The Richland Kennel Club (RKC), Inc. membership application process is as follows:

- The membership application needs to be filled out completely and returned in person at a RKC meeting or submitted via email to <u>Richlandkc386@gmail.com</u>.
 - Due to Covid the RKC meetings are presently being held via Zoom. Once your application is received you will be invited to attend a Zoom meeting.
 - General meetings are held the first Thursday of each month at 7:00pm, unless otherwise noted. Please note that some of these dates will fall on the Club's social gathering dates.
- Club members will sign the bottom of the application after it is returned.
- Candidate for membership must attend a meeting before the application can be read.
- Reading of the application process:
 - Application is read at a general meeting.
 - Application is read and reviewed at a board meeting and board makes motion to return it for approval to the general club membership.
 - Application is voted on at the next general meeting for acceptance in the Club. If accepted, payment of dues are as follows:
 - ✓ Dues are 10\$ for Junior (up to 18 years of age), \$15 for individual and \$25 for a family application.
