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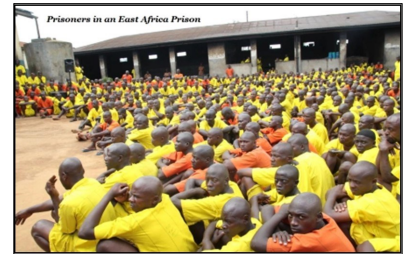

Dear TFEA/Freedom Team Partner,

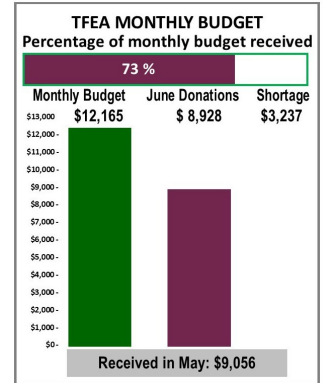

WAY of JESUS House Church Clusters Movement has Supernatural Growth

Greetings in the mighty Name of our Lord Jesus. I want to take this opportunity to thank you all for the good leadership, spiritual oversight and most of all, I thank God for His provision of His work here in Uganda. My team has been very committed and hardworking during this first half of the year, **over 1200 ministers in 40 geographical locations**, overseeing **1,111 WAY House Church clusters** that have reported **84,485 salvations in June**, each of the 40 centers has a team of 30 Elders overseeing the growth and activities of the center and these elders are under the leadership of the Mega Center superintendent. Normally all superintendents are the pioneers of the first WAY Churches in an area's first outbreak of churches immediately after they are released from prison and these 40 superintendents are under my leadership together with my wife Harriet as my assistant.

Praise the Lord for the bicycles!! **The TFEA WAY Church Leader's activities have achieved incredible reach over the past few months because of equipping our key leaders with bicycles**, enabling them to navigate vast distances, proving them as efficient, mobile ministry tools. As the baptism numbers increase, the bicycles have been very helpful, our leaders can now reach multiple villages in a single week, monitoring the work and getting to know new church outbreaks and easily reaching areas that previously took days to travel to on foot, however the challenge is that one bicycle is shared by almost 8 to 10 people now because of the increase in the number of centers and the need to balance the equipment.

The motorbikes have been our supplementary means of transport, helping the leaders and administrators to respond much faster to the emergency needs and incase of new church outbreaks especially during this time of Ebola threat country wide, Alex and Doreen have been effective in this especially in the baptism events as the numbers increase, **baptism is required immediately after salvations to avoid numbers piling up and waiting for baptism**, each respondent is baptized immediately as this has required training almost all ministers to conduct baptisms to balance the rising number of respondents.

Evangelist Bryan & Loice - June 2026 Praise Report & Analysis of Activities

As we close out the first half of 2026, we are reflecting on all the milestones we've reached in TFEA ministry here in East Africa. We couldn't have achieved these greater things without your faithful financial partnerships and prayers, spiritual guidance and love, patience and trust. Special thanks to our spiritual parents Tom and Carla for your spiritual guidance, indeed East Africa will never be the same again. **Thanks to all TFEA Partners and friends who have been used of God to make this possible. Thank you for making a lasting impact for the Kingdom here in East Africa, I don't know any ministry in history or today that has reached this many people in such a simple godly way.**

We are in **40 geographical locations** with **40 WAY CHURCH CENTERS** currently running **1,111 WAY CHURCH clusters**, with **1200 elders overseeing the centers**, **30 in each of the 40 centers**, and the out break of churches continues as the prison ministry continues to reach out to the inmates. **Revival is coming out of the Prison Cell Churches to the rest of the Uganda.**

We have received reports of new WAY Churches in the closed districts areas, but due to the current Ebola threat we are unable to visit these areas yet and we have not yet established the picture of the progress of these new churches. We know they are **18 WAY Churches in a new center which will be our 41st center**. We are currently waiting for the government to open these districts officially when they have been declared Ebola free sooner or later. There are people dying of Ebola also in some parts where movement has been restricted and some cases are far and others a bit closer, but we are being careful with our teams and waiting for any government official communications.

Please pray for us that God will protect us as a nation through the health threat of the Ebola virus, some districts are still closed to block further spread. May the good Lord richly bless you and give you good health.

Recently released inmates have demonstrated remarkable gratitude by donating 27 Bibles back to the ministry to help others. Many inmates have cited **The WAY of JESUS Bible** as their greatest source of comfort during their sentences, particularly in their final years.

A recently released inmate writes: "If I had not received this Bible two years ago, I would not be here. I had planned to bribe the kitchen department to access serving tools in order to commit suicide. The Word of God saved my life."

We thank God for the physical strength, dedication, and resilience of our volunteer teams, which has allowed us to maintain a consistent and highly impactful ministry.

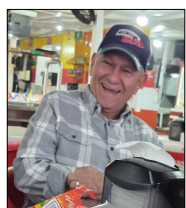
Ebola Precaution:

He had been arrested 103 times over the early 2/3rds of his life. He found Jesus and hasn't stopped serving the Lord since his salvation experience. He is 76 years old now and been active in the Freedom Team's Mexico prison ministry since 2001.



Bicycles

Evangelist Bryan writes: Our deepest gratitude for the bicycles you provided us. Thank you so much. They are doing an incredible job in helping us move around in baptisms, supervision, new church outbreaks, day to day ministry activities, and because of this need we have increased the number of bicycle owners from 6 people per bike to 10 people per bike because of the increasing WAY Church clusters and centers and the need of traveling by the elders on duty. We currently have 52 bicycles.

Evangelist Bryan writes: Many of the inmates being released from the prisons are encouraged to donate their Bibles to the inmates still in prison, others donate immediately before they leave prison facilities and others gather them to us and we take them back and give to new inmates inside prisons, because the released inmates are able to buy their own Bibles. Emmanuel has informed me that he has so far 27 Bibles donated by inmates who were released and are able to buy their own Bibles and we shall give these to the prison ministry department to redistribute them during their prison outreaches.

Note: The funds we have just sent will bring us to 26,500 Bibles printed so far this year.

Construction Continues on 24 more Widow Homes

A massive thank you for your generous support of the widow's house construction. We have successfully made 21 out of 24 frames so far! We are just waiting for the rains to come so we can start making the stone and mud walls. Meanwhile we shall finish the

frames and embark on putting doors, windows and ventilators. Thank you for making this possible. The soon coming rains will give us the perfect soil conditions to mix and mold the mud walls with stones and cement.

Superintendent Emmanuel writes: We have finished 21 frames of the widow's houses out of the 24 frames, all volunteers working on the widows' houses and the big church people who have donated trees and small wall sticks are very excited and waiting for the rains to start the mud wetting and fixing of walls soon which will be followed by concrete plastering after installation of windows and doors and ventilators. The widows can't wait for the completion of their houses. Thank you for restoring hope and joy in the people of Rwenjeru and Uganda at large. Cost of building a Widow Home is \$250.

Testimonies of Miraculous Healings & Deliverances!

Kabanyana Edithiana Rwakubuturukytwe, female, age 39, (Healing from Serious Abdominal Pain & Infertility)

For five years, I have suffered from intense stomach pain that doctors in the Government Mbarara hospital could not explain, I went there several times, at some point they suggested operation but asked for a lot of money that my family could not afford, I left and went to the witch doctors because my aunt had told me that people have sent me witch craft. I spent all my farming money on charms and witch doctor, I stayed at the shrine for two years, but the pain only grew worse, and I could not conceive a child, so my husband left me. Last year early my neighbor Godwin invited me to the big church. During the Sunday service, Emmanuel called the sick to the front. He laid hands on me and prayed with great authority. I felt a cold sensation leave my body instantly, that was six months ago, God reunited me again with my husband on that very day, the pain was also gone on that very day, I am now carrying a baby in my womb, and I give all glory to Jesus of the big church.

Musa Katuntu Muhoozi, male, age 41 (Healing from Paralysis)

I can't believe, I was healed after everyone told me that I would never walk straight again. I had a stroke while working at the Kyamusya public flower gardens and was bedridden for eight months. My family had to feed me and move me. I was brought to the big church in March on a mattress after everything had failed, I had sold my land and all the money wasted in hospitals. When the Elders prayed and asked us to believe in the power of Jesus, I felt a shock in my legs. I stood up and walked for the first time in nearly a year. Today, I am back to farming and serving in the big church as an Usher. God is a miracle worker.

Mama Rukyebe Murikatatete Harris, female, age 73 (Healing from Eye Blindness)

I was almost totally blind when I was brought to the big church. I remember I could not see my grandchildren's faces clearly. I came to the big church to find refuge, and they prayed for me, anointing my eyes with oil. In the next few weeks, my sight began to improve, and one day, I woke up, and the thick darkness was gone. I could see the light, I am now able to walk to the river alone, fetch water, and read my Bible too. God has healed my eyes completely.

Brother Bosco Kanyana, male, age 41, (Freedom from Alcoholism, Drugs & Internal Sickness)

Last year, I was a slave to alcohol and drugs when they brought me here to the big church, I could barely stand on my own, and my liver was badly painning me constantly. I had lost my family and my dignity of course. I indeed came to the big WAY Mega Church broken. Through the teachings, I realized God loved me. The Elders constantly prayed for me and I lay on the mattress all day, and a few weeks later, I lost the appetite for alcohol, and the pain in my side started to disappear, and a month after it completely vanished. I am a new man now, my wife and children came back and my home is filled with joy.

Zeldra Munyaneza, male, 48 years old (Beat wife to death, but found true freedom in Jesus)

My last sentence has been 17 years long, I was arrested from the hills of Rwenjeru while grazing goats on the morning of Tuesday, December 9th, 2008. I left our 5 children home and was taken to jail. I was only 31 years old when I beat my wife to death while under the influence of alcohol, this time I knew that it was my journey to the grave. I was released from prison miraculously on October 24th last year, I had been part of the Prison Cell Church for 2 years, after I received Christ Jesus through one of the Prisoners of Pain events. But what I thought would be the darkest time of my life turned out to be the greatest when I met the Freedom Team and started attending the events. As I fully surrendered every part of my life to Christ, and I began growing and serving in the prison cell church, I experienced true freedom. I grew up in a gang-infested Biharwe neighborhood, joining my first gang at age 14. My initiation took place in an empty farm in Rwenjeru where now sits the Mega Center big church that is going to become my new home church now. When I was initiated into a life destroying ritual is the same place where the fountain of life for Rwenjeru community is flowing from. I thank Jesus for rescuing my life, my favorite verse in the WAY of JESUS Bible that I received from prison is **"So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed"**. After I received Jesus, I felt freedom in my heart it did not matter whether I was in jail or out of jail, I felt true freedom.

Kilned Mussolini Magara, male, 46 years old (Sentenced to 90 years in prison, but Jesus set him Free)

When I was arrested on murder charges, last year, the prosecutor gave me 90 years in prison for being involved in a high profile murder case, I was innocent but I knew my life had come to an end, when I returned to my prison cell, I thought about my young children growing up without a dad. The prison cell church inmates were gathering in a nearby commons area for their nightly Bible study and prayer. I decided to join them for comfort, they invited me the following day for the Prisoners of Pain event. That night, I attended the Prisoners of Pain event and as I watched the video documentary, I gave the message my full attention. And for the first time, I truly understood who I was and what I needed. I asked God to have mercy on me, forgive me, and change me and I received Jesus that very day. That was early last year. I still hoped God would free me from my physical prison, but that did not immediately happen. But what was supposed to be 90 years turned into 9 months after court proved my innocence in my absence. However, during that season, as I fully surrendered my life to Christ, I began growing and serving in the prison cell church and receiving the Freedom Team events visitors, I read my entire Bible through several times from February to October last year and when I was released miraculously, I completed my sentence and went home. I now stay at the big church helping in volunteer construction of widow's houses, I am free in every way.

Boniface Magoba, male, 53 years old (Delivered from Drug possession and drug trafficking)

I was arrested from Kanyaryeru 9 years ago for various reasons, drug trafficking, drug possession and other drug-related convictions. It was my third time in prison, and I have served 9 full years now, the judge had threatened to give me a life sentence but somehow it didn't happen. Sometime last year I met the Freedom Team at my cell common area, I had heard about them in my previous transfers from the inmates that came to our cell through testimonies, but I gave it a deaf ear because I only waited for a time to get out of prison and start over life of drugs again, do business and get high too. When I met the Freedom Team however, my life changed, I remember I walked into the hall, it had about 80 to 100 men, and that was my turning point. After the video show, I gave my life to Christ, I received a small Bible and the leaflet. Daily I walked over to the hall and knelt down and said, "God, I know You're real. I just don't know how to get to You. I can't stop weed, the alcohol, the cigarettes, but if You'll help me this one last time, I'll always tell somebody what You did for me." God healed me and I never smoked another cigarette from that day. I am on the line up to go home this year may be in October or November, I can't wait to share my testimony with others outside these four walls and tell people what God did for me as I promised in a prayer that changed my life.
