1.. Salvation – God's Free Gift

2. Repentance – Turning Away from Sin

We believe that repentance means turning away from sin and turning toward God.

When we repent, we are sorry for our sins, and we ask God to forgive us and change our hearts.

"Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out."
— *Acts 3:19*

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us."
— *1 John 1:9*

3. Faith – Trusting in Jesus

We believe that faith is trusting in Jesus—believing that He is God's Son, that He died for us, and that He is alive today.

We are saved when we put our faith in Him.

"Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved."
— *Acts 16:31*

"Without faith it is impossible to please God."

— *Hebrews 11:6*

4. Baptism – A Sign of New Life

We believe that baptism shows the world that we belong to Jesus.

It is a symbol of dying to sin and rising to new life in Christ.

"Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved."

— *Mark 16:16*

"We were buried with Him by baptism into death... so we too might walk in newness of life."

— *Romans 6:4*

5. Communion – Remembering Jesus' Love

We believe that communion is a way for believers to remember what Jesus did on the cross.

The bread reminds us of His body, and the cup reminds us of His blood.

"This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me."

— *1 Corinthians 11:24*

"Whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes."

— *1 Corinthians 11:26*
