2. How do you honor your parents according to the Ten Commandments?
3. How does reading the Bible help you through daily life?
4. In what way has your favorite Bible character impacted your life?
5. What does being a Christian mean to you?
6. Which fruit of the Spirit does the bible say is the “Greatest Of All” and why?
7. What does God want you to understand from the Gospels?

3. Impromptu Speaking

- *The maximum time is 5 minutes to answer the question*
- *The questions will be in a container or envelope, with one question per slip of paper.*
- *The Participant will blindly select ONE slip of paper from the container or envelope.*
- *The Participant will hand the slip to the Moderator, who will read the question/statement to the Participant and Judges.*
- *The Moderator will return the slip of paper to the envelope.*
- *The Participants will deliver their responses at that time within 5 minutes*

Psalm 91

Psalm 91: 1-16

- 1) vs 1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2) vs 2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust."
- 3) vs 3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler And from the perilous pestilence.
- 4) vs 4 He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler.
- 5) vs 5 You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day,
- 6) vs 6 Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.
- 7) vs 7 A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; But it shall not come near you.
- 8) vs 8 Only with your eyes shall you look, And see the reward of the wicked.
- 9) vs 9 Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place,
- 10) vs 10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;
- 11) vs 11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.
- 12) vs 12 In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.
- 13) vs 13 You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, The young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot.
- 14) vs 14 Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name.

Ephesians 6:10-20

- 15) vs 10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.
- 16) vs 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

17) vs 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*.

18) vs 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

19) vs 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness,

20) vs 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

21) vs 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

22) vs 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

23) vs 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—

24) vs 19 and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel,

25) vs 20 for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

26) Psalm 27: 1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear?

27) Joshua 1:9 Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go.

28) Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the LORD your God, He *is* the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.

29) Proverbs 9:9 Give instruction to a wise *man*, and he will be still wiser; Teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning

30) Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.

31) Proverbs 11:3 The integrity of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.

32) Proverbs 21:21 He who follows righteousness and mercy finds life, righteousness, and honor.

33) 1 Samuel 2:2: No one is holy like the LORD, For *there is* none besides You, Nor *is there* any rock like our God.

34) Psalm 96:9 Worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness! Tremble before Him, all the earth

35) Psalm 7:17 I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness

36) Psalm 29:2 Worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness.

37) Matthew 6:33 Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness

38) Psalm 89:14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne

Psalm 103:6-11

39) vs 6 The Lord executes righteousness. And justice for all who are oppressed.

40) vs 7 He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel.

41) vs 8 The Lord is merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy.

42) vs 9 He will not always strive with us, Nor will He keep His anger forever.

43) vs 10 He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor punished us according to our iniquities.

44) vs 11 For as the heavens are high above the earth, So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him

Psalm 23:1-6

45) vs 1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.

46) vs 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures;
He leads me beside the still waters.

47) vs 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake.

48) vs 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

49) vs 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

50) vs 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me, all the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
