- 6. Keyboards -- Sun Ra improvising electronic whirlpools;
- Singing -- Cage chanting randomly created "syllables";
- Silence -- Cage observing silences of random length;
- 9. Crowd -- 150 listening intently to a dreamt-of match;
- Record -- put it on vinyl and let the listener be brave;
- 11. End -- Avant-garde fans apprehend the Void of Nirvana.
