WHY DO A CRYOSKIN FACIAL INSTEAD OF BOTOX OR FILLERS?

Fillers just fill in the wrinkles, Botox just paralyses the muscle, whereas a Cryoskin facial treatment has multiple effects that are not only visible but also internal and that help to have a healthier skin long term.

A Cryoskin facial uses the cold of the wand and the warmth of the therapists hand for a pumping effect on the superficial blood and lymphatic system. The blood system will alternate the vasoconstrictor and vasodilator reflex for a pumping effect. As a result, the whole microcirculation of the blood will increase, carrying more oxygen and nutrients to the cells.

The production of collagen and elastin will rise due to the extreme cold triggering the fibroblasts deep in the dermis, improving the quality and elasticity of the skin. The skin pores will retract under the action of the cold, resulting in a glowing effect on the face. The treatment will also help to drain the lymph of the face, which will appear less puffy and more illuminated.

The cold also has an anti-inflammatory benefit too, reducing redness, in particular rosacea, and minimizing the eye-bags as well as the inflammation of spots. The appearance of fine lines and wrinkles is improved. The face looks younger and fresher. The effect is instantaneous and visible. The benefit is holistic: aesthetic and physiological, and the result more natural.

A client can receive a Cryoskin Facial every week, even every 3-4 days. Usually, the client comes for one session every week for the recommended amount of weeks discussed at the time the package was purchased based on the needs and wants if the client, followed by one session every month for maintenance. This will help to maintain a higher production of fibroblast (collagen + elastin).

Cryoskin is non-invasive, non-painful, and more reliable than Botox. It encourages your skin to behave as it did during your twenties. It can be used to look younger, to improve your skin's appearance, or even to help with weight loss in a separate treatment.

In NJ, Botox runs about \$200-\$400 (or more) per treatment area. Not per visit. Cryoskin treats the entire neck and the face in one 30 minute visit.

Cryoskin Facials aren't just anti-aging, they are also recommended to treat skin issues like sensitive skin, dermatitis, acne (stages 1 and 2) and rosacea, as the cold helps to reduce inflammation and redness.

The whole treatment takes about half an hour, and clients find it to be incredibly relaxing, especially when the wand was motioned back and forth along the forehead.

The effects of a Cryoskin facial are not permanent, as the skin naturally ages on a daily basis, so it is recommended to visit us monthly after your series to maintain the results achieved.

Risks following Botox (Mayo Clinic)

Botox injections are usually safe when you're under the care of a licensed and skilled health care provider. The procedure can result in unwanted results or even cause harm if it's given incorrectly. Possible side effects and unwanted results include:

- Pain, swelling or bruising at the injection site.
- Headache or flu-like symptoms.
- Droopy eyelids or crooked eyebrows.
- A crooked smile or drooling.
- Watery or dry eyes.
- Infection at the injection site.

Rarely, the medicine may spread to parts of the body where it isn't supposed to go. It can cause symptoms there. Call your health care provider right away if you have any of these symptoms hours or weeks after your procedure:

- Muscle weakness.
- Vision problems.
- Trouble talking or swallowing.
- Breathing problems.
- Allergic reaction.
- Loss of bladder control.

Other possible perils include:

Allergic reactions as a rejection from the body which can be detrimental to vision
and eye health

- Irritations noticeable by bloodshot eyes and temporarily blurred vision
- Vascular occlusion, otherwise referred to as a decline of blood flow (blindness)

Risk following Fillers:

Severe complications from dermal fillers are uncommon. Potential risks vary depending on the specific filler used and the relative permanence of the filler substance and include:

- Acne-like skin eruptions
- Asymmetry
- Bleeding from the injection site
- Bruising
- Damage to the skin that results in a wound and possible scarring
- Infection at the injection site
- Lumps
- Palpability of the filler under the surface of the skin
- Skin necrosis (ulceration or loss of skin from disruption of blood flow)
- Skin rash with itching
- Skin redness
- Swelling
- Under- or over-correction of wrinkles

In very rare cases, the filler may accidentally be injected into your blood vessels instead of under your skin. This can block blood flow. What happens if your blood flow is blocked will vary depending on where the block is. If your skin is affected, you might have skin loss or wounds. If your eye is affected, you might lose your eyesight or go blind.
