One "Real Daughter" of the American Revolution lies in Pine Hill on the south end.

Her name is **Belinda F. Moreman Thomas**. She was born in 1822 in Wilkes County, Georgia, and died in 1918.

Her father was Revolutionary war soldier Thomas Moreman, who was born in England in 1746. He was engaged during the entire seven years of the war, mostly in Maryland. He fought at Trenton, Brandywine, and Monmouth. He still carried a bullet in his leg when he died in Wilkes County, Georgia.

Belinda's husband, J. L. Thomas, was the son of John Madison Thomas, who built the Thomas Hotel in downtown Auburn. Thomas descendants still own property here.

Belinda's grave is marked with a plaque by the local chapter of the DAR, denoting she is a Real Daughter.
