Buyer acknowledges that puppy specific details including sex, color, microchip number, and final puppy assignment may be completed by Seller after Match Day and prior to final execution of this Agreement.

Reservation & Match List Terms

1. A non-refundable Reservation Fee of \$500 is required to join a Twilight Doodles Match List and will be applied toward the total purchase price of the puppy.
2. Buyer understands that reservation placement secures a position on a Match List, not a specific puppy. Twilight Doodles does not guarantee gender, color, coat type, size, temperament, or specific physical traits.
3. Reservation Fees may be transferred one (1) time only to a future litter of the same breed, size, and generation, provided the original litter has not yet reached four (4) weeks of age.
4. After one transfer, the Reservation Fee is forfeited and may not be transferred again.
5. Reservation Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable to another person under any circumstances.
6. If Buyer declines puppy selection opportunities from two (2) eligible litters and wishes to remain on the Master List, a new Reservation Fee will be required.
7. Twilight Doodles reserves the right to refuse or cancel a reservation at any time if Seller believes placement is not in the best interest of the puppy.

Litter Timing

1. Buyer understands that the timing of heat cycles, breedings, pregnancies, litter sizes, and puppy go home dates are estimates only and are never guaranteed.
2. Twilight Doodles may postpone, cancel, or adjust planned breedings or litter timelines if deemed necessary for the health, safety, or well-being of the parent dogs or puppies.
3. Breeding dogs are living animals and reproductive timelines can vary naturally and unpredictably.
4. In the event a planned litter does not occur or is significantly delayed, Buyer may transfer to another eligible upcoming litter in accordance with Twilight Doodles reservation policies.

Pairing Changes

1. Twilight Doodles reserves the right to make changes to planned breeding pairings at any time, including near or during a breeding cycle.
2. Every reasonable effort will be made to select a replacement pairing that is similar in size, breed, generation, and overall goals to the original planned litter.

3. Buyer understands that planned pairings are subject to change based on health testing results, reproductive timing, temperament considerations, veterinary recommendation, or other program decisions made in the best interest of the dogs and puppies.

Match Process

1. Puppy selections occur in Reservation List order during scheduled Match Day appointments.
2. Twilight Doodles reserves the right to determine the structure, timing, and format of Match Day and puppy selections.
3. If Buyer is unavailable during their scheduled selection time and cannot be reached, Twilight Doodles reserves the right to move to the next family in line.
4. Buyer may appoint a proxy or request assistance from Twilight Doodles in selecting a puppy.
5. Twilight Doodles reserves the right to reassign any forfeited, abandoned, or unused Match List positions at Seller's discretion.

Payment Terms

1. The total purchase price of the puppy is \$_____.
2. Buyers joining the Match List before puppies reach one (1) week of age:
 - \$1,750 is due once the litter reaches one (1) week of age
 - Remaining balance is due at six (6) weeks of age
3. Buyers joining the Match List after puppies are one (1) week old but before puppies reach six (6) weeks of age:
 - \$2,000 is due at the time of joining the Match List
 - Remaining balance is due at six (6) weeks of age
4. Puppies over four (4) weeks of age may require payment in full upon signing.
5. Final payment must be completed prior to puppy pickup or transportation.
6. Failure to make payments on time may result in forfeiture of reservation placement and all monies previously paid.

Seller Responsibilities & Health Warranty

1. Seller guarantees the puppy is in good health at the time of transfer, excluding the possible presence of intestinal parasites, which are common in puppies.

2. Prior to transfer, the puppy will have received:
 - A. Age appropriate vaccinations
 - B. Routine deworming
 - C. A subcutaneous microchip
 - D. A veterinary health certificate, if required
3. Seller provides a warranty against debilitating congenital and hereditary defects for a period of two (2) years from the date Buyer takes possession of the puppy.
4. Seller represents that reasonable and responsible breeding practices were used in the selection of the sire and dam to reduce the risk of hereditary defects.
5. Debilitating congenital or hereditary defects are defined as conditions determined by a licensed veterinarian to be genetic, inherited, developmental, or present from birth, and which significantly impair the dog's quality of life or ability to function as a companion animal.
6. Conditions caused by injury, obesity, environmental factors, toxins, improper conditioning, preventable illness, or neglect are not covered under this warranty.
7. Any suspected congenital or hereditary defect must:
 - A. Be diagnosed by a licensed veterinarian
 - B. Be reported to Seller within seven (7) calendar days of diagnosis
 - C. Include complete veterinary records and diagnostic testing
8. Seller reserves the right to require a second opinion from a veterinarian or veterinary specialist of Seller's choosing at Seller's expense.
9. If a qualifying congenital or hereditary defect is confirmed within the warranty period, Seller may, at Seller's sole discretion:
 - A. Offer a replacement puppy of equal or lesser value from a future available litter
 - OR
 - B. Reimburse up to fifty percent (50%) of the original purchase price toward documented veterinary expenses directly related to the qualifying condition.
10. Total reimbursement under this Agreement shall not exceed the original purchase price of the puppy, regardless of the number of claims or qualifying conditions submitted.
11. Wait time for a replacement puppy may range from six (6) to twenty four (24) months.
12. Replacement puppies are not guaranteed to match the original puppy in color, gender, size, coat type, or temperament.
13. Shipping and transportation expenses are the responsibility of Buyer.
14. This warranty is void if the puppy is euthanized, rehomed, surrendered, or otherwise disposed of without written consent from Seller and without allowing Seller the opportunity for a second veterinary opinion.
15. This warranty does not cover:

- Parasites including Giardia or Coccidia
 - Viral or bacterial illness
 - Stress related illness
 - Allergies
 - Ear infections
 - Urinary tract infections
 - Hypoglycemia
 - Hernias
 - Cancer
 - Endocrine disorders
 - Improper bite alignment
 - Injuries
 - Ingestion of foreign objects
 - Toxins
 - Physical trauma
16. No other warranties or guarantees, express or implied, are made under this Agreement except as stated herein.
 17. This warranty is non-transferable.
 18. Seller does not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for routine veterinary bills or general healthcare expenses unrelated to a qualifying congenital or hereditary defect covered under this warranty.

Buyer Responsibilities & Puppy Care

1. Buyer agrees to provide appropriate, humane, and responsible lifelong care for the puppy.
2. Buyer agrees to:
 - A. House the dog indoors
 - B. Provide appropriate nutrition
 - C. Maintain a healthy body weight
 - D. Provide annual veterinary wellness examinations
 - E. Seek prompt veterinary care when needed
 - F. Maintain the puppy's microchip registration information
3. Buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within seventy two (72) hours of taking possession.
4. Proof of examination must be provided to Seller. Failure to complete the examination within the required timeframe voids the health warranty.
5. If the puppy is determined to be seriously ill during this examination:
 - A. Buyer may return the puppy to Seller at Buyer's expense

- B. Buyer must provide written documentation from the examining veterinarian
 - C. Refunds are limited to the original purchase price only
 - 6. Buyer understands that intestinal parasites are common in puppies and may require multiple treatments after going home.
 - 7. Buyer assumes responsibility for all medical expenses associated with parasites, stress related illness, environmental illness exposure, or routine veterinary care after transfer.
 - 8. Buyer agrees to postpone strenuous or forced exercise until the puppy reaches at least one (1) year of age to help protect developing joints.
 - 9. Seller strongly recommends:
 - A. Basic obedience training within the first year
 - B. Maintaining pet insurance throughout the dog's life
 - C. Gradual food transitions to help reduce gastrointestinal upset
 - 10. Risk of loss, injury, illness, or death transfers to Buyer once the puppy leaves Seller's care.
 - 11. Buyer is solely responsible for transportation arrangements and associated expenses beyond DFW or Love Field Airport.
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Breeding Restrictions & Spay/Neuter Agreement

- 1. The puppy is sold strictly as a companion animal without breeding rights.
 - 2. Spaying, neutering, or approved gonad sparing sterilization performed by a licensed veterinarian is required no later than fifteen (15) months of age.
 - 3. Proof of sterilization must be submitted through SpaySecure before the puppy reaches fifteen (15) months of age.
 - 4. Unauthorized breeding constitutes a material breach of this Agreement.
 - 5. Buyer acknowledges that damages resulting from unauthorized breeding are difficult to quantify and agrees to liquidated damages in the amount of \$25,000.
 - 6. Seller reserves all legal rights and remedies related to unauthorized breeding.
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Rehoming & Lifetime Commitment

- 1. If Buyer is unable to keep the dog for any reason, Buyer agrees to notify Seller immediately.
- 2. Buyer agrees the dog will never be surrendered to a shelter, rescue, pound, research facility, or similar organization.
- 3. Buyer and Seller will work together to determine appropriate rehoming if necessary.

4. No refunds will be issued for returned or rehomed dogs.
5. Buyer acknowledges that Twilight Doodles maintains a lifelong commitment to every puppy produced.

Media Release

1. Buyer grants Seller permission to repost or share photographs and videos of the dog that Buyer publicly shares on social media for promotional or educational purposes.
