Walk-In Patients

We operate on a booked appointment basis to reduce waiting times. If we are fully booked when you walk in, we may still be able to see you — however a **\$10 surcharge** applies to our Standard / After Hours rates for ALL patients, regardless of concession status.

Procedures

Service	Fee
Skin procedures, wound repair, nail procedures, contraceptive implants and similar	Please call the practice (we will confirm the fee before your appointment)

The item number for your procedure is determined by the practitioner based on your specific requirements, so the cost varies accordingly. Please call us on **[phone]** or speak to reception and we will confirm the item, the Medicare rebate and your out-of-pocket cost before your appointment. Medicare rebates are only available to patients with an eligible Medicare card. Some procedures may also involve an additional consultation fee.

Cryotherapy — simple	\$20.00 (no rebate)
Cryotherapy — multiple or extended	\$50.00 (no rebate)
Ear syringing / wax irrigation	\$50.00 (no rebate)
Dressing — simple	\$15.00 (no rebate)
Dressing — standard	\$25.00 (no rebate)
Dressing — complex / ulcers	\$40.00 (no rebate)
Dressing — advanced / specialised	From \$50.00 (or to be advised)
Suture or staple removal — simple	\$25.00 (no rebate)
Suture or staple removal — complex	\$40.00 (no rebate)
Wound closure with tissue adhesive (glue) — surcharge	\$25.00 (added to the repair fee)
Blood glucose or urine dipstick — standalone nurse test	\$10.00 (no charge within a consultation)
Pregnancy test	\$10.00 (rebate available)

Repeat dressings within a short course of treatment are charged at a reduced rate — \$15.00 simple, \$20.00 standard, \$30.00 complex or packing — up to a weekly maximum of \$120.00. The nurse or doctor will confirm which fee applies to you. Specialised products may cost more.

Historical Immunisation Records (Australian Immunisation Register)

Service	Fee
Up to 5 historical vaccination entries	\$50.00 (no rebate)
6–15 historical vaccination entries	\$80.00 (no rebate)
Over 15 entries, multiple records, or complex overseas history	From \$150.00 (quoted before we start)
Clinical review or catch-up vaccination plan	GP consultation fee (rebate may apply)
