**From the Pastor:** Where New Life May Yet Begin is the theme of our Lenten journey this year. How does New Life begin out of the stories we tell, risks we take, conversations that are holy, faith that overcomes our fear, when we think it is too late, when we take an alternate path, pray in the garden, eat and fellowship, join Jesus at the cross and walk with the women to the tomb. New life is all around us right now even under the snow I'm looking out on this morning as I write. Our sanctuary tells the story of new life—from living water flowing in and out of the well, to new life sprouting from seeds planted. Join us in this Lenten journey and explore where new life may yet begin for you, our church, and our Slate Belt community.





Combined Lenten Supper and Book Study—inperson or on Zoom: Wednesday evenings beginning March at 6PM. We will join with East Stroudsburg and First PC churches for a rotating sixweek study focused on the book Hard to Dance With the Devil on Your Back by Ray Buckley, a book that helps us enter Jesus' and the disciples world during those last days of Easter. In every culture and time, persons of faith, of all ages, have summoned trials and tribulations to find the endurance and strength to "dance." They have danced with the weight of the world upon their shoulders, sustained by God and others dancing near them.
