- Why is Jesus called our Prince of Peace?
- What is the Second Coming of Christ, and how can you prepare for it?
- Why is repentance necessary for salvation?
- What does it mean to work out your salvation with fear and trembling?
- How does baptism symbolize a new life in Christ?
- Why did God choose those specific plagues to be sent to Egypt?

3. Impromptu Speaking

- > The Participant will blindly select ONE slip of paper from the container or envelope.
- The Participant will hand the slip to the Moderator, who will read the question/statement to the Participant and Judges.
- > The Moderator will return the slip of paper to the envelope.
- ➤ The Participants will deliver their responses at that time within 5 minutes.

- 4) <u>Describe the Armor of God</u> (Ephesians 6:13-17)
- ➤ Discuss the connection between the actual armor item, such as the belt, sword, helmet, etc., and the spiritual elements, such as faith, salvation, spirit, etc.?
- > (i.e., Does it matter that the helmet is related to Salvation? What if the helmet was related to faith instead?)
