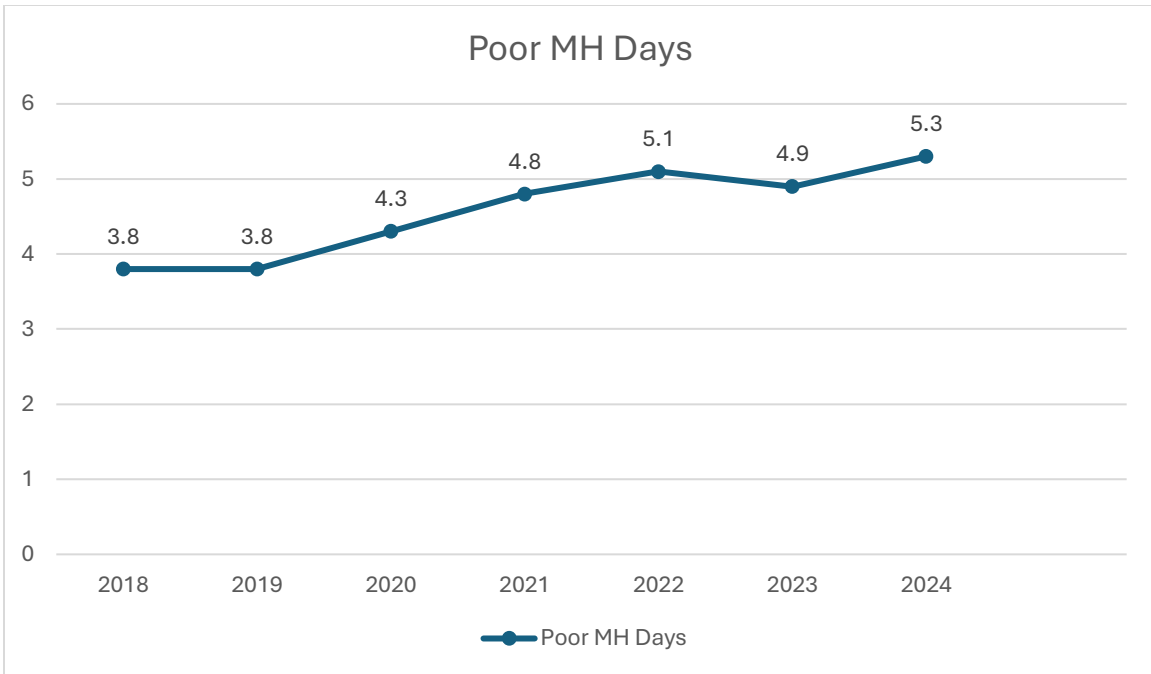

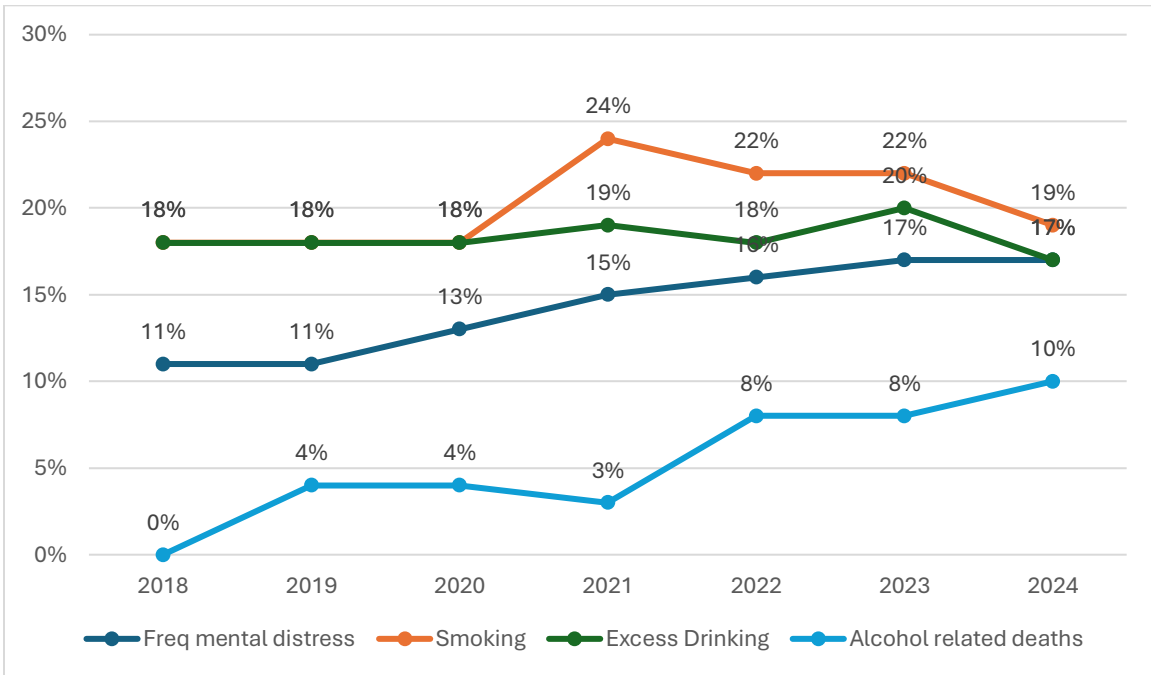

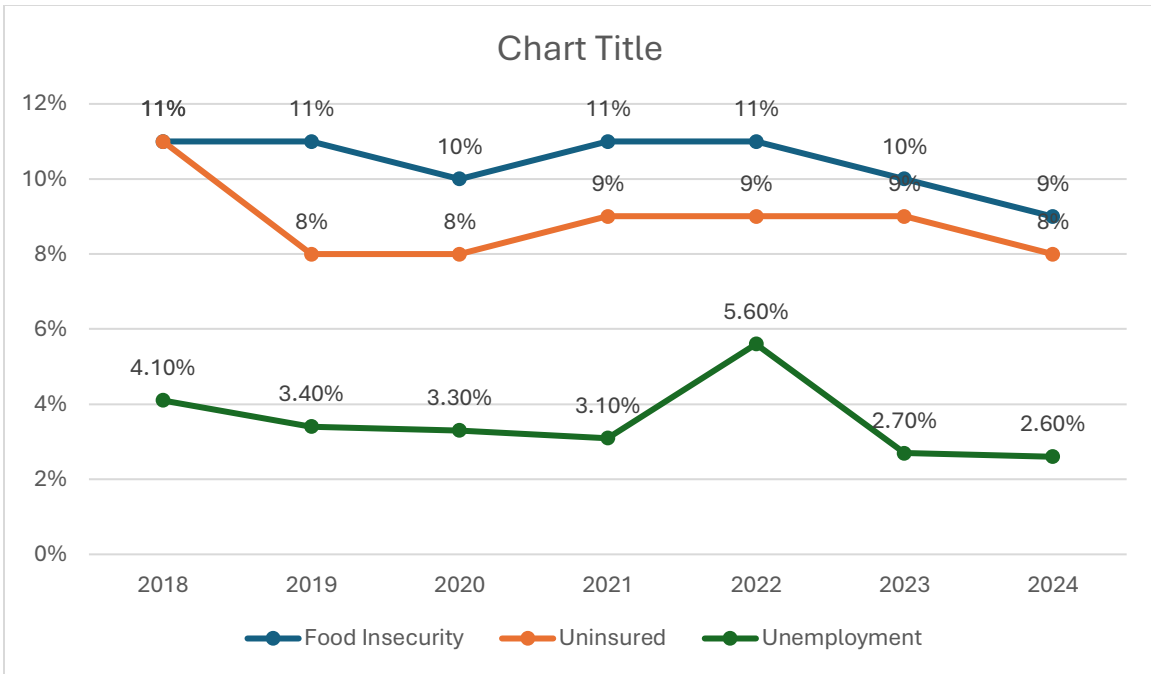




The number of poor mental health days per 30 days has increased from 3.8 days to 5.3 days.

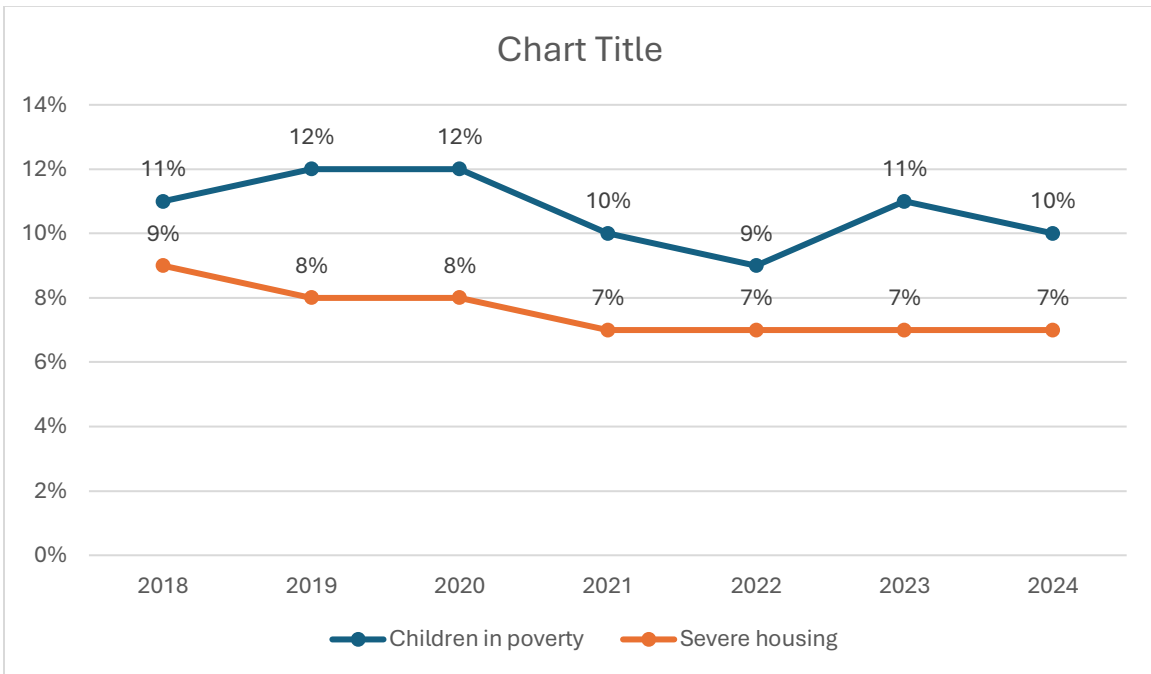


Frequent mental distress levels have increased from 11% to 17% since 2018. Smoking rates have increased from 18% in 2018 to 19% 2024. Excess drinking has decreased from 18% to 17% since 2018 and alcohol related deaths have increased to 10%.

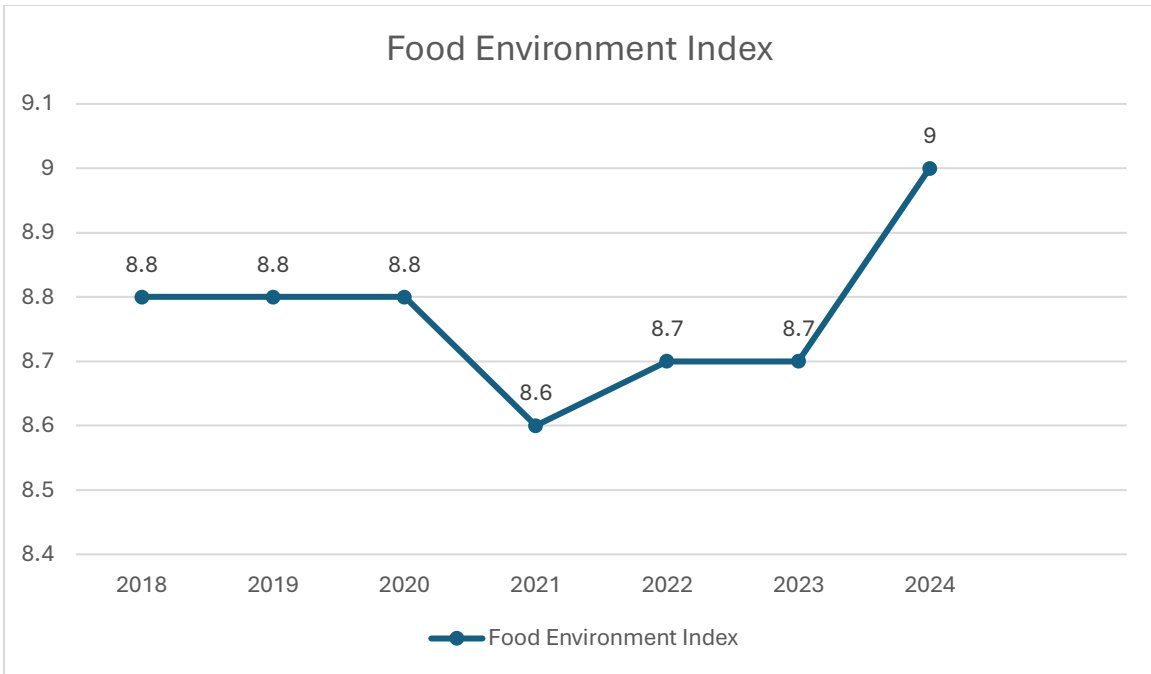


Food insecurity has decreased from 11% to 9%

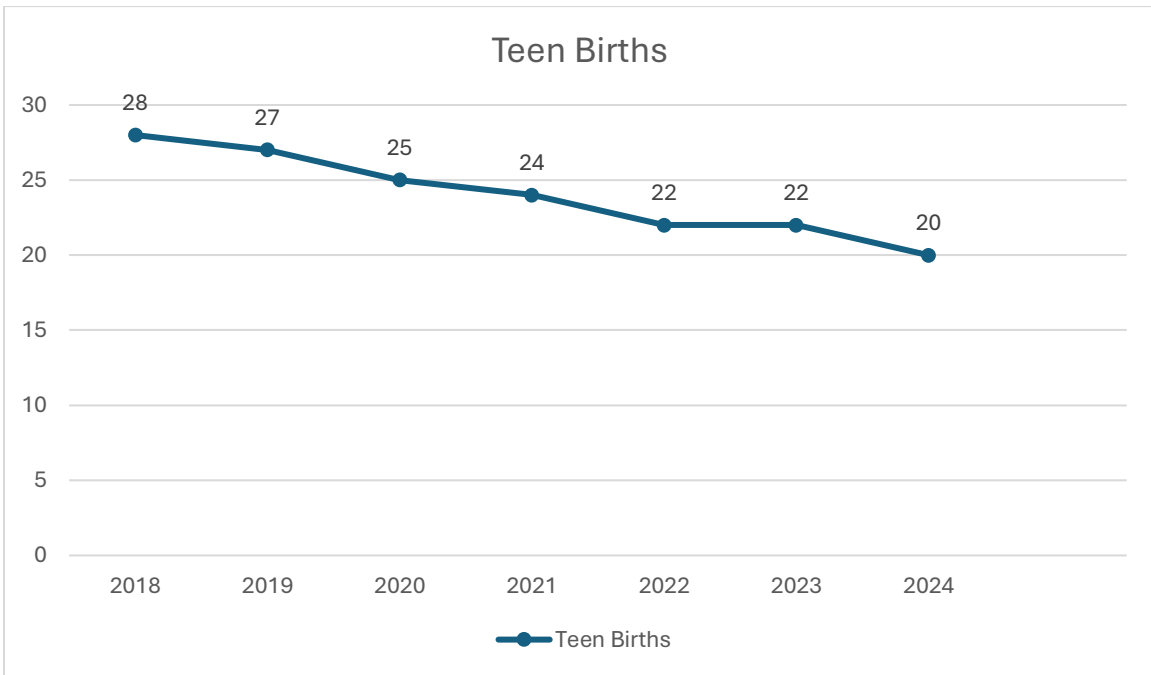
Uninsured rate has decreased from 11% to 8%. Unemployment rate decreased from 4.1% to 2.6%



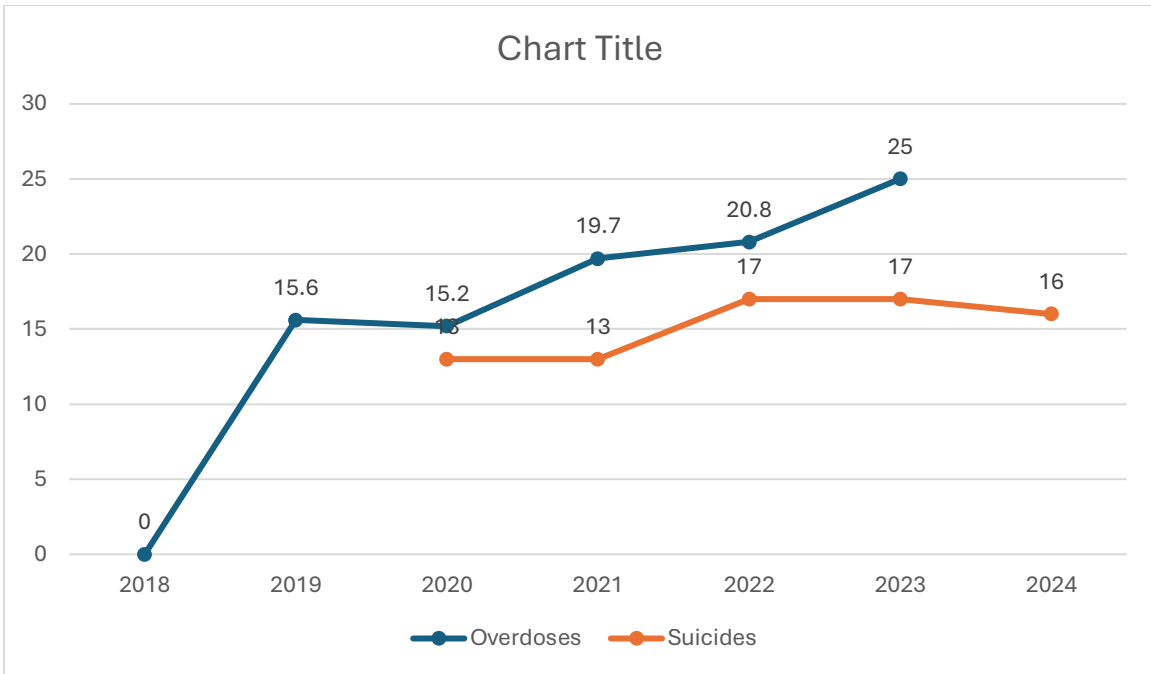
Children in poverty has decreased from 11% to 10% since 2018. Severe housing issues has decreased from 9% to 7% since 2018.



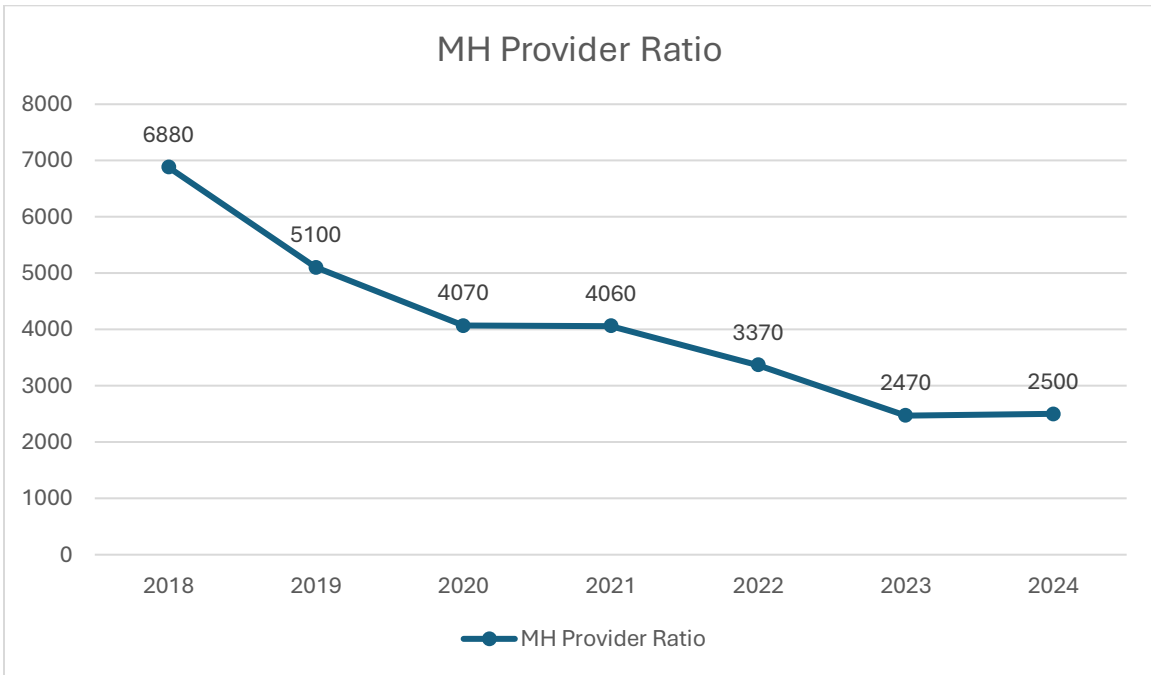
The food environment index has decreased from 8.8 to 9.0 since 2018.



Teen births have decreased from 28 to 20 since 2018.



Overdose rates have increased from 0 to 25 since 2018. Suicide rate has increased from 13 to 16 since 2018.



The mental health provider ratio is how many patients there are to every one mental health provider. The average in Indiana is 550:1. Spencer county has had a decrease from 6880:1 to 2500:1 since 2018.
