Pine Hill Cemetery Lantern Tour



In the north end of the cemetery, several **children's graves** are marked by the image of a **lamb**, signifying **innocence** and the **Lamb of God**.

The children buried in these graves were usually victims of typhoid or diphtheria before vaccines were produced.

As an example, we can look to the graves of **College Treasurer Emory Glenn's sons**:

- Young John B. Glenn died from typhoid when he was five years old
- his two-year-old brother, Emory, died of the same disease a week later in January 1859
