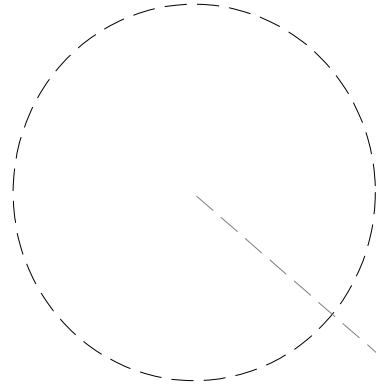

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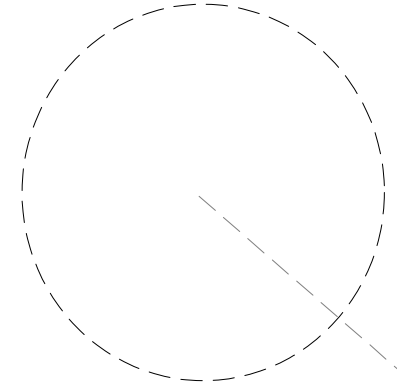
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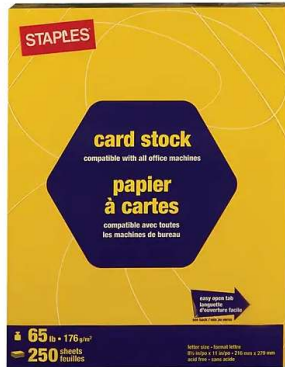
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INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Tools and supplies required:

Card Stock



Power Drill



Hole Saw Attachment



2. Purchase a package of Card Stock paper from Staples or another office supply company.
3. Print page 1 (door hangers) on the card stock using an ink jet printer or have copies made on card stock at Staples (\$0.15 per page)
4. Separate the door hangers by cutting along the vertical dotted lines with either scissors or a paper cutter.
5. Stack 10-20 door hangers (with edges aligned) and secure them with clamps to a scrap board, which is in turn secured to a workbench. (The hole saw will leave cuts in the scrap board)
6. Using a power drill with a 2" hole saw attachment, cut out the hole where indicated by the circle.
7. Use a screwdriver or punch to remove the paper circles from the hole saw attachment.
8. Use scissors to cut at 45 degree angle where indicated by the dotted line. This cut will allow the door hanger to easily be placed over a door knob.
9. Return to step #4 and repeat.
