HOW TO PURCHASE A PLOT AT CHRIST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH CEMETERY

Walk through the cemetery and decide what plot fits your needs. Most of the plots are 16'x16'. There is enough room to provide eight (8) full size vaults and one cremation vault to be placed on top of each full-size vault. One Half plot purchases are available upon request with approval from the Session at CPCSB.

If you are a member of the Presbyterian Church, you can purchase a 16'x16' plot for \$1,000, and if you are not a member, the price is \$2,000.

There is a Deed available for each purchased plot, Cemetery By-Laws/Rules and Regulations Form, Plot Purchase Price and Reference Form and a Purchase Receipt form.

The funeral director will provide a packet of papers which goes to the church, one sheet of paper goes to Harrisburg, and one goes to the plot owner. The person responsible for someone who has passed away will get this pack of papers to be validated in Harrisburg.

If the owner of the plot wants a stone, either upright or a flat stone flush with the ground, all purchases can be made at Owens Monumental on First Street in Bangor, or you can purchase a stone at any monumental place.
