Standard 21: The Clubhouse enables its members to return to paid work through Transitional Employment, Supported Employment and Independent Employment; therefore, the Clubhouse does not provide employment to members through in-house businesses, segregated Clubhouse enterprises or sheltered workshops.

Transitional Employment

As noted in Standard 21, employment is an essential part of the Clubhouse model. Transitional employment is short term (6-12 months), risk free, supported re-entry to the workforce. The only requirement is the desire to work. The Clubhouse manages these positions alongside the employer and the Clubhouse guarantees coverage on all placements during member absences.
