## **ORDINANCE 675-23**

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEAN GATE, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE NO. 671-23 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BEACH, BOARDWALK, PIER AND BATHING REGULATIONS"**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Ocean Gate has found and determined a need to establish and update beach, boardwalk, pier and bathing regulations originally established by Ordinance No. 671-23, which is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

#### **SECTION I**

Badges are required for all individuals over 12 years old for use of the beach, pavilions and piers between June 15<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day.

No person shall:

- a. Have a fire on beach.
- b. Possess or consume any alcoholic beverages on any beach, boardwalk, pavilion or pier.
- c. Charge electric vehicles on piers, pavilions or at any comfort station.
- d. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 and 40:48-2, the smoking and/or burning of a lighted cigar, cigarette or pipe, including any handheld electronic device which vaporizes a liquid (e.g., e-cigarettes, e-cigs, electronic nicotine delivery systems, electronic non-nicotine delivery systems, personal vaporizers, PVs), or any other matter or substance which contains tobacco, marijuana, cannabis, cannabis item, or any other matter that can be smoked, is prohibited on the Boardwalk, Beach, Piers or Pavilions.
- e. No picnicking on any beach, boardwalk, pier or pavilion.

#### **SECTION II**

No person shall use any anchor or mooring device on any part of the beach between the boardwalk and the low water line, other than flat anchors. Each and every anchor shall be completely buried in the ground.

#### **SECTION III**

No person shall ride any skateboard, roller skates, roller blades, hover board, segway, scooter, gas powered vehicle or electric vehicle on the boardwalk, beach or pier at any time. Motorized equipment for persons with disabilities is exempt. Bicycles are permitted on the boardwalk from June 15<sup>th</sup> until the day after Labor Day between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 am. Bicycles are allowed on the boardwalk at any time from the day after Labor Day until June 14<sup>th</sup>.

#### **SECTION IV**

No person shall have, take, permit or allow any dog or other domestic pet, either on or off the leash, on any boardwalk, beach, pier or in the water of the Toms River which is adjacent to any boardwalk, beach or pier at any time of the year.

#### **SECTION V**

No person shall engage in the playing of ball, either soft ball, hard ball or football, the throwing of stones or other hard objects on any boardwalk, beach or pier.

## **SECTION VI**

No person shall do anything on the beach, boardwalk or pier which is annoying, objectionable or dangerous to any other person.

## **SECTION VII**

No person shall, permit or allow any boat or personal watercraft;

a. On the beach between the boardwalk and the low water mark of the Toms River in the area of this Borough from Ocean Gate Avenue to the easterly side of Asbury Avenue.

b. On the beach between the boardwalk and the low water mark of the Toms River, in the area of this Borough from the Wildwood Avenue Pier to the easterly side of Stone Harbor Avenue.

c. On the beach between the boardwalk and the low water mark of the Toms River in the area from the Anglesea Avenue Pier eastwardly for a distance of 500 feet

d. On the beach between the boardwalk and the low water mark of the Toms River in the area of this Borough from a point fifty feet west of Monmouth Avenue to a point fifty feet east of Monmouth Avenue.

e. On the beach between the boardwalk and the low water mark of the Toms River in the area of this Borough from the east Borough line westerly for a distance of 300 feet.

## **SECTION VIII**

No person shall moor or anchor a boat in the Toms River, in the Borough of Ocean Gate, between the low water mark on the Borough's water front and:

a. A line parallel therewith and 300 feet north thereof in any area now or hereafter designates and used for public bathing beach or beaches; or

b. A line parallel therewith and 100 feet north thereof in any area not a public bathing beach; or

c. For the safety of all residents and visitors to the Borough of Ocean gate, as well as for the safety of all boats used and moored in the waters within the Borough, no person shall moor or anchor a boat using submerged motors, flywheels, blocks or cement or concrete, tin cans or containers filled with concrete, or other such items as such anchor or mooring device. Safe and adequate mooring, such as, mushroom anchors, wishbone, stockless, plow, porter, northill or light-weight type anchors may be used.

## **SECTION XIX**

No person shall engage in crabbing or fishing on either the Wildwood Avenue pier or the Anglesea Avenue Pier other than between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. and between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

## **SECTION X**

No person shall, at any time, tie a boat up or otherwise fasten a boat to the easterly sideline of either the Wildwood Avenue pier or the Anglesea Avenue pier.

## **SECTION XI**

No person shall robe or disrobe in any car, truck, van or public place in the Borough. This section shall not apply to outer clothing or to children under the age of five years.

## **SECTION XII**

All items (beach chairs, towels, umbrellas, floats etc.), except properly registered boats, shall be removed from the beach no later than midnight of each day.

**SECTION XIII**

No person shall race or drive a boat at any excessive and unreasonable speed within 300 feet of the beach or within 100 feet of the public piers.

**SECTION XIV**

No person shall engage in aquaplaning or water skiing within 300 feet of the beach or within 100 feet of the public piers.

**SECTION XV**

All littering of any nature or kind by any person, firm or corporation upon any portions of the beaches, boardwalk, piers, bathing areas and municipal parking lots located in the beach areas of the Borough is prohibited.

**SECTION XVI**

Any person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a penalty of a fine not exceeding \$200.00, at the discretion of the Magistrate before whom such conviction is had

**SECTION XVII**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION XVIII**

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption, approval and publication as required by law.

## ORDINANCE 676-23

### AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING ORDINANCE 593-15 TO ESTABLISH COSTS AND FEES AND PERMIT REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF ANY SERVICE CONNECTION TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM IN THE BOROUGH OF OCEAN GATE, OR ANY APPROVED CONNECTION TO THE BOROUGH'S WATER SYSTEM FROM ADJOINING BERKELEY TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Ocean Gate (Borough) is obliged to protect the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council finds and determines that for the general welfare of its citizens that it is necessary and advisable to establish costs and fees to be borne by property owners associated with the construction and installation of any service connection to the municipal water system.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Ocean Gate, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

#### **SECTION I**

Notwithstanding any other prior Ordinance adopted by the Borough of Ocean Gate, the laws, rules, and regulations regarding the Water System shall be and are hereby amended as follows:

#### **SECTION II**

- A. No person shall uncover, connect with, make any opening into or use, alter or disturb in any manner any water service line or the water system without first obtaining a permit in writing from the Borough of Ocean Gate. Permits shall be issued to owners required to connect to the water system.
- B. If any owner fails to comply with the provisions of this Subsection A, in addition to other penalties, the Borough may engage the services of a registered or licensed plumber to make the required connection. Prior to doing so, the Borough shall notify the delinquent owner, in writing, of its intention to have the work done at the owner's expense, unless the work is completed by the owner within 15 days of the mailing of the notice, or such later date as may be consented to by the Borough's authorized agent. If the work is not completed within that period by the owner, the Borough shall proceed to have the work done, and the Borough Engineer shall certify the cost to the Borough. The Borough shall then notify the owner when and where the Borough Council will examine the certification and any objections will be heard at that time. The Borough, after a hearing, will determine the correctness of the certification and cause. The cost as shown or as corrected by the Borough will be added to the water bill for the property in question, and the amount of the charge shall become a lien upon the lands upon filing with the collector of water rents. The charge shall bear interest at the same rate as taxes and shall be collected and enforced by the collector of water rents.
- C. Application for the permit required shall be made by the owner of the improved property to be served or by his authorized representative.
- D. No person shall make or cause to be made a connection of any new or improved property to the Borough water system until a permit has been issued by the Borough. That person shall have given the Borough's

authorized agent at least 24 hours' notice of the time when the connection will be made so that the Borough's authorized agent may supervise and inspect the work of connection and, when necessary, supervise the testing. The permit fee for the connection and related inspection shall be \$500.00. The authorized agent for all new construction or significant improvements will be the Borough's certified plumbing inspector.

- E. The permit shall be displayed prominently upon the improved property to be connected all times during construction of the water service line and connection of the building thereto.
- F. Installation of all service lines from the curb stop or repair work shall be performed by a licensed plumber duly qualified to perform such work at the expense of the applicant. All service connection pipes shall be installed at least four feet below the surface. No rigid connection to any other water distribution system shall be made. The owner shall indemnify and save harmless the Borough from all loss or damage that may be caused, directly or indirectly, because of construction of a water service line. All water meters must be located within the interior footprint of the premises.
- G. The service connection shall, as far as practical, be installed at right angles to the main and in a straight line to the meter. There shall be no attachment from which water may be drawn between the main and the meter.
- H. Service pipe shall be installed only through the property of the applicant, unless the applicant enjoys an easement or right-of-way for that purpose, duly recorded.
- I. Water pipe shall not be installed in the same excavation or trench with sewer pipe unless the same shall be separated vertically by at least two feet above the sewer.
- J. All service connection pipe from the main to the curb stop shall consist of Type K copper tubing or Borough approved alternative pipe and shall be installed by the Borough or Owner's approved contractor at the sole cost and expense of property owner. Costs shall include but not be limited to excavation, taps, connections, piping valves, dewatering, road restoration, permits and all items connected directly to the servicing of the individual property. The service line from the main to the curb stop shall be maintained by the Borough.
- K. The copper tubing or approved alternative pipe shall be no less than one inch in size for all domestic lines and of such larger size as shall be approved by the Borough for commercial and industrial buildings and multiple residences.
- L. The property owner shall be responsible for the maintenance of the service line from the curb stop to the meter or interior of the building and shall keep the same in good repair and protect it from damage due to frost or other causes. All leaks in the service lines shall be reported promptly to the Borough and repaired by the owner. The owner shall be liable for water escaping from leaks at a charge estimated by the Borough based upon the estimated quantity of water escaping. If repairs are not made the Borough may shut off the water and refuse to turn it on again until the line is put in serviceable condition.
- M. Only an employee/agent or approved contractor of the Borough shall turn water on or off at the curb stop.



- N. No service connection shall be permitted to serve two or more buildings or structures from a single tap except upon a special permit granted by the Borough, and if granted, a separate and distinct curb stop and box shall be provided for each building or structure.
- O. Owners, their agents, employees, or independent contractors may do excavation, ditch preparation and plumbing work involved in the construction of a water service line upon receipt of a connection permit from the Borough and subject to compliance with these regulations and inspection requirements.
- P. All contractors, before performing any work involving the construction of a building water service line or the connection of a building water service line to a water main, shall register with the Borough's authorized agent, giving their name, business and home address, telephone numbers and the amount and nature of their experience, and shall provide a certificate of insurance in a form satisfactory to the Borough and shall name the Borough as an additional insured entity .
- Q. Any person who violates any one or more sections of this article shall be subject to a fine for each violation of up to \$1,000 and/or a jail term of up to 90 days.

### **SECTION III**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

### **SECTION IV**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

### **SECTION V**

#### **Ocean Gate has the following requirements to tap into their water main.**

- A. The contractor needs to be qualified and insured to perform the wet tap and water service installation up to the curb stop.
- B. The contractor will need to provide documentation to the Borough regarding their qualifications and insurance, which shall name the Borough of Ocean Gate as an additional insured entity.
- C. Ocean Gate must be notified 24 hours in advance when the wet tap will be accomplished to ensure an inspection can be completed by the borough's agent before any backfill. Pictures of the wet tap and curb stop are required.
- D. Ocean Gate must be notified when the water meter will be installed. Water service to the home should not occur until a meter is installed. After meter installation, normal water service and billing begins.

### **SECTION VI**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption, approval and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMENDING AND REPEAL ORDINANCE 603-16 AND ORDINANCE 639-21 ALL BOROUGH ORDINANCES REGULATING BEACH, BOARDWALK, PIERS AND BATHING REGULATIONS AND TO REGULATE SPLASH PARK FEES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR THE BOROUGH OF OCEAN GATE, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Ocean Gate, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION I**

Purpose. The purpose of the within ordinance is to establish the fees, times, and rules and regulations for the use by the public of the Borough's Splash Pad facility.

**SECTION II**

Hours of Operation. The Splash Pad is open from ~~10:00~~ 10:00 am to 4:30 pm, Sunday through Saturday, during the scheduled Borough of Ocean Gate beach season.

Fees. All patrons, regardless of age, are required to have Borough of Ocean Gate badges for entrance into the Splash Pad area.

1. Borough Splash Pad badges are available at the following rates:
  - a. ~~Residential~~ Seasonal badge - \$~~40.00~~ 20.00 (On or before June 15<sup>th</sup>).
  - b. ~~Nonresidential~~ Seasonal badge - \$~~45.00~~ 25.00 (After June 15<sup>th</sup>).
  - c. Daily badge - \$~~4.00~~ 5.00.
2. Borough Splash Pad badges can be purchased in the following locations:
  - a. Splash Pad – from June 15<sup>th</sup> to Labor Day during operating hours.
  - b. Borough Hall – all year round during normal business hours.
3. All Borough beach badges will be accepted for admission into the splash pad area.
4. No refunds for lost or stolen badges.

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**Admissions.**

1. The splash pad area is intended for children between the ages of three (3) and twelve (12) years of age. All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. No more than five (5) children per parent or legal guardian.
2. Any group attending as an organized function, including church groups, day care facilities, sports teams, athletic training classes, junior sailing programs, etc. must

contact the Borough of Ocean Gate in advance of the visit. Additionally, the group must have a valid certificate of liability insurance presented to the Borough.

3. The Splash Pad has a maximum capacity of thirty (30) people. The Borough of Ocean Gate reserves the right to limit capacity at its discretion.

### SECTION III

#### Rules and Regulations.

1. Family-oriented swimwear must be worn when in the splash pad area.
2. Surfaces may be hot and slippery. Slip-resistant footwear is highly recommended at all times for safety and enjoyment.
3. Flip-flops shall be prohibited in the splash pad area.
4. Having fun is permissible and highly encouraged.
5. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
6. No running, rough play, illegal, disruptive, destructive, or inappropriate behavior.
7. Climbing, hanging, swinging, pulling, sitting or standing on Splash Park features is strictly prohibited and is grounds for immediate removal from the Splash Park area.
8. No blocking or obstructing the water from Splash Park fixtures or drains with face, hands, or objects.
9. No spitting, spouting of water, nose blowing, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the Splash Park area. Drinking the water is prohibited.
10. Smoking and littering are strictly prohibited.
11. The following items are prohibited from the splash pad area:
  - a. Beach toys, water toys, or athletic equipment, including, but not limited to, water balloons, water guns, beach balls, pool noodles, balls, bats, sticks, etc.
  - b. Skateboards, bicycles, scooters, rollerblades, strollers, or other wheeled devices in the Splash Park area.
  - c. Animals, except for service animals.
  - d. Glass objects, including, but not limited to, cups, bottles, containers, etc.
  - e. Electrical equipment, appliances, radios or amplified devices.
  - f. Food, beverages, or gum, except for plastic bottles or containers.
  - g. Tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs.
  - h. Portable chairs.
  - i. Soap, shampoos, conditioners, body lotions, body washes, suntan or sunscreen lotion, or any other lotion that may cause the splash pad surface to become slippery if directly applied to such surface.
12. Any person show evidence of any communicable skin diseases, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
13. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.

14. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
15. All children in diapers must wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.
16. Diapers are to be changed outside the Spray Park area and disposed of properly.
17. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to an attendant.
18. All persons shall shower before entering the splash pad.
19. Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
20. Use the Splash Park area at your own risk. No lifeguard is on duty.
21. The Borough of Ocean Gate is not responsible for loss or damaged personal property.
22. The Borough of Ocean Gate reserves the right to close the Splash Park and immediate area due to maintenance requirements, health & safety reasons, and inclement weather. Do not enter or remain in the Splash Park area when the park is closed to the public.
23. The Borough of Ocean Gate, through its designated agents, reserves the right to remove or cause to be removed a patron or spectator from the Splash Park for violating any of the above rules. Abuse of personnel in the conduct of their duty or any behavior causing annoyance to personnel is also grounds for removal. Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.

25. For emergencies, call 911.

#### SECTION IV

##### Signage.

1. Appropriate signage shall be posted in a conspicuous area at the Splash Pad with a copy of the Rules and Regulations.
2. All signage required by law shall be posted at the Splash Pad.

#### SECTION V

Penalties. Violations of this section may be subject the offender to ejection from the Splash Pad and/or revocation of his/her privileges to use the Splash Pad.

#### SECTION VI



All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### SECTION VII

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

ORDINANCE 679-23

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 390-95, 482-04 AND 555-11 ENTITLED  
"ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF OCEAN GATE PROVIDING FOR THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF A CURFEW FOR JUVENILES; REQUIRING PARENTS AND  
GUARDIANS TO ALLOW UNACCOMPANIED JUVENILES TO BE ON ANY  
PUBLIC STREET OR IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE AFTER A CURFEW HAS BEEN  
IMPOSED AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF"

WHEREAS, from time to time and under certain occasions the presence of persons less than seventeen (17) years of age upon the public streets and in public places in the Borough of Ocean Gate has constituted and can constitute in the future the opportunity and existence for anti-social conduct and disturbances of the peace and order of the society of the Bourough of Ocean Gate; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Ocean Gate is desirous of adopting a statutorily authorized curfew ordinance that has sufficient strength, but appropriate safeguards and flexibility to provide for the institution of a curfew when its institution will enhance the safety and well being of the citizens of the Bourough of Ocean Gate; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Ocean Gate believe that children who are left unsupervised during the overnight hours may be exposed to the most detrimental influences in society, that the allure of the rampant drug culture, the potential for involvement in criminal activity, and othe potential threats to the physical and mental health and welfare of children justify governmental action in furtherance of the protection of one of the most fragile and easily influenced segments of our society.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Ocean Gate, in the County of Ocean, and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purposes of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

- A. "Juvenile" means an individual who is under the age of seventeen (17) years.
- B. "Guardian" means a person, other than a parent, to whom legal custody of the juvenile has been given by court order or who is acting in the place of the parent or is responsible for the care and welfare of the juvenile.
- C. "Knowingly" means actual knowledge or such total information which a parent has or should reasonably be expected to have pertaining to the whereabouts of the juvenile in that guardian's legal custody. It is intended to include within the meaning of knowledge the requirement of neglectful or careless parents to maintain a reasonable community standard of parental responsibility through this objective test as to maintaining knowledge of the juvenile's whereabouts.
- D. "Public place" means any place to which the public has access, including but not limited to public street, road, thoroughfare, sidewalk, bridge, alley plaza, park, beach, recreation or shopping area, public transportation facility, vehicle used for public transportation, parking lot or any public building, structure or area.

## SECTION 2.

- A. A juvenile is prohibited from being on any public street or in any public place between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.
- B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a juvenile when one of the following circumstances are present:
  - (1) When the juvenile is accompanied by a parent or guardian or other adult have the care and custody of the juvenile.
  - (2) Where the juvenile is upon a medical emergency, errand or legitimate business directed by the juvenile's parent or guardian.
  - (3) When work time of the juvenile who is gainfully employed overlaps the curfew hours.
  - (4) When the juvenile is in attendance at a function sponsored by a religious or educational organization.
  - (5) When the juvenile is in attendant as a bona fide student at an evening school of instruction.
  - (6) When the juvenile is in attendance at a civic, cultural, educational or social function.
  - (7) When the juvenile shall, as a result of the above exceptions be traveling within the Borough after the prescribed hour toor from the juvenile's residence in a direct manner in connection with any of the above excepted activities.

## SECTION 3.

Any parent or guardian who knowingly allows an unaccompanied juvenile to be on any public street or public place during the operation of a curfew and between the hours specified herein except as allowed herein shall have been deemed to violate this ordinance.

## SECTION 4.

If any juvenile shall be apprehended for violating the provisions of this ordinance, the Borough Police Department shall immediately notify the parents, guardian or other adult having care and custody of the juvenile of such arrest and upon notification such parent, guardian or other adult having care and custody of the juvenile shall immediately provide for the juvenile's placement in their custody, care and keeping.

## SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall be posted in the Municipal Building, the public school of the Borough of Ocean Gate and in such public or quasi-public places as deemed appropriate so the public will be constantly informed of the existence of this order and any actions

taken thereunder. This provision shall not be interpreted to require proof of actual notice or knowledge of this ordinance, or any proclamation made pursuant to this ordinance in order to have a conviction for violation of any provision of this ordinance.

#### SECTION 6.

Anyone convicted of violating this ordinance shall be required to perform community service of up to two hundred forty (240) hours and may be subject in addition to a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1000.00). If both the juvenile and the juvenile's parent or guardian violate such an ordinance, they shall be required to perform community service together.

#### SECTION 7.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A 40:8-2.52. It is determined that the standards established herein are consistent with the findings of fact made by the Legislature in its legislative history in adopting said legislation. It is further determined that the language contained herein does establish clear standards and precise language adequate to apprise a juvenile and a parent or guardian of that which is unlawful as well as that which is adequate to circumscribe the discretion of police officers so as to prevent subjective and discriminatory enforcement of this ordinance. The Council does further determine that juveniles and their parents or guardians are hereby specifically apprised that both are responsible for the conduct of the juvenile and that juveniles shall not be allowed to be on public streets or in public places during the hours between 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. unless the juvenile's parent or guardian is in the physical presence of the juvenile or unless the juvenile has a particular purpose as set forth in this ordinance for his or her being in a public street or public place between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. Police officers enforcing this ordinance shall enforce it against any and all juveniles who are in or about public streets or public places of the Borough of Ocean Gate unaccompanied by their parent or guardian or not having a specific, particular purpose as authorized by this ordinance for their movements in the absence of a parent or guardian.

#### SECTION 8.

It shall be no defense to any violation charged here under that a parent or guardian was completely indifferent to the activities or conduct or whereabouts of such juvenile who is charged with a violation of this ordinance.

#### SECTION 9.

In the event that any section, sentence or clause of this ordinance shall be declared illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not, in any manner, prejudice the enforcement of the remaining provisions.

SECTION 10.

This ordinance shall take effect in the manner as prescribed by law.
