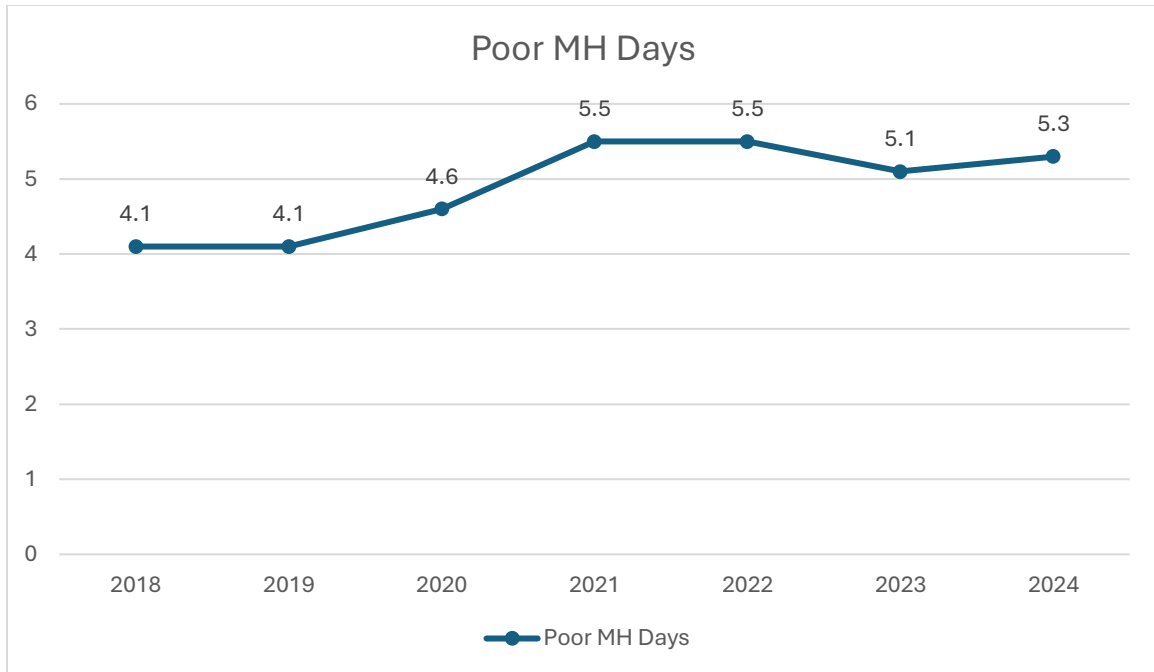

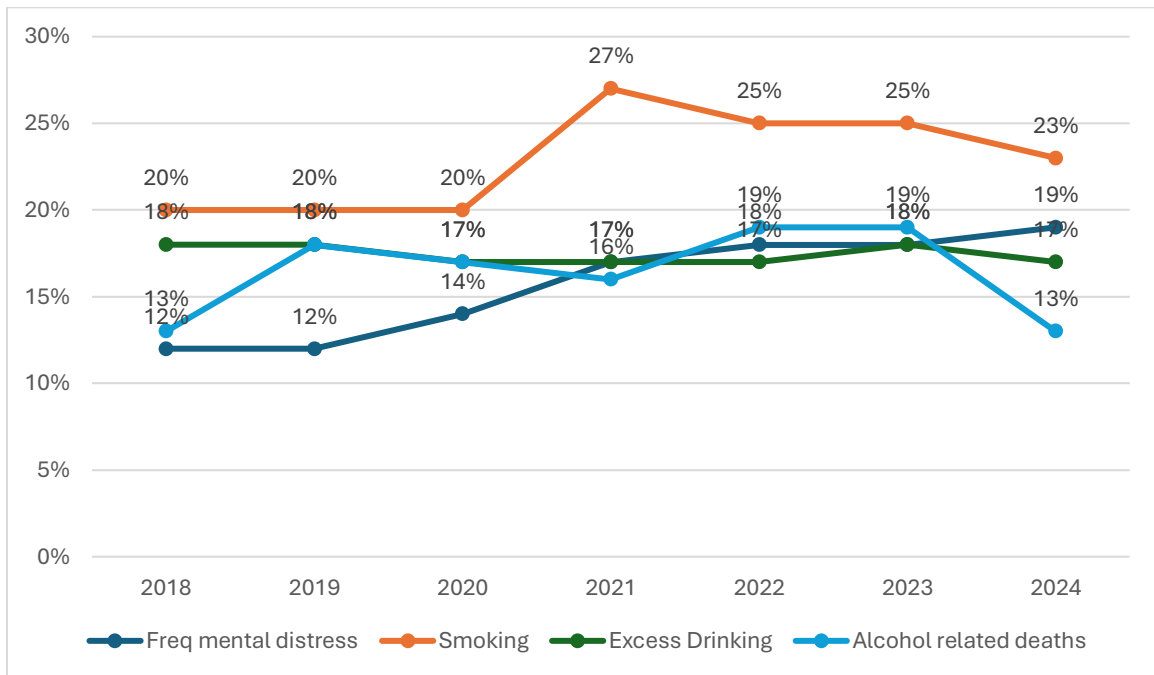

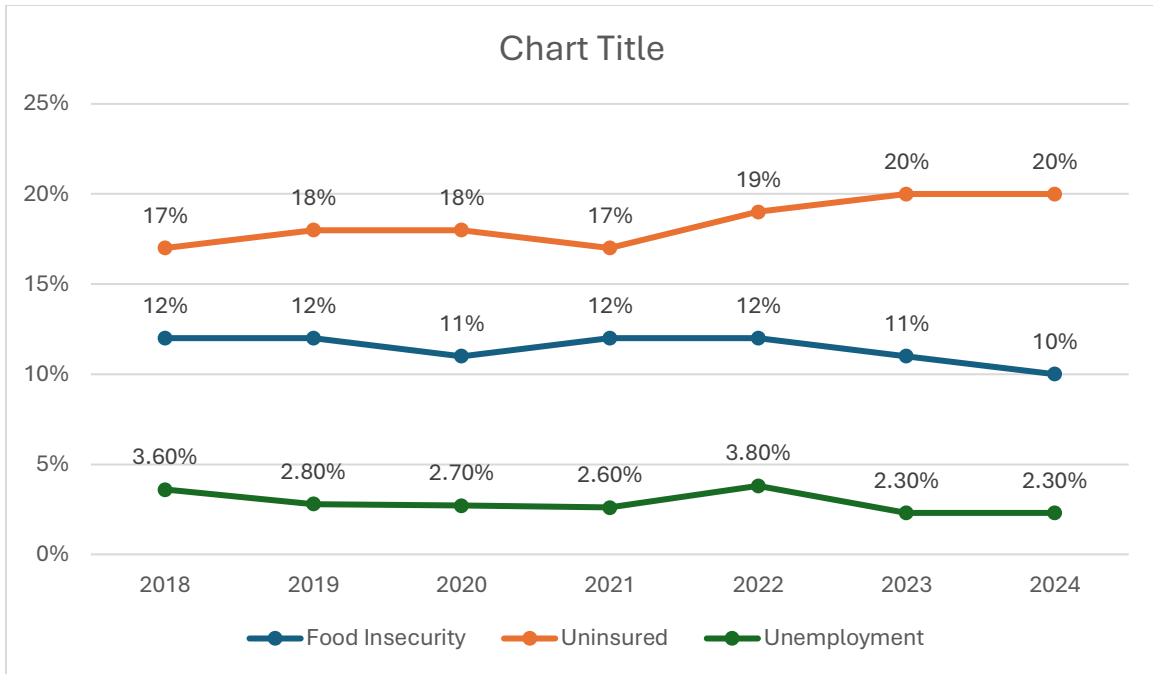




The number of poor mental health days per 30 days has increased from 4.1 days to 5.3 days.

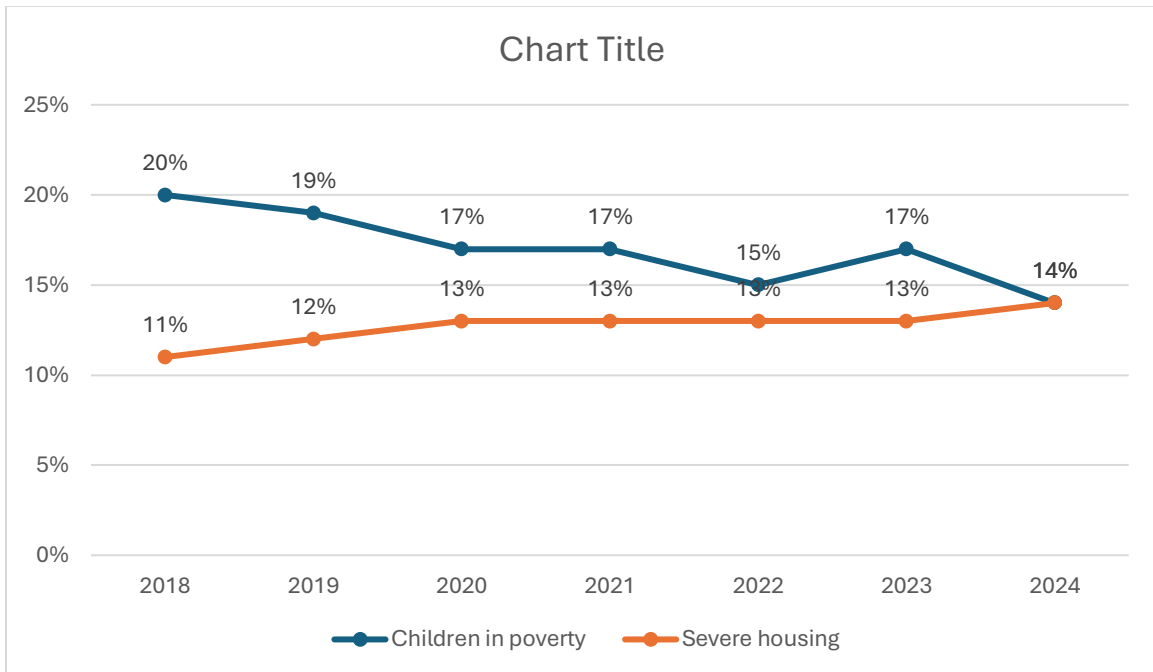


Frequent mental distress levels has increased from 12% to 19% since 2018. Smoking rates have increased from 20% in 2018 to 23% 2024. Excess drinking has decreased from 18% to 17% and alcohol related deaths have stayed the same at 13%

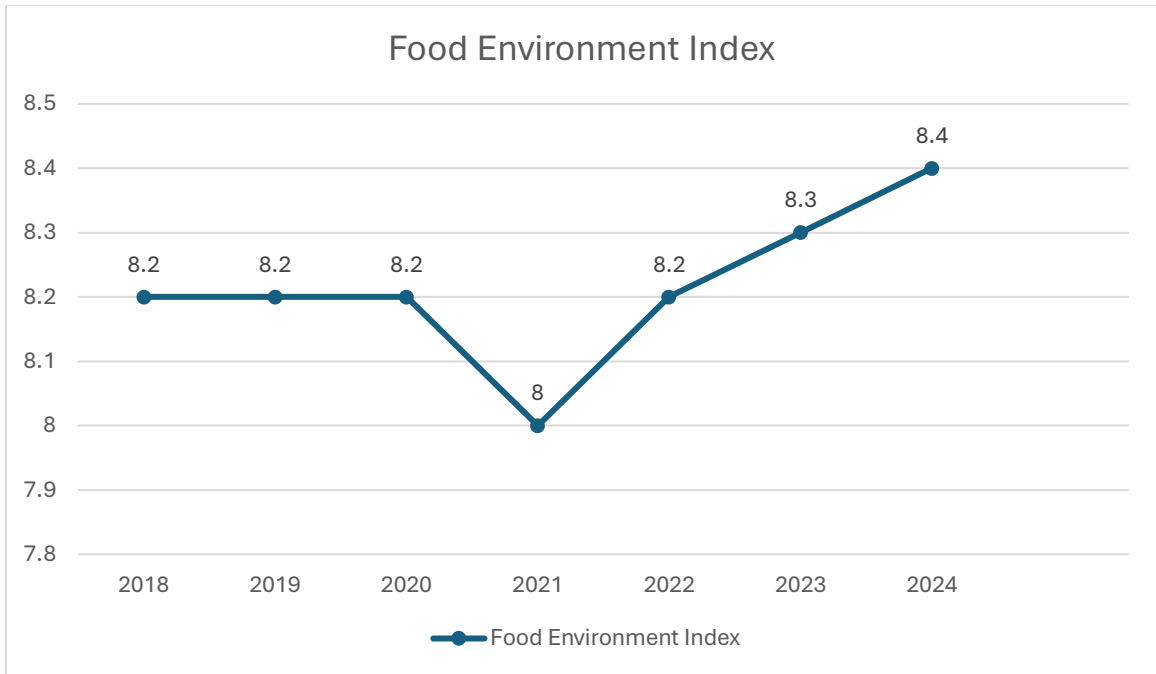


Food insecurity has decreased from 12% to 10%

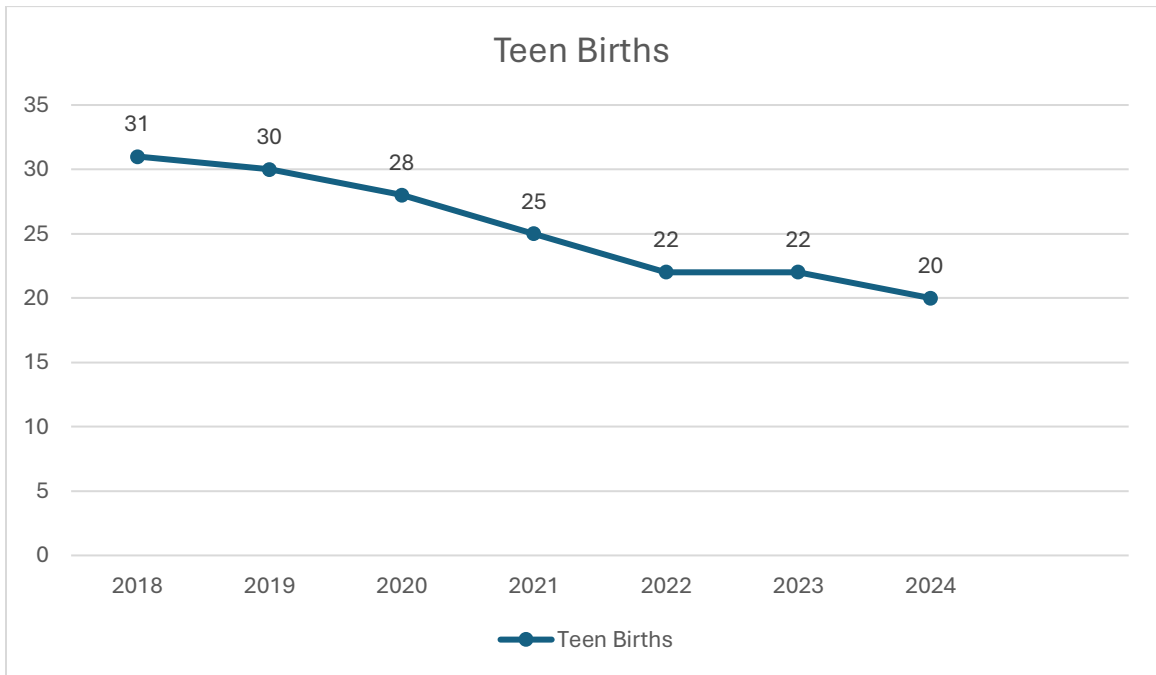
Uninsured rate has increased from 17% to 20%. Unemployment rate decreased from 3.6% to 2.3%



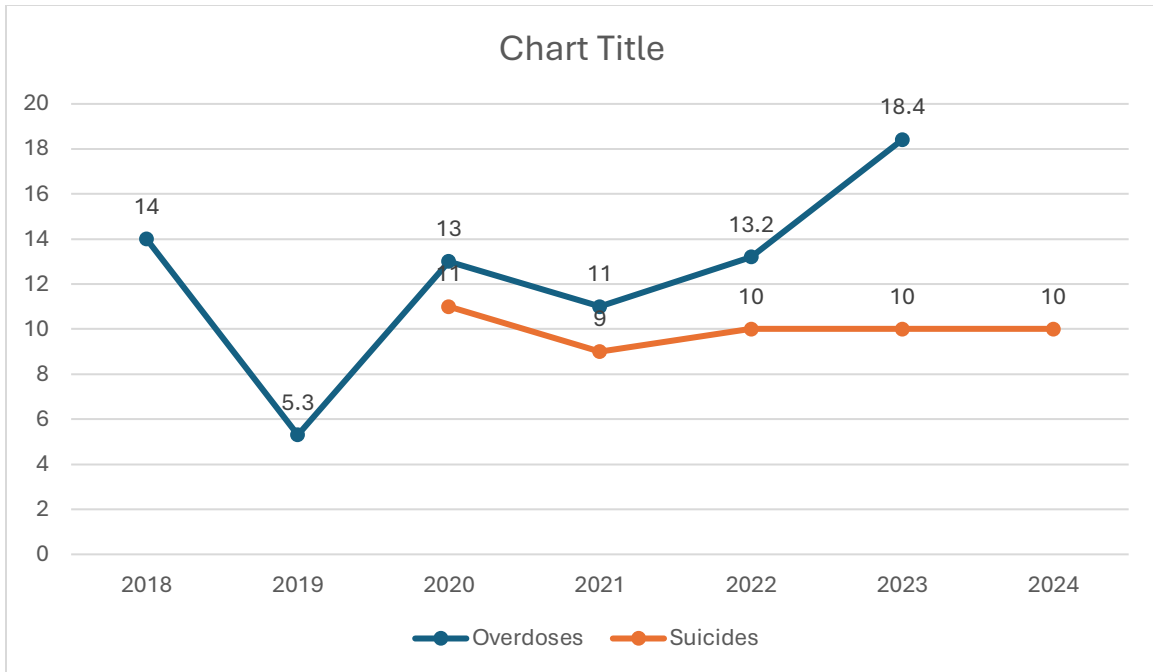
Children in poverty decreased from 20% to 14%. Severe housing issues has increased from 11% since 2018 to 14% in 2024.



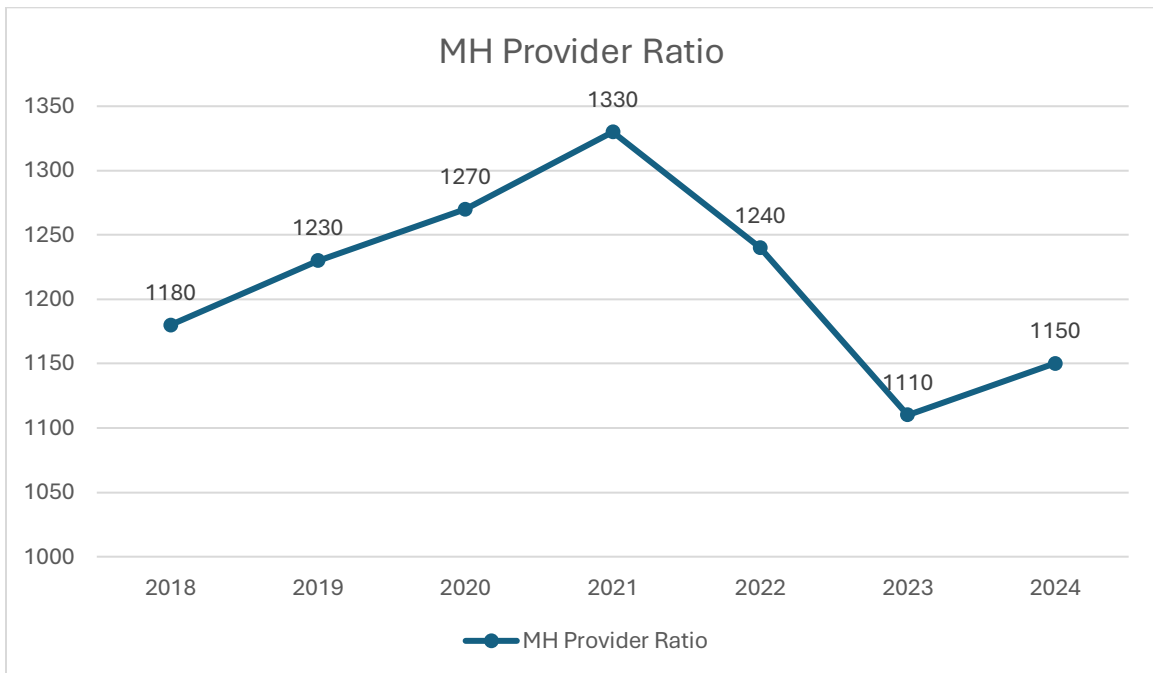
The food environment index has increased from 8.2 to 8.4 since 2018.



Teen births have decreased from 31 to 20 since 2018.



Overdose rates have increased from 14 to 18.4 since 2018. Suicide rates have decreased from 11 to 10 since 2020.



The mental health provider ratio is how many patients there are to every one mental health provider. The average in Indiana is 550:1. Daviess county has had a slight decrease from 1180:1 to 1150:1 since 2018.
