September 8 is Rally Day and the beginning of Faith Formation programming for the year. St. Timothy offers Sunday morning classes for all ages as well as a catechism program for middle schoolers. Christian education or, as it is known at St. Timothy,



Faith Formation, is critically important to Christian life and faith. This is especially true in a time when many use Christianity as a means to political success. What does it mean to follow Jesus? How do you make sense of the seemingly contradictory parts of the Bible? For example, is it "an eye for an eye" or "turn the other cheek"?

Over the centuries Christian people have wrestled with scripture and tradition and have come up with various, often conflicting, answers to the questions raised. There have been times when to disagree with the prevailing thought could get you in a great deal of trouble. Wars have been fought over differences in theology.

For Christians, at its most basic, faith formation is a process by which a community of people study and struggle together to understand what it means to follow Jesus here in this place, now at this time. Faith formation is done in community, in places where it is safe to question and to disagree as we seek to understand and to be faithful. I hope you will take advantage of the opportunities for faith formation this year at St. Timothy.

One of those opportunities will begin on September 29 at 9 o'clock, when we will offer an Inquirers Class for anyone who is interested in learning more about the Christian faith as Lutherans understand it and about the St. Timothy congregation. The class will last for 4-6 weeks, depending on what questions and interests the participants have. If you are interested in being a member of St. Timothy or would like a catechism refresher, or simply want to join others in examining our faith, please join us on Sunday mornings at 9 o'clock in Founders Hall. I think you will find the time engaging, interesting, and helpful.
