They loan out an assortment of medical supplies including walkers, bath and shower benches, commodes, and wheelchairs for a period of three months. Do I Need a Transport Wheelchair?



We rely on some pretty amazing volunteer drivers. They do their best and genuinely love helping their community. They, however, are not trained in lifting people or transferring people in and out of wheelchairs. To be able to use RAN, you must be able to get in and out of a vehicle with minimal

help. If you are feeling unsteady on your feet, we highly suggest using a *transport wheelchair*. These are different from typical wheelchairs because they are so light weight. Our drivers can easily fold them up and put them in their cars. This also lessens the chances of falling. Many local pharmacies have them available for purchase. You can also find one online such as Amazon.com and have it delivered to you!

Ride Requests

Call at least 7 days in advance. Your driver will call you the day prior to your ride to confirm. Please try to answer your phone so there is no confusion on the day of your ride.

Ride Cancellations

We realize cancellations happen, and please try your best only to give us rides you know you will need to avoid last minute cancellations.
