Bronwyn surprised the hell out of me several times. Not only could she hold her liquor (but always with an eye on time and the caveat of "I don't want to worry Rick"), she had an amazing knack of showing up with gifts. She gave me a portrait of myself (the first and only, completely unexpected) that she did completely from memory; it's uncannily accurate and it is on my wall, even though it is of the real old current me and not the young version of me that I occasionally try to enact at moments in public after that fourth cocktail. She also gave me several housewarming presents for my latest apartment, two paintings (also on my walls) and an incredible stainless steel pot that I use almost every day.

She is just like that. She will never be far from my mind. I would surely call Bronwyn Rucker indelible, and then beyond. She was easily one of the finest women I've ever known, and the only woman I enjoyed kicking back with on a frequent basis.
