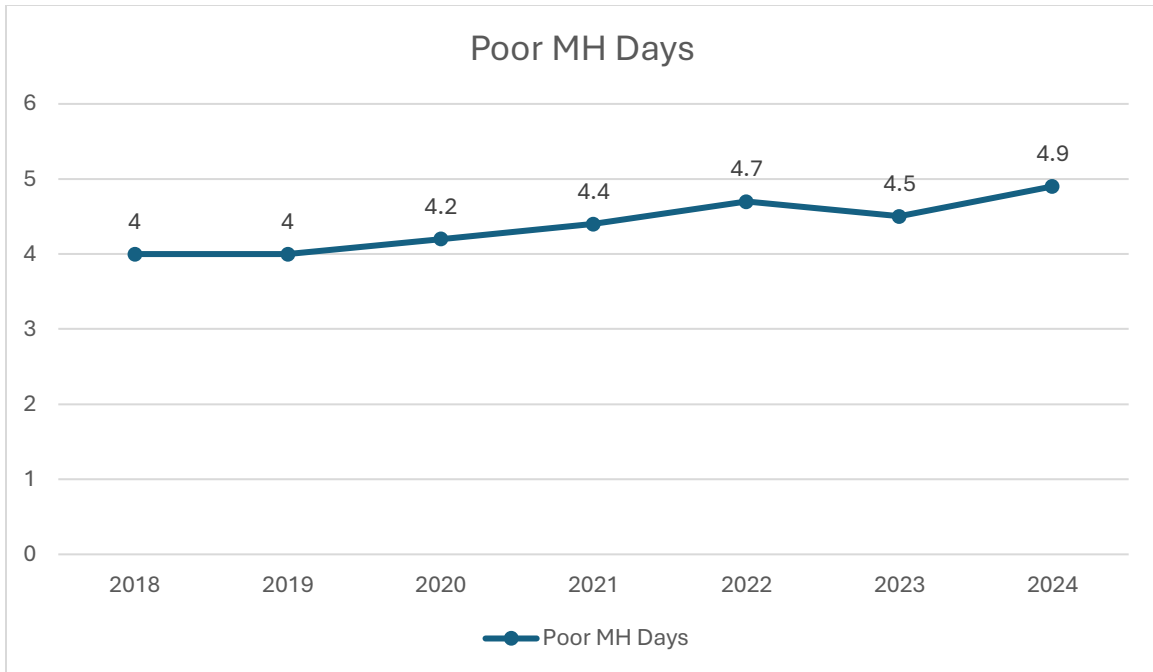

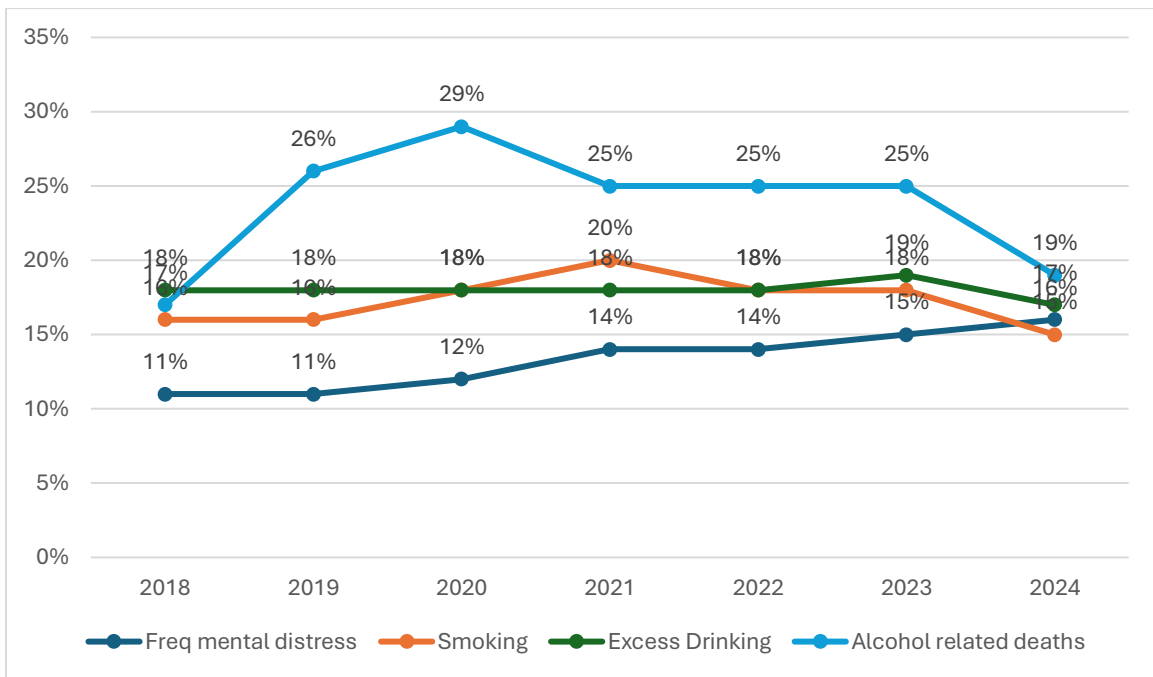

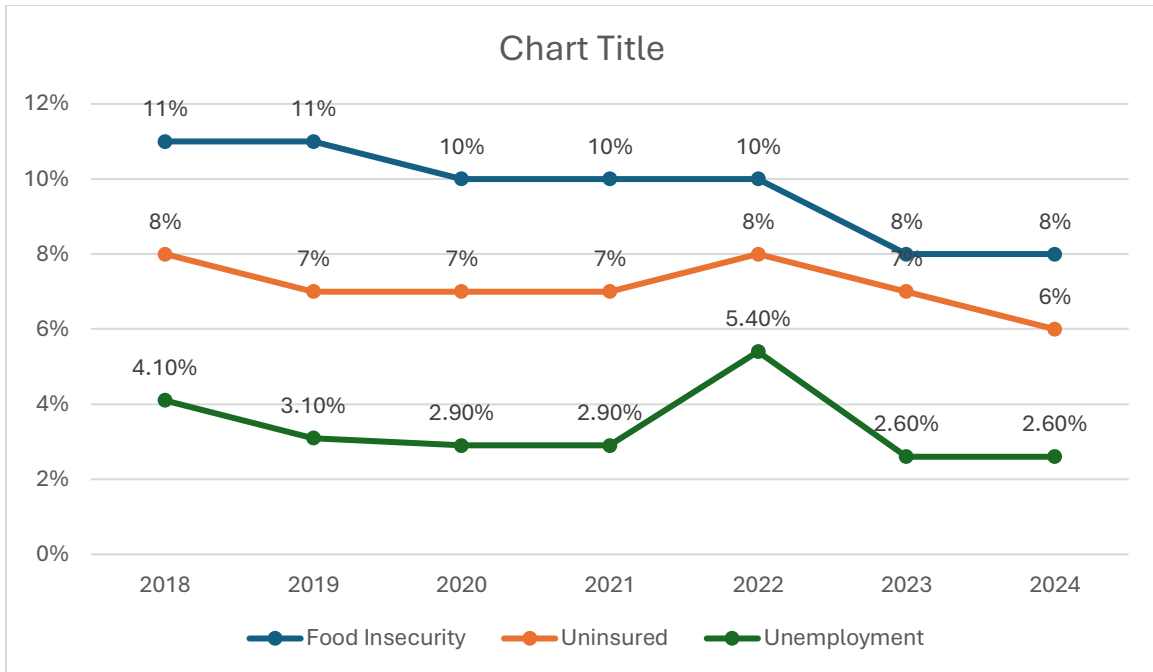




The number of poor mental health days per 30 days has increased from 4 days to 4.9 days.

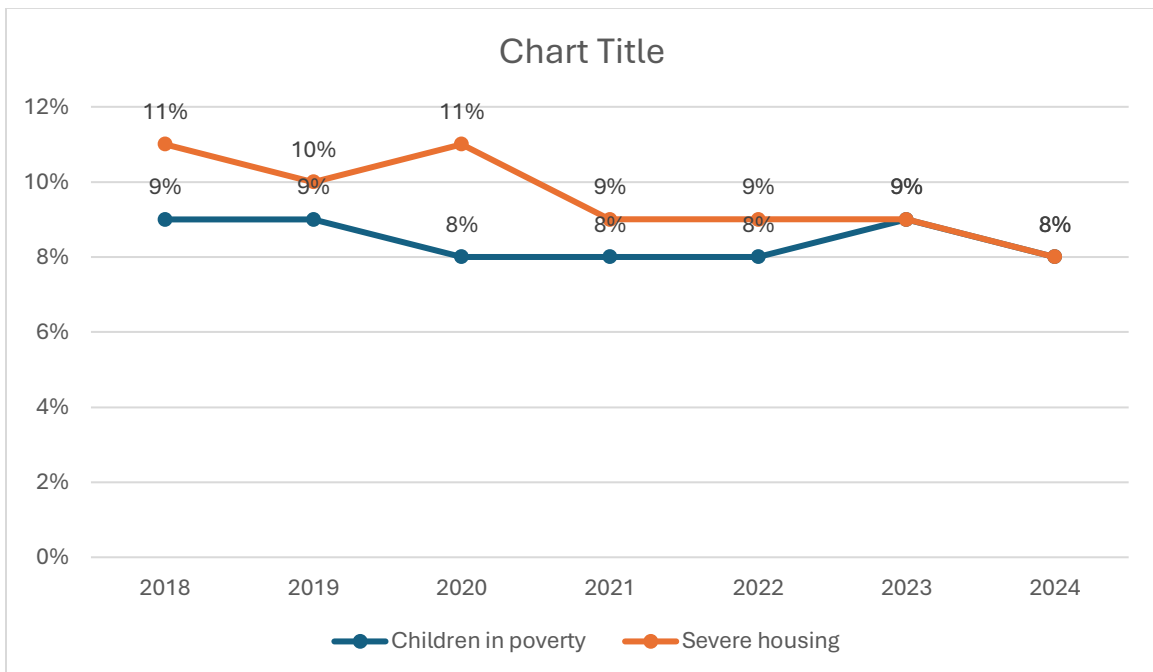


Frequent mental distress levels has increased from 11% to 16% since 2018. Smoking rates are the same have decreased from 16% in 2018 to 15% 2024. Excess drinking has decreased from 18% to 17% and alcohol related deaths have increased from 17% to 19%

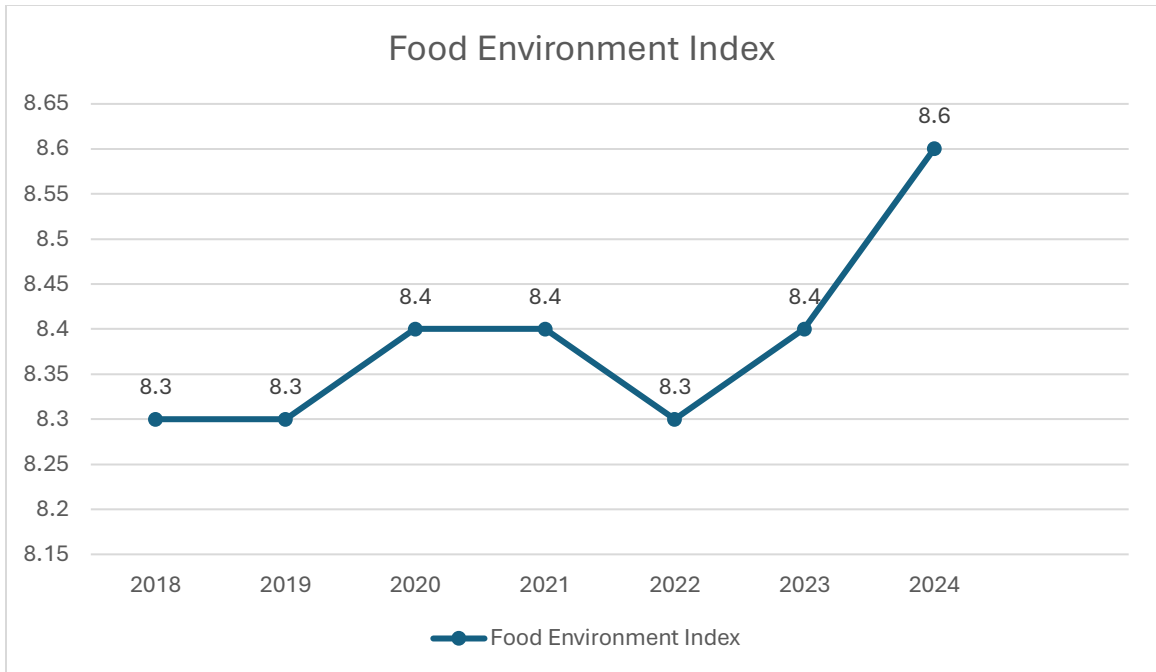


Food insecurity has decreased from 11% to 8%

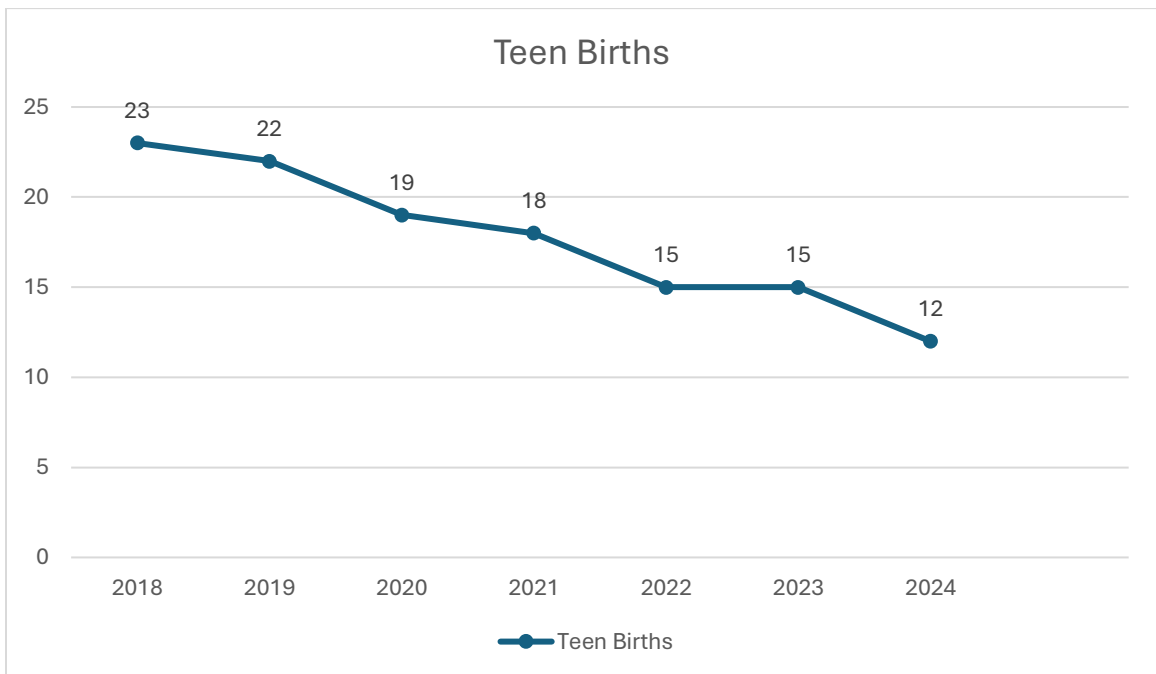
Uninsured rate has decreased from 8% to 6%. Unemployment rate decreased from 4.1% to 2.6%



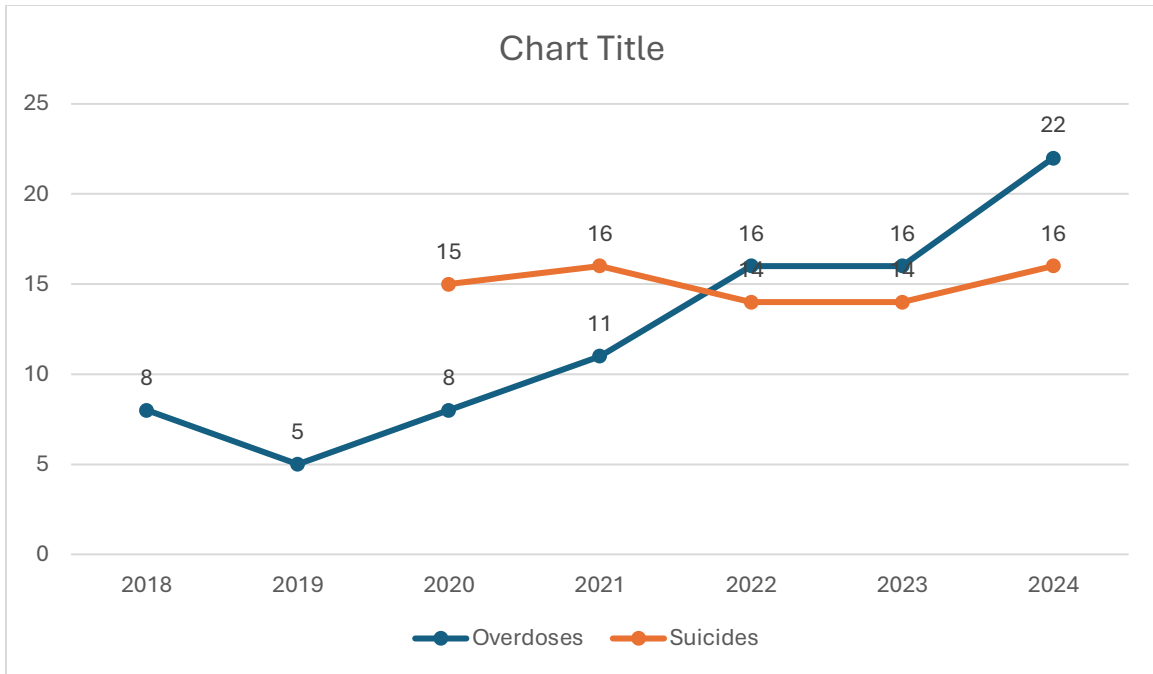
Children in poverty decreased from 11% to 8%. Severe housing issues has stayed the same at 9% since 2018.



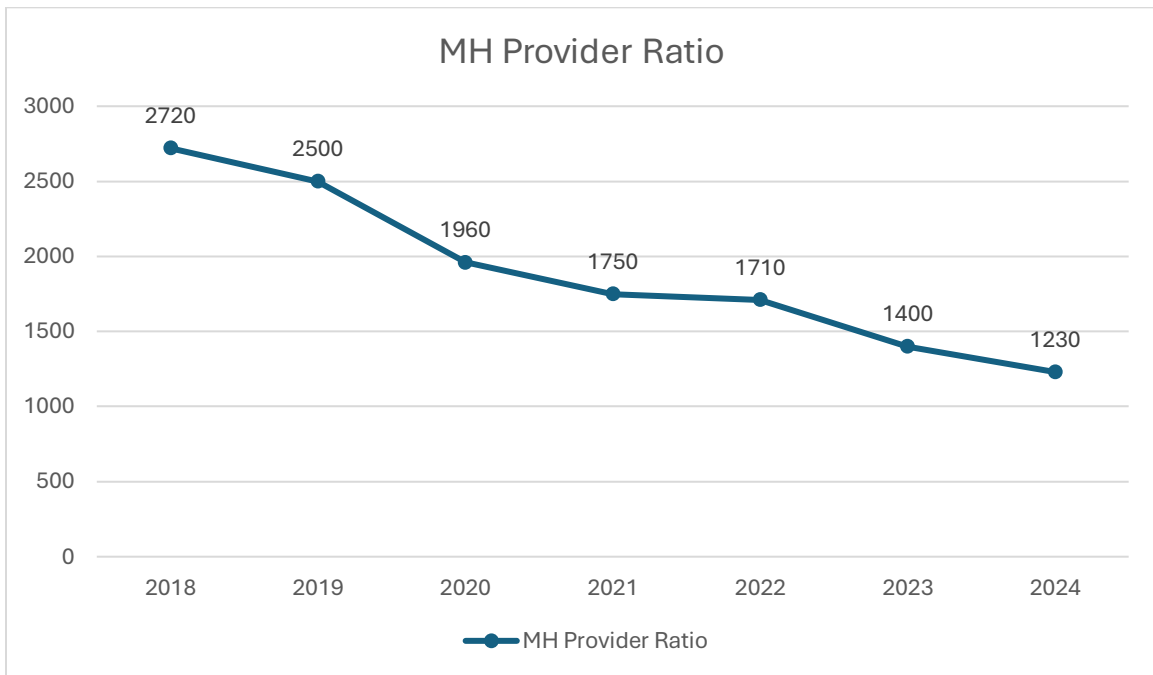
The food environment index has increased from 8.3 to 8.6 since 2018.



Teen births have decreased from 23 to 12 since 2018.



Overdose rates have increased from 8 to 22 since 2018. Suicide rates have increased from 15 to 16 since 2020.



The mental health provider ratio is how many patients there are to every one mental health provider. The average in Indiana is 550:1. Warrick county has had a significant decrease from 2720:1 to 1230:1 since 2018.
