






Our Teams wish you a very Merry Christmas and a joyful New Year.

Evangelist Bryan Writes: On Thursday, the 20th of November, we had a colorful event, our very first graduation ceremony of the tailoring class. We graduated 26 students in total who were able to pass with distinction in the National Examination, they passed excellently and the **Honorable Minister for Industrials** at the district level was



impressed and donated a sewing machine to one of the best students, he said, "that the skills program is the solution to the youth unemployment, and the high level of crimes in society." He vowed to ask the Government to support the program and rehabilitate the youth into better citizens, he applauded the effort of

the **WAY OF JESUS SKILLS DEVELOPMENT CENTRE** in transforming the society. Also Carol and Jackie received their gifts of the tailoring machines and are so happy. They will be starting their business at the nearby center immediately after the Christmas season.

Evangelist Bryan Report:

Praise God! And greetings from TFEA Uganda East Africa, we have had a good year of excellence and a great month of November, one month left to bring the year to a close.

We thank God for the twelve Way Churches in Nakivale right now, in a population of about 200,000 people, it's like a drop in the ocean, the settlement camp is hosting refugees from DRC Congo, Burundi, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Ethiopia, and Eritrea, most of which are former prisoners of war, political prisoners etc., **this makes it a fertile ground for the ministry and the Prisoners of Pain events have been very successful.** This is the only place where the people are buying fuel and taking care of the audio/video/generator equipment financially.

The camp also has an estimated **40,000 local Ugandans living nearby who will be benefitting from the Prisoners of Pain events as it spreads outside the camp**, and the establishment of Way

Churches, one of our way church leaders, Karokora Edward has visited homes outside the camp and established Way House Churches outside the camp within the local families, leaving the camp Way House #2 under the care of his wife.

Thank you so much for helping some of the 30 leaders to repair their bicycles, especially during this rainy season when they needed them most to visit the some WAY House Churches and fellowship with them, collect the information of the progress and activity, to encourage and give direction, and also praying for the sick etc.

Some of the widows have already started using their houses, some stay with their grandchildren while others stay alone. We thank God for enabling the TFEA ministry to accomplish this with much appreciation to all our partners and prayer warriors. May God bless you abundantly.

Praise God for 2025, A very successful year, God has given us grace. The Prisoners of Pain events inside the prisons have **brought more people to Christ than the biggest crusades held in open air anywhere I know in Uganda**. God has gone ahead of us to reach out to communities through former inmates without our knowledge; **a sure proof that this is the work of God and not the work of man**. God is working with us and without us. All planned schedules, events, and routes for November were completed as intended, there is slight improvement in security on the roads, although the political situation continues to cause tension in most of the areas, we thank God for safe travels of our teams, safe accommodation, and very successful events.

Special thanks to our Mobile team for their faithful service and dedication to this calling and mandate, because most of the month is spent on the road for events which we enjoy so much seeing many souls coming to Christ. Our Christmas schedules are just the same as other months, the events are going to run through December as usual because we have the inside teams conducting events normally and the supervisory team moving around, we shall have time between 20th and 26th for rest for the mobile team but the inside teams will continue ministry as usual throughout December.

We pray that God will continue to provide the Bibles for the many respondents coming to Christ each month, that at least every inmate will have access to the word of God daily.

We have a total of 967 cell churches in 17 prisons gathering twice daily, every evening and morning. Praise God!

Superintendent Report: 443 WAY Church Clusters 42,394 First-time Salvations 1,000s Attending

We are so happy and excited about what the Lord has done through us and all our Way of Jesus staff and ministers, bringing God's people to Him in a miraculous way, **using what we call the unqualified to miraculous expand His work in ways we can't predict. It is amazing how God has gone ahead of us to use other released inmates to establish a work** within two months with ten churches without even our knowledge, we ask ourselves how can this be? **But we are quick also to answer ourselves that it has not been about us since the beginning, and so it's about God and His good will, and we continue to appreciate God for using us because as He can use anybody.**

As we discussed about the miraculous center that was established in Kanyaryeru for two months by one of the former prison cell church leaders who was released from prison and went straight to begin new churches, one of our elders at the Center mentioned that "God doesn't ask for permission" and we agreed with him fully. This challenged us to keep watching to do God's perfect will.

Our team of 12 elders in each of the 8 centers, the 8 superintendents and their 8 assistants from the eight centers, Alex and Doreen's supervisory team, me and my wife Harriet, are doing supervisory work, collecting data, supervising its accuracy, following up timetables of Baptism events, special pastoral visits, and supervision of new areas. God has advanced the gospel to hundreds of clusters of homes, house churches, having daily services and in fellowship with one another, notable miracles of healing, salvations, move of the Holy Spirit in many ways have been reported by the evangelists through the center leaders and superintendents. We now have 437 clusters of WAY House Churches in the 8 geographical centers,



How GOD has used the WAY of Jesus Community School to change a community!

In April of 2023 a large tract of land was donated to the TFEA ministry by a Politian who had witness the change in the lives of the people who were attending the **WAY of Jesus Mega Church Center**. When this happened I asked Evangelist Bryan who heads up our East Africa ministry, **“What is the greatest need for the local community?”** Bryan quickly responded back **“The greatest need of the community is for a school.”** He then went on to tell of the large number of children who would not be able to attend any school because of the long distance to the nearest school, and the poverty of the community. He also told me about how several children over the last few years had perished when walking and trying to cross the rain swollen river trying to get to the nearest school a number of kilometers away. That is when we decided to build the WAY of Jesus Community School and determined that when the school reached certain goals, our ministry would give it to the local community. Now that the school has reached those initial goals of creating a place of academic learning and life skill vocational training. This month ownership of the school has been assumed by the school board and local government. Through the WAY of Jesus Community School our ministry has not given a **‘hand out’** but an important **‘hand up’** to over 600 students and their families. **Thank you to all of you who are financial supporters of our ministry.**
