BRIGHTON BOWLS CLUB “OPEN” BARRACUDA CLASSIC CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 5 Games of 14 ends 2 hours or the bell.
- Saturday 3 games - Sunday 2 games.
- No Dead Ends – Re-spot on the Tee.
- Should a team receive a forfeit, or bye that team will record a win with the average margin (rounded up or down) recorded in that round.
- No roll ups prior to games.
- Teams may rotate player positions for each game.
- Bowls Australia approved clothing must be worn.
- If rain interrupts an end, that end is to be completed (and not replayed) when players return to the green.
- In the event of “Bad Weather” the controlling body reserves the right to adjust the number and duration of games in order to complete the tournament.
- Bowls are played under Bowls Australia Laws of the Game and as amended by these conditions of play.
