The Omnia project is alive and well. This will be a state-of-the-art performance facility that we look forward to building. The land on 5th Ave. belongs to the citizens of Naperville. Seniors need a facility that will be accessible. The arts groups are in dire need of performance space. It will not be in competition with the Wentz, 600 seats, nor Pfeiffer 1000 seats, nor the Calamos project that will be an arena of 4500 seats. Our plan is for 2200 and 900 seats plus a 200-seat flexible meeting room.

To attract millennials to stay or move to Naperville, we need three things - \underline{AWE} . $\underline{Affordable}$ housing, \underline{W} alkability (which is already there) and \underline{E} for entertainment. These are the same requirements to keep our seniors in Naperville. The only entertainment we now have in Downtown Naperville is bars.
