1. Bible Memory Verses Recitation

- > 50 verses, 7 minutes maximum
- ➤ Key below

2. Gospel Basics

- > Judges will ask 5 questions
- ➤ Maximum 1 minute per answer
- Why is God called our Wonderful, Counselor?
- From the Seven Words on the Cross, which one of the 7 teaches us about HIS character and why?
- What is the Lord's Supper or Communion?
- Why is repentance important to a Christian Believer?
- Why do we call Grace, amazing?
- How does baptism symbolize a new life in Christ?
- How has the perspective of sin changed from the Old Testament to the New Testament?
- What is prayer, and how does it help you get closer to God?
- How can you share the good news of salvation through Christ with non-Christians?

3. Impromptu Speaking

- > Maximum time 5 minutes to answer the question
- > The three questions will be in a container or envelope, with one question per slip of paper.
- > The Participant will blindly select ONE slip of paper from the container or envelope.
- > The Participant will hand the slip to the Moderator, who will read the question/statement to the Participant and Judges.
- > The Moderator will return the slip of paper to the envelope.
- > The Participants will deliver their responses at that time within 5 minutes.

- ➤ Include thoughts on God's unconditional Love and Forgiveness, Repentance, Grace, Self-righteousness, and Reconciliation as part of your answer.
- 2) What do we learn from the parable of the Good Samaritan? (Luke 10:25-37)
- > Include thoughts on Love and compassion as part of your answer.

- 3) <u>Discuss the meaning of Jesus' Seven Last Words on the Cross</u>.(Matthew 27:46, Mark 15:34, Luke 23:34, Luke 23:43, Luke 23:46 John 19: 26-30)
- ➤ Include references to salvation, God's love, repentance, and atonement as part of your answer.
- > Pick 3 of the Last Words to discuss

4) Describe the Armor of God

- > Discuss whether there is any connection between the actual armor item, such as the belt, sword, helmet, etc., and the spiritual elements, such as faith, salvation, spirit, etc
- > (i.e., Does it matter that the helmet is related to Salvation? What if the helmet was related to faith instead?)

- 32. The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent. Acts 17:30
- 33. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

Jesus Miracles

- 34. Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." Immediately, his leprosy was cleansed. Matthew 8:3
- 35. Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!" And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. Mark 4:39
- 36. Then He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke them and gave them to the disciples to set before the multitude. Luke 9:16

Word of God

- 37. How can a young man cleanse his way? By taking heed according to Your word. Psalm 119:9
- 38. As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him. Psalm 18:30
- 39. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John 1:1

Prayer

- 40. My voice You shall hear in the morning, O LORD; In the morning I will direct it to You, And I will look up. Psalm 5:3
- 41. The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth. Psalm 145:18

- 42. Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 1 John 5:14
- 43. Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak. Matthew 26:41
- 44. Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16

Kindness

- 45. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Galatians 5:22-23
- 46. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgave you. Ephesians 4:32
- 47. May the Lord show you kindness and faithfulness 2 Samuel 15:20
- 48. Do to others as you would have them do to you. Luke 6:31
- 49. Show me unfailing kindness like the LORD's kindness as long as I live 1 Samuel 20:14
- 50. Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering. Colossians 3:12
