The Number 6

The number 6 is thought to represent man's weakness and inability to achieve perfection and sinlessness. Because of sin man must work for 6 days to remember his sin. 6 can also be seen as the number of evil and its full development. Rebellion will run its full course with the man of sin and the number of his name, 666.

The Number 7

The number 7 perhaps speaks of perfection or completeness. God's complete provision in His dealings with men. Some examples:

- 7 days make a complete week
- 7 colors make a perfect spectrum
- 7 great land masses form a complete earth
- 7 notes make a perfect scale
- 7 great bodies of water form a complete ocean

There were the 7 days of creation as well as many other examples throughout the Scriptures:

Zech 3:9 For behold, the stone that I have laid before Joshua: upon the stone are seven eyes.

The Number 8

The Number 8 is thought to represent the number of new beginnings. A male child was circumcised on the 8th day. The Sabbath lasted 7 days and the 8th day was the Lord's day, the new day. The number 8 speaks of Jesus and the New **Covenant**. The church met on the 8th day or the first day, the new day.

The Number 10

The number 10 is a very significant number in the Bible. In examining the uses of the number 10 in Scripture it seems to represent human failure and God's provision. For example:

- The 10 spies failed to see God's power and provision, so they brought back an evil report
 - . The number "ten" is used 242 times in the Bible ("tenth" is used 79 times).
1. A tithe (Heb. = *maasrah* meaning "a tenth") of 10% was to be given (Gen 28:22)(Lev 27:30-32)(Num 19:26) to God.
 2. God promised Abraham He would not destroy Sodom if 10 righteous men could be found there (Gen 18:32).
 3. God brought 10 plagues on Egypt (Ex 7:14-12:30).
 4. God caused the shadow on a sundial to go backwards 10 degrees (2 Kin 20:8-11).
 5. In the Temple were 10 lavers, 10 lampstands, and 10 tables (2 Chr 4:6-8).
 6. On the 10th day of the first month, a lamb was to be chosen for Passover (Ex 12:2-3).
 7. The 10 Commandments (Ex 20:1-17)(Deut 5:6-21).
 8. Jesus healed 10 lepers (Lk 17:11-19).
 9. Jesus told several parables which focus on the number 10: 10 virgins (Mt 25:1-13), 10 coins (Lk 15:8-10), 10 minas (Lk 19:11-27).
 10. There were 10 days between Jesus' ascension to Heaven and Pentecost:

The Number 12

2. The number 12 has been thought to represent the number of God's government. The ancient people recognized 12 lunar cycles corresponding loosely to 12 months in the year, and they divided the day and the night into 12-hour periods
3. The Bible tells that Jacob-Israel had 12 sons (Genesis 35:22-27) and that each of these became the founder of one of the Twelve Tribes of Israel, the people of God (Genesis 49:28). Jesus chose Twelve Apostles (Matthew 10:2-4) for the beginnings of the Church. There were 24 classes of priests and Levites (1 Chronicles 24:4) and 48 Levitical cities (Numbers 35:7).
4. And again in the Book of Revelation, the number 12 becomes very important when symbolizing the salvation of God's people. There are 24 elders around the throne of God and 144,000 of the saved (Revelation 4:4; 7:4). The perfection of the new Jerusalem is seen in its 12 gates, each "a single pearl," and 12 foundations, each adorned with jewels. Its circumference is 12,000 furlongs, and its walls are 144 cubits high (Revelation 21:10-21; Ezekiel 48:30-35).

5. The 12 sons/tribes of Jacob/Israel (Gen 35:22)(Gen 42:13,[32](#))(Gen 49:28)(Lk 22:30)(Acts 7:8)(Acts 26:7)(James 1:1)(Rev 21:12).

Angels in Bible

Christianity values the powerful spiritual beings called angels who love God and serve people on divine assignments. Though other words are used for these spiritual beings, the primary word used in the Bible is *angel*. Three other terms undoubtedly referring to angels are *seraphim* (Isa. 6:2), *cherubim* (Ezek. 10:1-3), and *ministering spirits*, which is perhaps more of a description than a name (Heb. 1:13).

- (1) For human messengers from one human to another (Luke 7:24; Jam. 2:25).
- (2) For human messengers bearing a divine message (Hag. 1:13; Gal. 4:14).
- (3) For an impersonal agent, Paul's thorn in the flesh described as "a messenger of Satan" (2 Cor. 12:7).

First Sphere, First Choir: Seraphim

The seraphim angels are in charge of guarding God's throne in heaven, and they surround it there, constantly praising God. In the Bible, the prophet Isaiah describes a vision he had of seraphim angels in heaven calling out: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). The Seraphim (meaning "burning ones") are lit from within with brilliant light that manifests their passionate love for God. One of their most famous members, Lucifer (whose name means "light bearer") was closest to God and known for his bright light, but fell from heaven and became a demon (Satan) when he decided to try to wrest God's power for himself and rebelled. In Luke 10:18 of the Bible, Jesus Christ described Lucifer's fall from heaven as looking "like lightning." Since Lucifer's fall, Christians consider the angel Michael to be the most powerful angel.

First Sphere, Second Choir: Cherubim

The cherubim angels protect God's glory, and they also keep records of what happens in the universe. They are known for their wisdom. Although cherubs are often portrayed in modern art as cute babies sporting tiny wings and big smiles, art from earlier eras depicts the cherubs as imposing creatures with four faces and four wings that are completely covered with eyes. The Bible describes cherubim on a divine mission to guard the tree of life in the Garden of Eden from humans who had fallen into sin: "After he [God] drove the man out, he placed on the east side of the Garden of Eden cherubim and a flaming sword flashing back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life" Genesis 3:24).

First Sphere, Third Choir: Thrones

Throne angels are known for their concern for God's justice. They often work to right wrongs in our fallen world. The Bible mentions the Thrones angelic rank (as well as the principalities and dominions) in Colossians 1:16: "For by him [Jesus Christ] were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him."

Second Sphere, Fourth Choir: Dominions

Members of the dominion angelic choir regulate the other angels and supervise how they perform their God-given duties. Dominions also often act as channels of mercy for God's love to flow from him to others in the universe.

Second Sphere, Fifth Choir: Virtues

Virtues work to encourage human beings to strengthen their faith in God, such as by inspiring people and helping them grow in holiness. They often visit Earth to perform miracles that God has empowered them to perform in response to people's prayers. Virtues also watch over the natural world God has created on Earth.

Second Sphere, Sixth Choir: Powers

Members of the powers choir engage in spiritual warfare against demons. They also help human beings overcome the temptation to sin and giving them the courage they need to choose good over evil.

Third Sphere, Seventh Choir: Principalities

The principality angels encourage people to pray and practice spiritual disciplines that will help them grow closer to God. They work to educate people in the arts and sciences, communicating inspiring ideas in response to people's prayers. Principalities also oversee the various nations on Earth and help deliver wisdom to national leaders as they face decisions about how best to govern people.

Third Sphere, Eighth Choir: Archangels

The meaning of this choir's name is distinct from the other use of the word "archangels." While many people think of archangels as the highest-ranking angels in heaven (and Christians recognize some famous ones, such as Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael), this angelic choir is made up of angels who mainly focus on the task of delivering God's messages to humans. The name "archangel" is from the Greek words "arche" (ruler) and "angelos" (messenger), hence the name of this choir. Some of the other, higher-ranked angels do participate in delivering divine messages to people, however.

Third Sphere, Ninth Choir: Angels

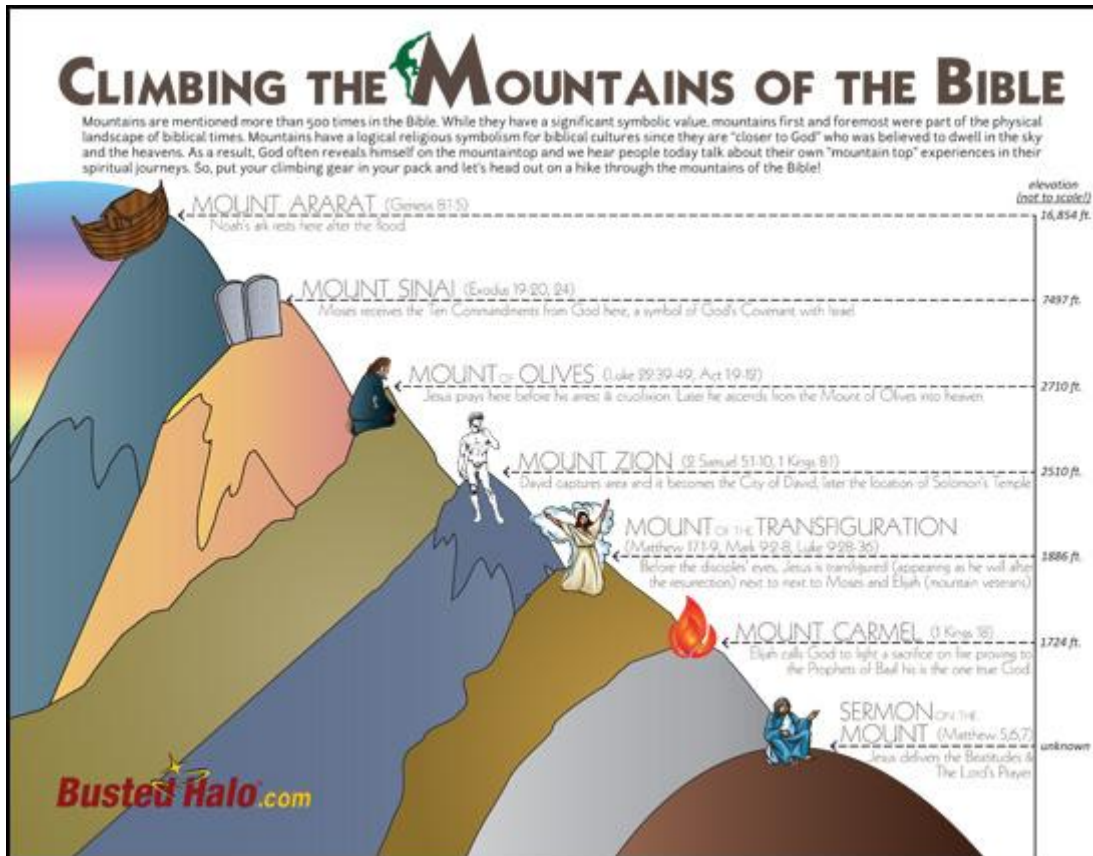
Guardian angels are members of this choir, which is closest to humans. They protect, guide, and pray for people in all aspects of human life.

- Cherubim Angels: Guarding God's Glory
- Throne Angels: Revealing Holy Mysteries
- Dominion Angels: Keeping the World in Order

Mountains in the Bible

Mountains have a significant place the Bible. Major biblical events took place in this place. So I gather the 7 most prominent and gave some brief info:

1. Ararat (Genesis 8:4) – after the global flood, the ark of Noah rested here till the waters subdued and after that everyone in the ark came out and propagate.
2. Moriah (Genesis 22:2) – this is the place Abraham offered Isaac. Eventually in the reign of King Solomon, his temple for God was built over there (2 Chronicles 3:1).
3. Sinai (Number 3:10)-this is where God gave the 10 Commandments (Exodus 20) to Moses.
4. Carmel- this mountain had a showdown between Elijah (the prophet of God) versus Baal's prophets (1 Kings 18: 17-46).
5. Mount of Beatitudes- (Matthew 5:1) scholars' points out this place is located within the vicinity of Capernaum where greatest sermon ever delivered by Christ Himself.
6. Calvary- Golgotha or the place of skull, this mountain (technically it's a hill like the Mount of Beatitudes) this is where our Lord and Savior was nail to the cross and died for God and our sins (Mark 15:22).
7. Mount of Olive or Olivet- lots of evens in Jesus earthly ministry occurred here. Most notable events is on this place Jesus ascended back to heaven (Acts 1:12).



SIGNIFICANT GARDENS OF SCRIPTURE"

PLEASE READ IN THE BIBLE (GENESIS 2:8, 15-17; 3:8, 23, 24)(JOHN 18:1; 19:41)(SONG/SOLOMON 4:12-15; 5:1)(LUKE 23:43)

The various gardens mentioned in scripture are significant and can be considered in a manner that is illustrative of the gospel and "God's Way of Salvation". The Bible, the Word of God begins and ends with events that are recorded in a garden. In this message we want to consider **five** "Significant Gardens of Scripture" which include the following:

1. **THE GARDEN OF REBELLION (EDEN) – (Genesis 2:8, 15-17; 3:23, 24)**
2. **THE GARDEN OF REJECTION (GETHSEMANE) – (John 18:1) (Matthew 26:36-42)**
3. **THE GARDEN OF REDEMPTION (CALVARY) – (John 19:41)**
4. **THE GARDEN OF RECEPTION – (Song of Solomon 4:12-15; 5:1)**
5. **THE GARDEN OF REJOICING (PARADISE/HEAVEN) – (Luke 23:43)**

1. THE GARDEN OF REBELLION (EDEN)

SATAN came into this garden.

SIN came into this garden

SORROW came into this garden.

The SOVEREIGN came into this garden.

We read that after Adam fell into sin, (Genesis 3:8, 9) “They heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the tree’s of the garden. And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, where art thou”?

SEPARATION (death) came into this garden.

God previously said that man’s sin and disobedience would result in death. God said to Adam, regarding the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, (Genesis 2:17) “Thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof **thou shalt surely die**”

20. THE GARDEN OF REJECTION (GETHSEMANE)

- **Jesus went forth – to Anticipation.**

Jesus went forth – to Agony. It says in, (Luke 22:44) “And **being in an agony** He prayed more earnestly: and His sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground”.

Jesus went forth – to Arrest. It says concerning the Lord Jesus, (Isaiah 53:3) “He is despised and **rejected** of men, a Man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief”

Jesus went forth – to Abandonment. It says in, (Matthew 26:56) “Then all the disciples forsook Him and fled”. Jesus was left alone to accomplish the work of redemption on the cross.

21. THE GARDEN OF REDEMPTION – (CALVARY)

We read in, (John 19:41) “Now in the place where He was crucified **there was a garden, and in the garden** a new sepulcher”.

(1 Peter 3:18) “For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God”.

22. THE GARDEN OF RECEPTION

(Song of Solomon 4:12-15) “A garden enclosed is my sister, my spouse, a spring shut up, a fountain sealed. Thy plants are an orchard of pomegranates, with pleasant fruits, camphire, with spikenard, etc. A fountain of gardens, a well of living waters, and streams from Lebanon”.

23. THE GARDEN OF REJOICING – (PARADISE/HEAVEN) (Luke 23:42, 43) “And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, today shalt thou be **with Me in paradise**”.

24. (Psalm 16:11) “In thy (God’s) presence **is fullness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures forever more**”.

O the joy and rejoicing, even now, with the prospect of Heaven as ones eternal dwelling place. **Which will it be for You dear reader, Heaven or Hell? Will it be “the pleasures of sin for a season” (Hebrews 11:25), or will it be the blessedness of heaven and its eternal pleasures?**
