TRAVEL INFORMATION

COVID-19

International passenger flights to and from South Africa are currently permitted, subject to the following conditions:

- A traveller must provide a valid certificate with a negative Covid-19 test outcome, recognised by the WHO, or equivalent local accredited authority, obtained not more than 72 hours before the date of travel.
- In the event of the traveller's failure to submit a valid negative test certificate the traveller shall be required to do an antigen test at his or her own cost.
- In the event of the traveller testing positive for Covid-19, he or she shall be required to isolate at their own cost, for 10 days.

- Face masks are required in all public places in South Africa.
- The event venue requires that on arrival a face mask or shield is worn; that you complete a guest screening questionnaire; have your temperature taken and make use of the hand sanitising stations.

VISAS

LETTERS OF INVITATION FOR VISA APPLICATIONS

If you require a Visa to travel to South Africa, please let us know immediately by return email to enable us to provide you with the relevant letter of invitation to assist with your Visa application.

PASSPORT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

South African law requires travellers to have two (2) blank (unstamped) visa pages in their passport to enter the country; one for the South African temporary residence permit sticker that is issued upon entry to the country, and an additional page to allow for entry and exit stamps for South Africa and other countries to be visited en route to South Africa or elsewhere in the region.

Passports should also be valid for a minimum period of 30 days from the date of exit from South Africa.

YELLOW FEVER REQUIREMENTS FOR SOUTH AFRICA

Please note that a vaccination certificate against yellow fever, issued at least 10 days before arrival in South Africa for travellers from a country with yellow fever, or for those who have transited more than 12 hours through the airport of a country with risk of yellow fever transmission.
