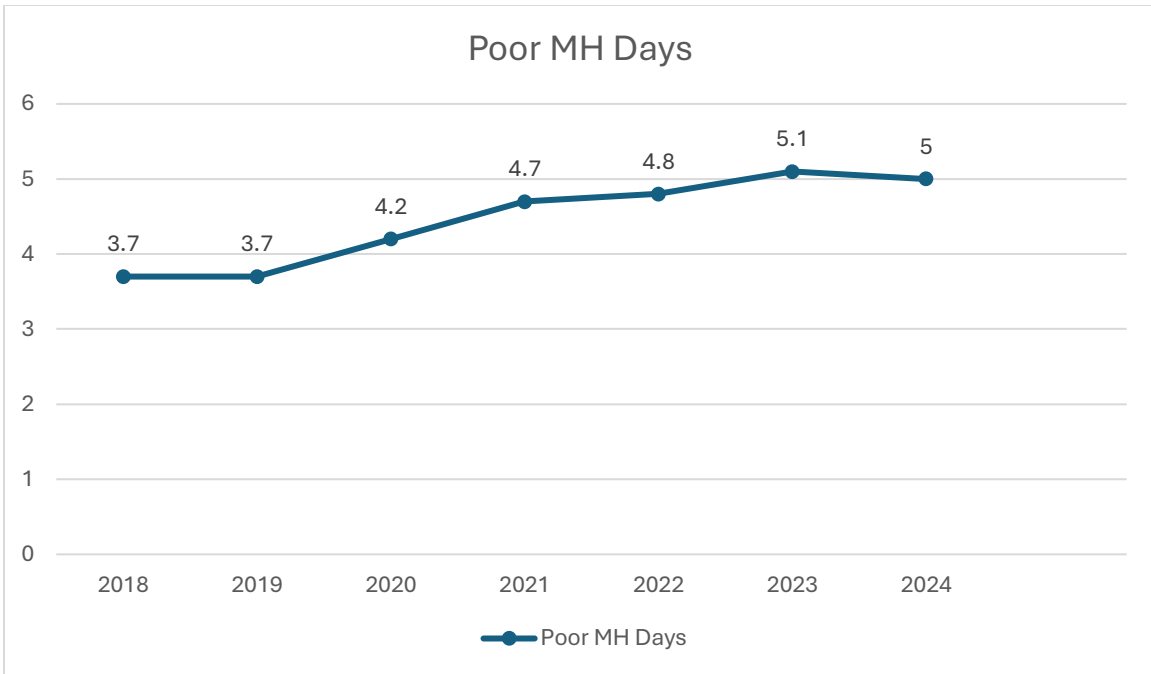

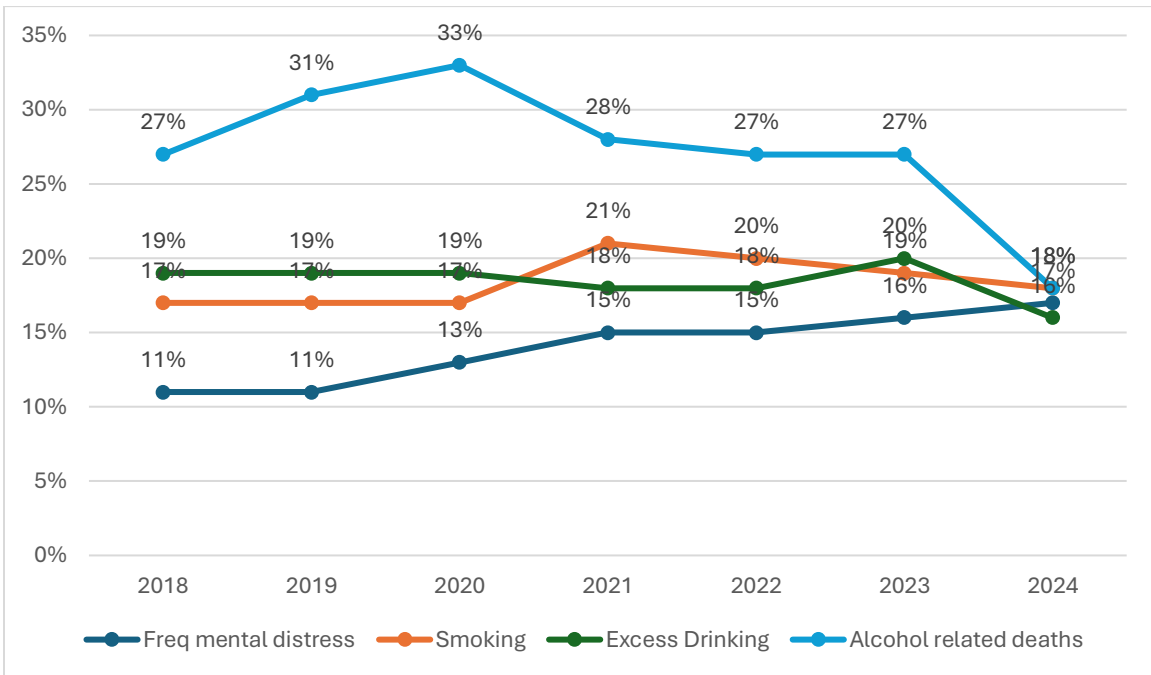

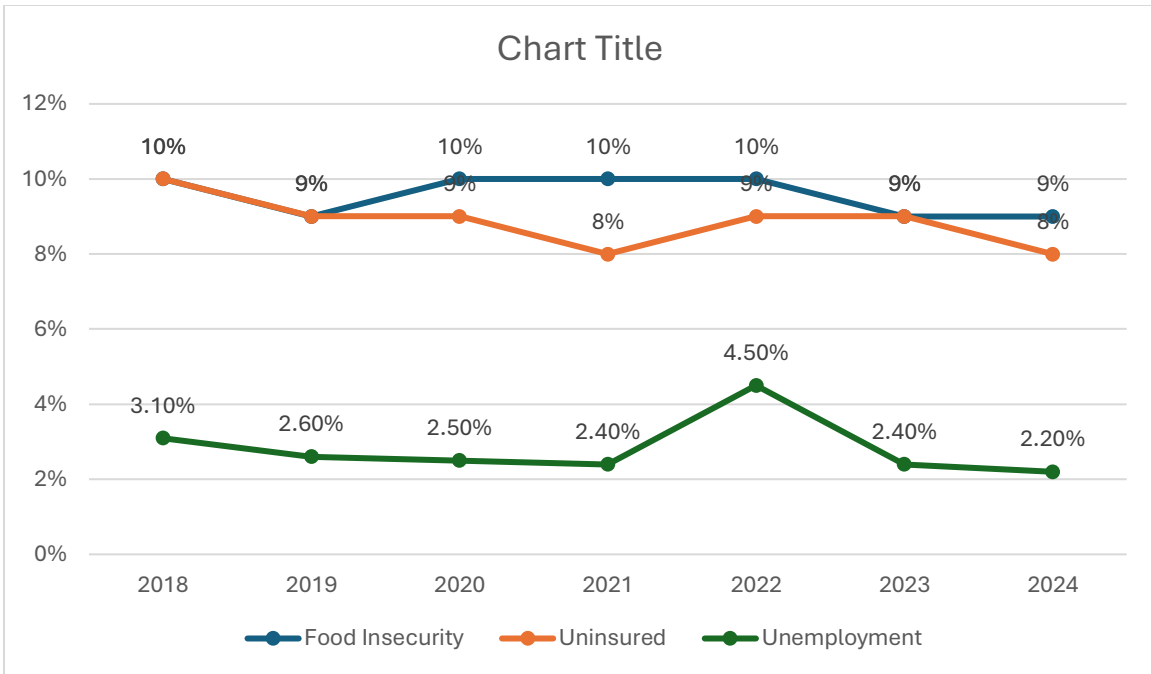




The number of poor mental health days per 30 days has increased from 3.7 days to 5 days.

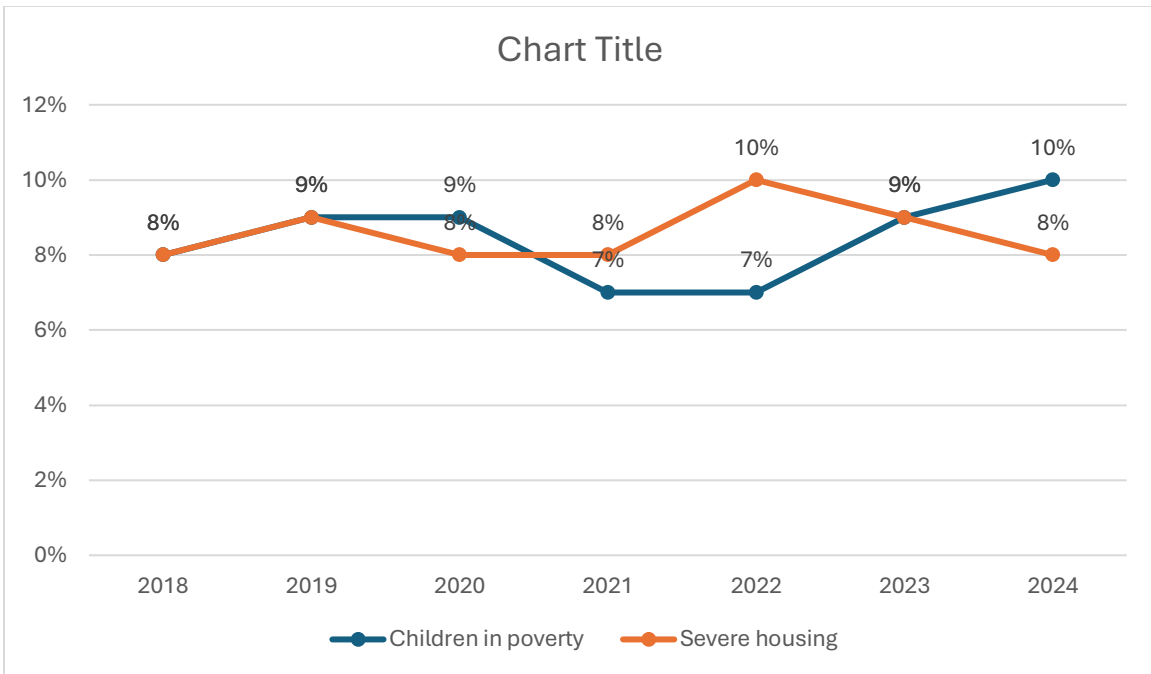


Frequent mental distress levels have increased from 11% to 17% since 2018. Smoking rates have increased from 17% in 2018 to 18% 2024. Excess drinking has decreased from 19% in 2018 to 16% in 2024 and alcohol related deaths have decreased to 18% since 2018.

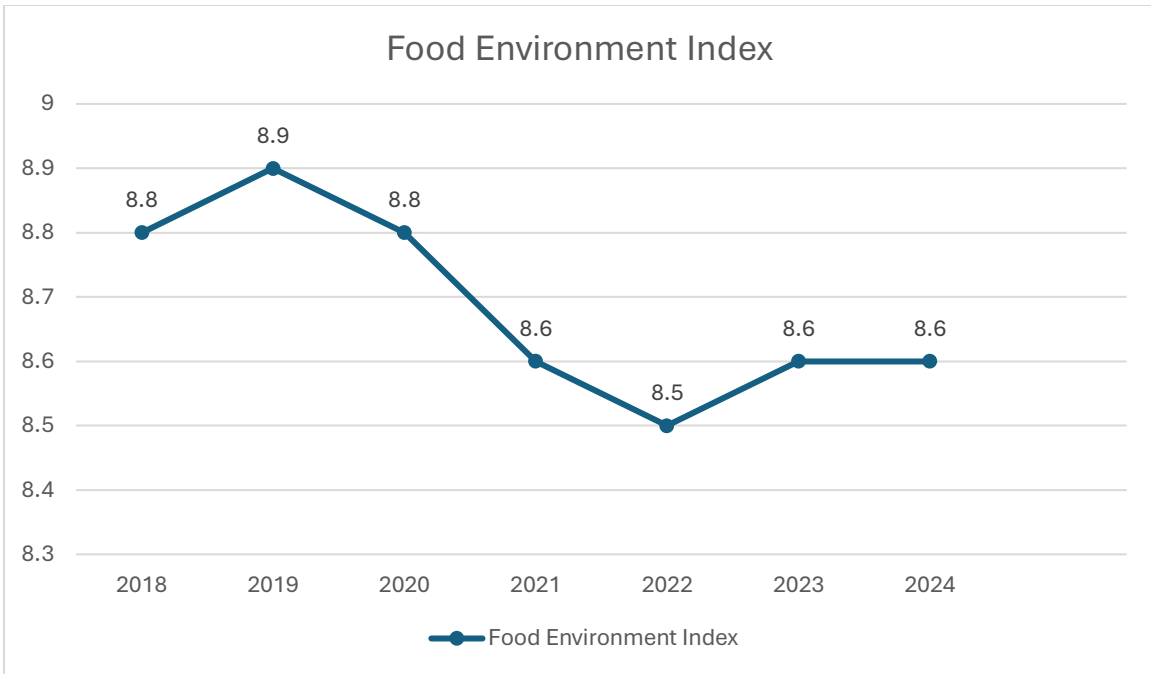


Food insecurity has decreased from 10% to 9%

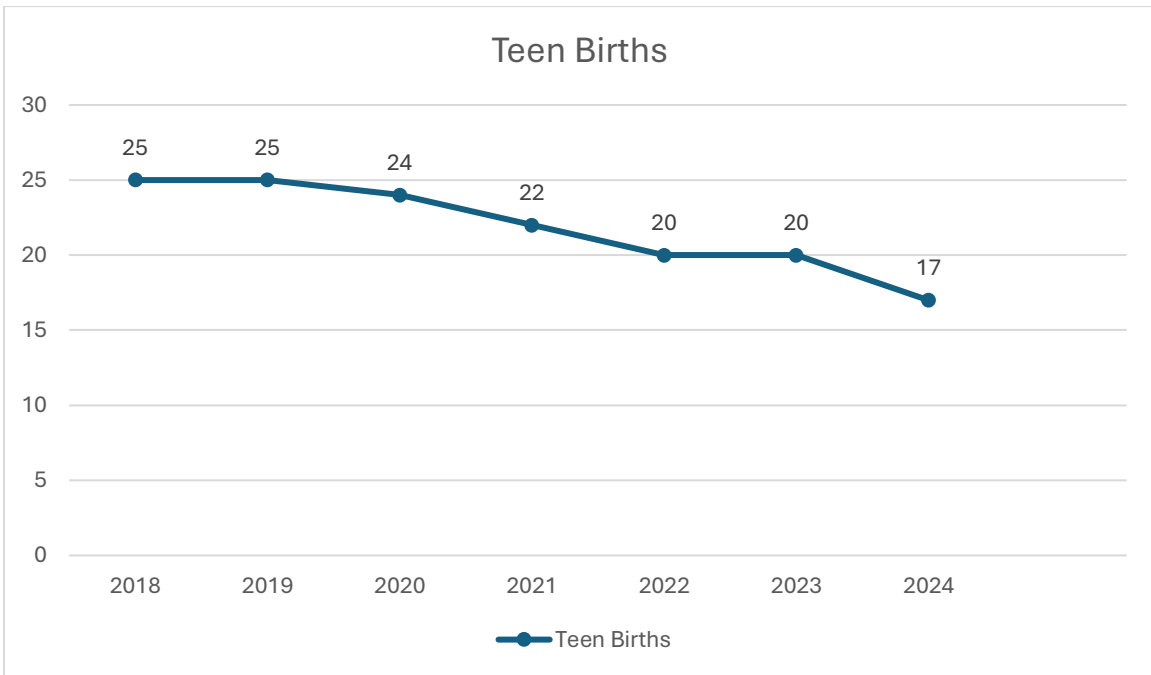
Uninsured rate has decreased from 10% to 8%. Unemployment rate decreased from 3.1% to 2.2%



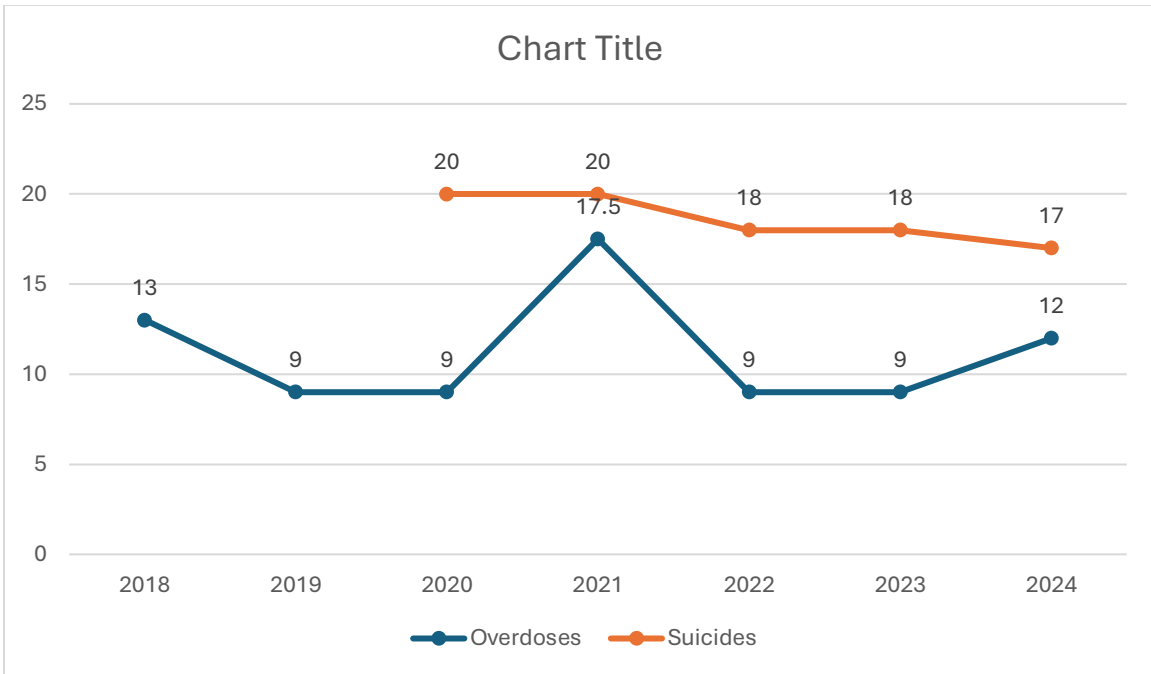
Children in poverty has increased from 8% to 10% since 2018. Severe housing issues has stayed the same at 8%



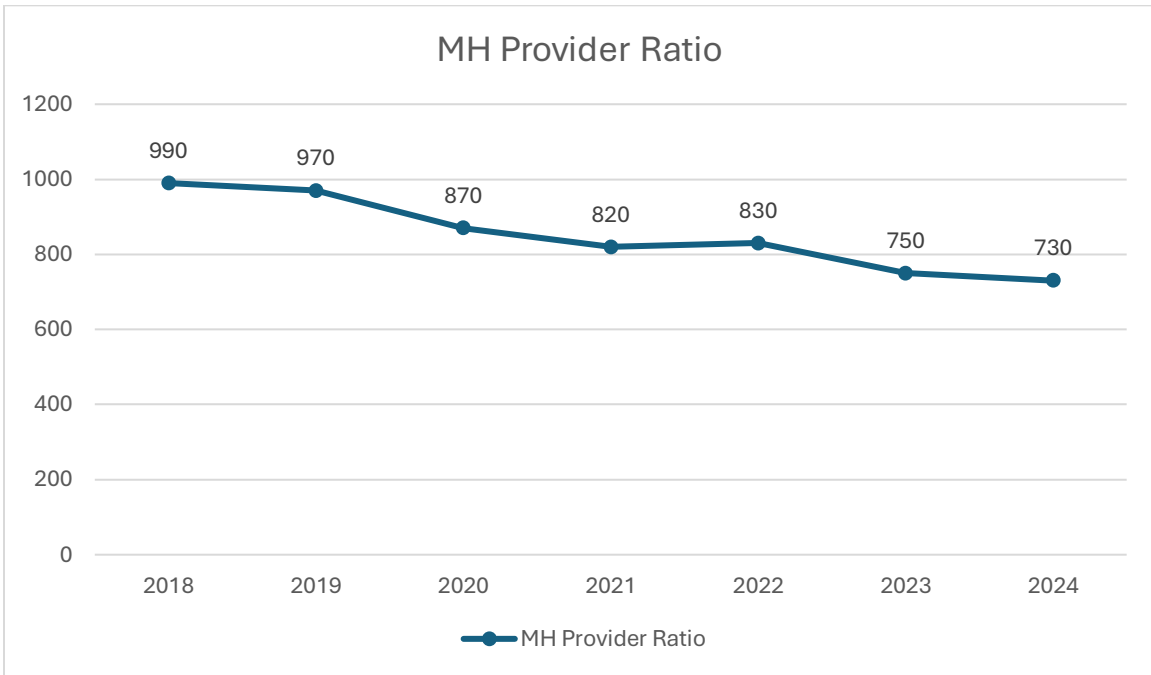
The food environment index has decreased from 8.8 to 8.6 since 2018.



Teen births have decreased from 25 to 17 since 2018.



Overdose rates have decreased from 13 to 12 since 2018. Suicide rate has decreased from 20 to 17 since 2018.



The mental health provider ratio is how many patients there are to every one mental health provider. The average in Indiana is 550:1. Dubois county has had a decrease from 990:1 to 730:1 since 2018.
