- No Dead Ends Re-spot on the Tee.
- Should a team receive a forefeit, or bye that team will record a win with the average margin (rounded up or down) recorded in that round.
- No roll ups prior to games.
- Teams may rotate player positions for each game.
- Bowls Australia approved clothing must be worn.
