## How Swollen Glands Can Alert You to Illness

If you've ever had strep throat, chances are you've experienced swollen glands. Your body has a system of lymph nodes, or lymph glands, that can be found primarily in your neck, chin, armpits, chest and groin. The lymph nodes act as a filter for your body, trapping viruses and bacteria before they can affect other parts of your body.

Generally speaking, when your lymph nodes are swollen, it's due to an infection or underlying disease. You may first notice pain or tenderness around the affected lymph node, which may swell to the size of a pea or kidney bean. Other symptoms that often accompany swollen lymph nodes can include runny nose, sore throat, coughing and other signs of an upper respiratory infection; fever or night sweats.

Some of the more common causes for swollen lymph nodes include viral or bacterial infections such as the common cold, mono or strep throat. As the infection clears up, the swelling goes down. Your doctor may prescribe antibiotics to treat an underlying bacterial infection or recommend ibuprofen or acetaminophen to lower a fever or ease pain. Warm compresses may also help reduce swelling.
