2. The Second Word: "I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43)
3. The Third Word: "Dear woman, here is your son." (John 19:26)
4. The Fourth Word: "My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?" (Mark 15:34)
5. The Fifth Word: "I am thirsty." (John 19:28)
6. The Sixth Word: "It is finished!" (John 19:30)
7. The Seventh Word: "Father, I entrust my spirit into your hands!" (Luke 23:46)

7 days of Creation Genesis 1

1. *Day 1-* God created the heavens and the earth. He created light and darkness, day and night.
2. *Day 2-* God separated the waters and created the sky.
3. *Day 3-* God created the land and the sea and seed-bearing plants and trees.
4. *Day 4-* God created the sun and moon and stars.
5. *Day 5-* God created creatures that lived in water and flew in the air.

6. *Day 6-* God created creatures on the land. He also created man and woman - both in his image. He gave authority for the man and woman to rule over the other creatures. He gave them seed bearing plants as food. (Note that he did not give the animals as food at this point. The Bible does not mention anything about eating anything other than the seed-bearing and green plants until Genesis 9:3, after the flood.)
7. *Day 7-* God rested from his work and declared the day holy.

After each day's work, God declared that it was good.
