It is the children who have the least who will be affected the most, and we believe our mission is more important than ever.

With that in mind, and with the understanding that resources of time and money are stretched to their limit everywhere, we are reaching out to you in the hopes that you can help us to bring opportunity and arts education to underprivileged, at-risk youth.

Every penny that is donated to our organization, as well as every Legacy Ride registration fee, goes to fund full scholarships for underprivileged or at-risk youth to attend summer arts camp.
