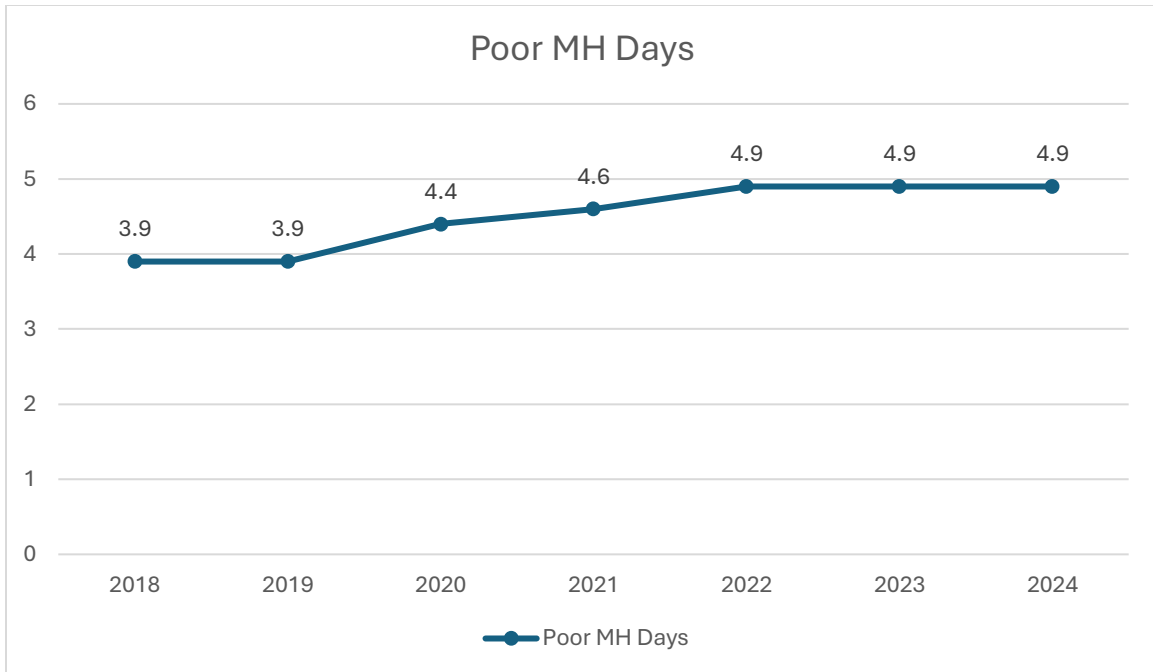

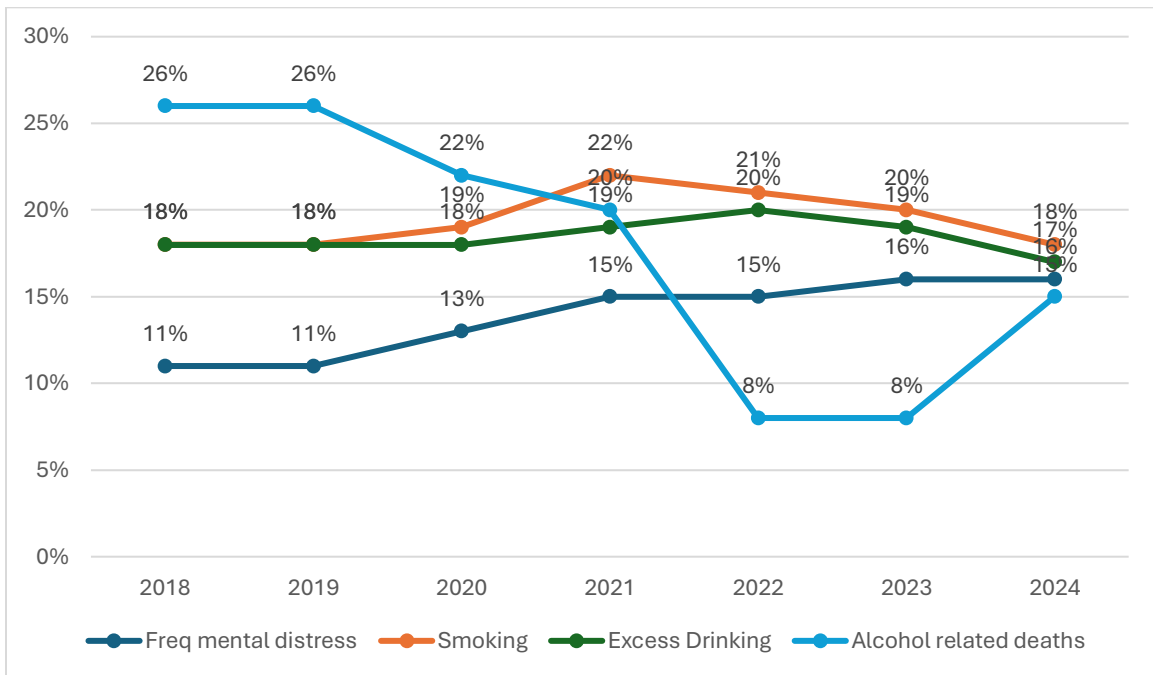

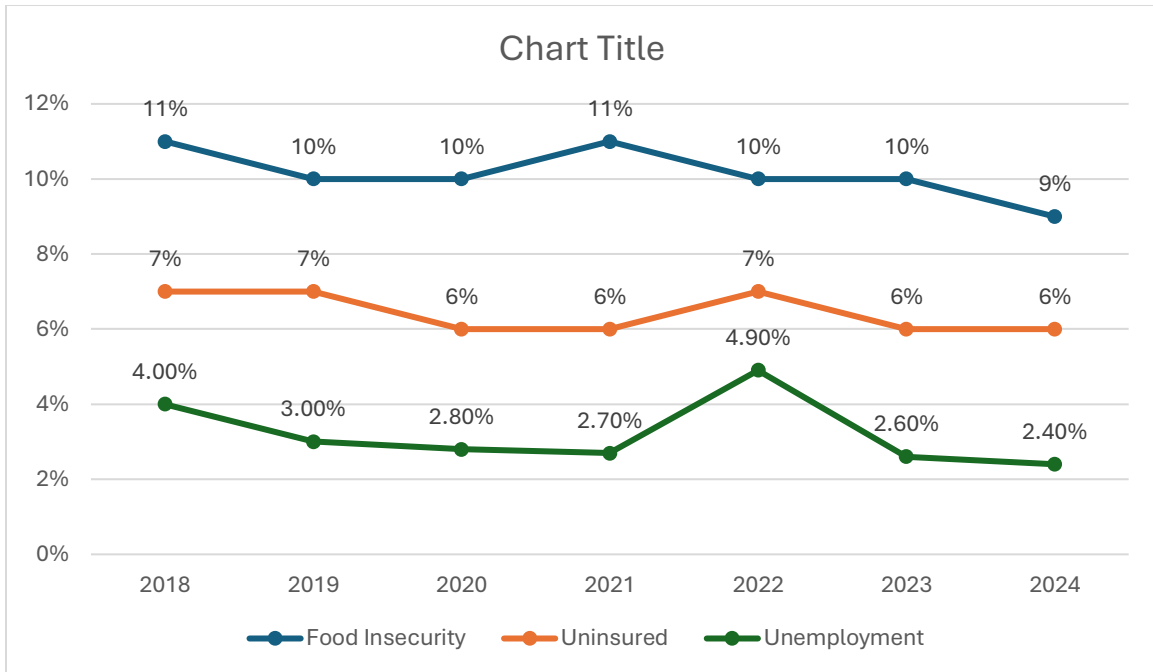




The number of poor mental health days per 30 days has increased from 3.9 days to 4.9 days.

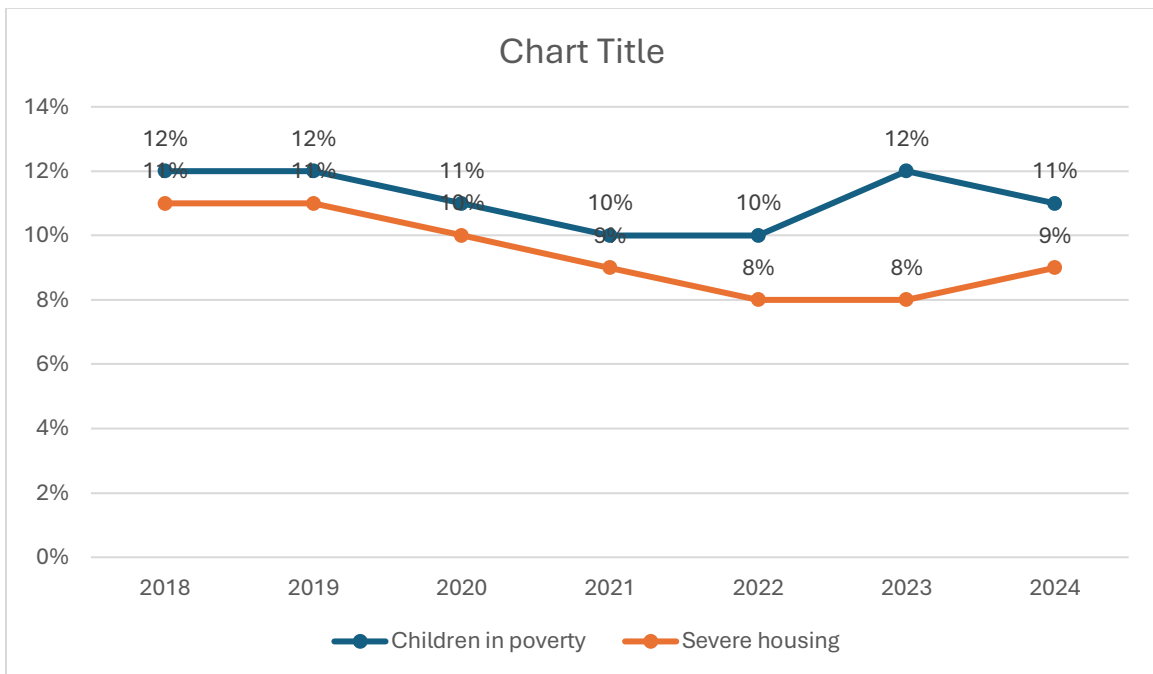


Frequent mental distress levels has increased from 11% to 16% since 2018. Smoking rates are the same at 18% from 2018 to 2024. Excess drinking has decreased from 18% to 17% and alcohol related deaths have decreased from 26% to 15%

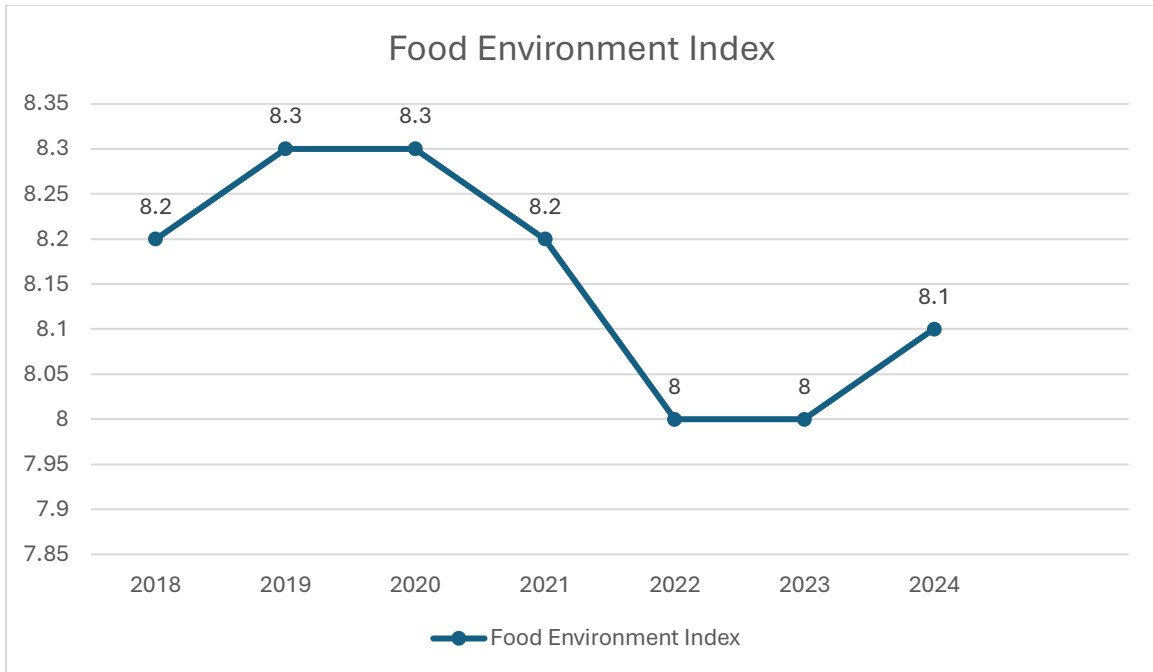


Food insecurity has decreased from 11% to 9%

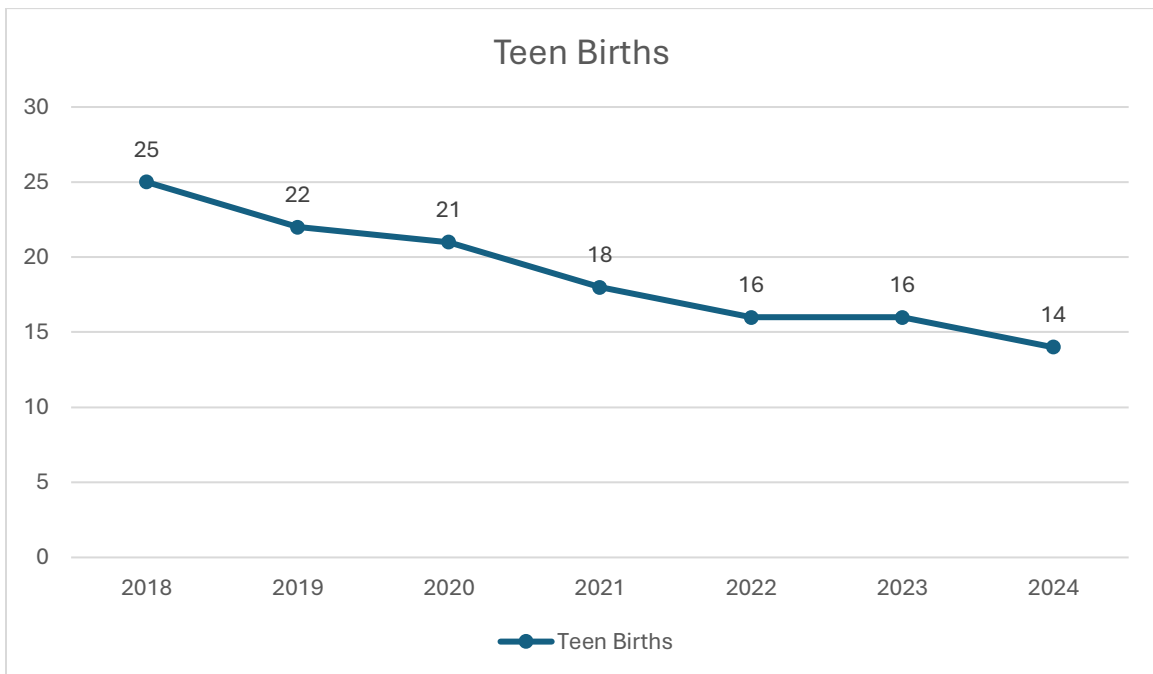
Uninsured rate has decreased from 7% to 6%. Unemployment rate decreased from 4% to 2.4%



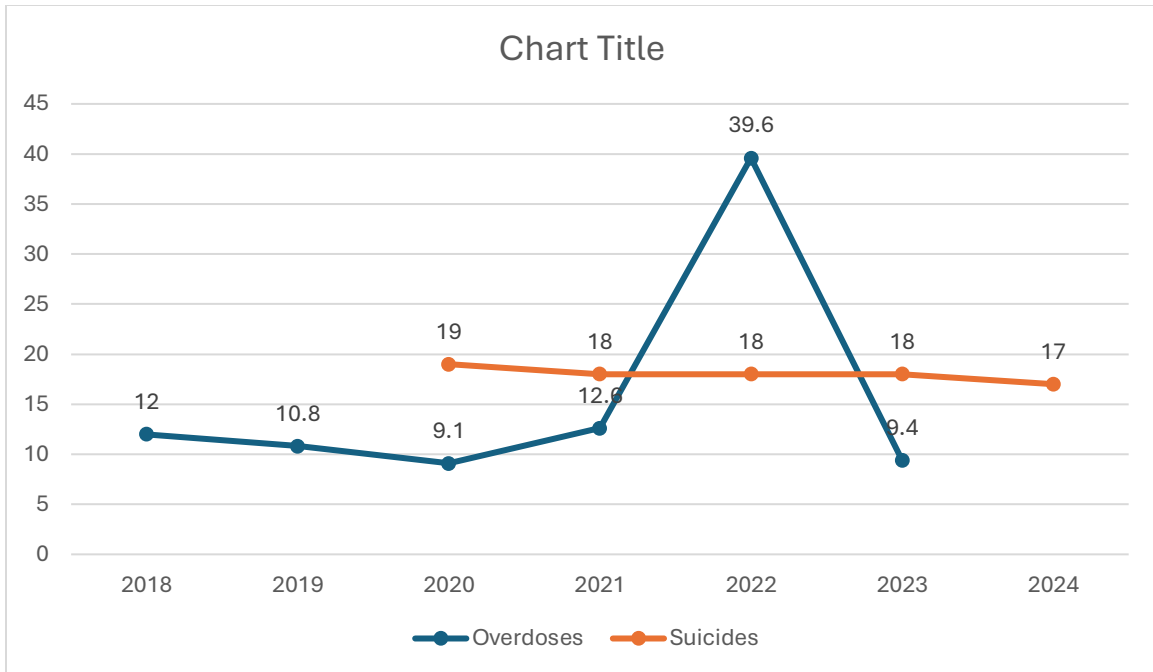
Children in poverty decreased from 12% to 11%. Severe housing issues decreased from 11% to 9%.



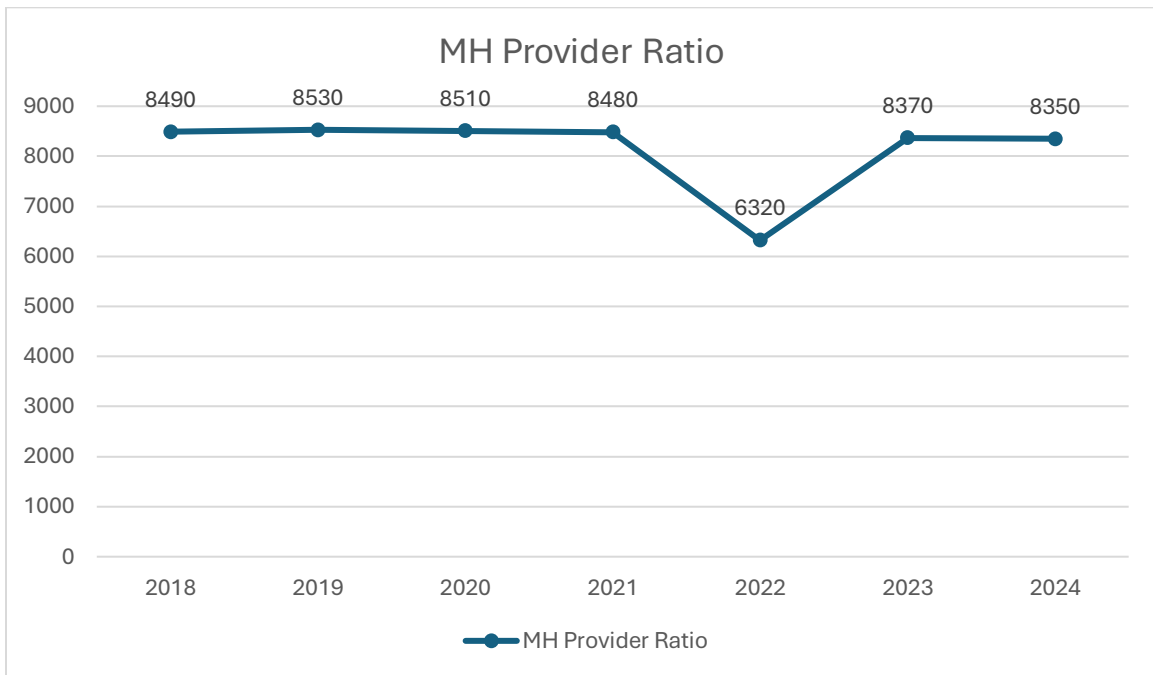
The food environment index has decreased from 8.2 to 8.1 since 2018.



Teen births have decreased from 25 to 14 since 2018.



Overdose rates have slightly decreased from 12 to 9.4 since 2018. Suicide rates have decreased from 19 to 17 since 2020.



The mental health provider ratio is how many patients there are to every one mental health provider. The average in Indiana is 550:1. Posey county has had a slight decrease from 8490:1 to 8350:1 since 2018.
