Pop-up Women's Choir


Ladies, here's an opportunity to sing in a treble choir



The pantry served 287 households in the month of December 2024. The monthly average for 2024 was 272 households. The number of volunteer hours for December totaled 525 spread across six different churches. The pantry received 3,400 pounds of donated food that month and approximately \$12,000 in monetary donations from individuals, businesses and congregation gifts.
