
## Multiplication Math Board




## How to Use the Multiplication Board with Beads

- 1. Pick a Multiplication Problem
  - $\circ$  Example:  $4 \times 3$
- 2. Identify the First Number (Multiplier)
  - Look at the first number (4). This tells you how many circles you will use.
  - Find and use 4 circles on the board.
- 3. Identify the Second Number (Multiplicand)
  - The second number (3) tells you how many beads to place in each circle.
  - Put 3 beads in each of the 4 circles.
- 4. Count the Beads
  - Count all the beads together to find the total.
  - $\circ$  Example: 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12
- 5. Write the Answer
  - $\circ$  Write:  $4 \times 3 = 12$
