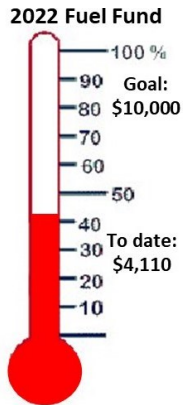
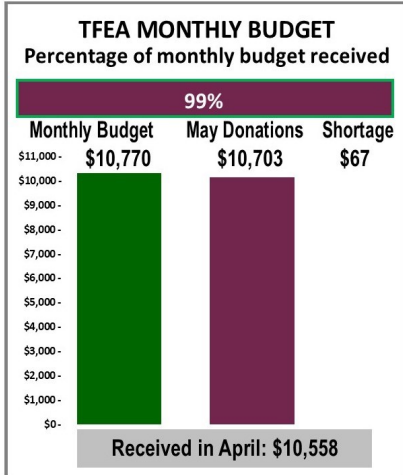
Never before in the history of the country has such a move of God taken place in the prisons of

Uganda. We continue to be astonished as so many inmates are coming to a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. The month of May our Evangelistic Teams did 99 Evangelistic Events and recorded 16,931 first-time professions of faith in Jesus Christ with another 1,035 prisoners recording a re-dedication to Christ.

Each are given our 'Freedom Tract' and our '8 Steps to Freedom' follow up materials. In addition to the inmates receiving Christ there have also been a number of prison officers who also have come to Christ through these events. We praise God for His wonderful pouring out of His Holy Spirit that appears to be touching and softening the hearts of these prisoners and officers.

You too, as a Partner, with our TFEA Ministry Teams are a very important part in these prisoners and officers finding a relationship with Christ.

A Supernatural Wild Fire? - 62 Prison Cell Churches with 5,600 Prisoners attending twice daily!

What we are experiencing in the Prison Cell Churches appears to us as a Godly Supernatural Wild Fire of revival sweeping through the Kakiika prison and has now begun in the Nyabuhikye prison. Only God can cause such explosive growth as He builds these New Testament Churches inside these prisons. On June 1st we began the first Prison Cell Church in Nyabuhikye prison and by June 12th there were 12 Prison Cell Churches operating with 50 people attending twice daily.

The short period of time that has taken place since we received God's plan for these churches has happened so fast with almost a new prison cell churches being started every other day. As I read how God built the New Testament Churches in the Book of Acts this seems to be the same miraculous movement of the Lord as He did in Acts. These men and women in these 62 Prison Cell Churches are attending because they are experiencing something that is beyond their understanding as well as our understanding. Could it be a new heart given to them by the Lord? As we read their testimony letters that are given to our Evangelists we see that all of them are gaining a hope and a future even though they are incarcerated. God is bringing freedom into these Prison Cell Churches as they meet and experience the presence and true reality of our Living God. This is what we also believe the early New Testament Churches in Acts also experienced. Thank you, Lord!

Evangelist Bryan writes: *The Nyabuhikye Church has 600 total inmates meeting daily within 12 Cell Churches of 50 each, and the Warden and Joshua informed me that they will very soon merge the cells to make cells of 100 each instead of 50 each.*

We have distributed part of The "WAY of JESUS gospels" to the respondents this month and we are currently using the 8 Steps to Freedom and the Freedom Tract booklets to handout to all the respondents. Praise songs, singing with joy and sharing of testimonies is part of our Kakiika church services. We appreciate the hands that gave to make it possible for the Prison Cell Churches at Kakiika to be fully equipped with sound systems, may God bless you abundantly. We have also seen thousands of inmates responding to the call to salvation this May, through the Prisoners of Pain documentary ministry. It is still as powerful a tool as it was from the beginning and God has continually favored us in the sight of the prison staff and administration of the prisons to

all our East African teams.

We are building a typical New Testament church at Nyabuhikye Prison just as we did at Kakiika, a continuous church, it resembles the early church in the book of Acts where the church was referred to as "The WAY", That Good old way. (JEREMIAH 6:16/JOHN 14:6). Bibles are still our greatest need and our prayers together with all born again inmates at the Cell Churches at Kakiika Prison are praying for the same. We are praying also that the fuel prices will stabilize again (they have almost doubled) and have affected the prices of almost every item in the market, because of the rise in fuel prices and we pray that they normalize soon.

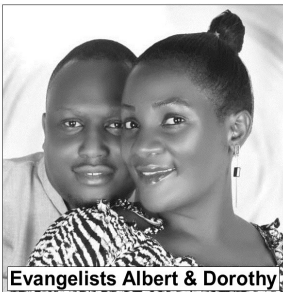

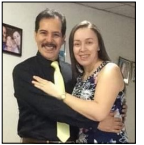


Hector Soto Report: 1 Event 27 Responding 18 Registered First-time accepting Christ

Unedited Testimony from Prisoners in a East Africa Prison

Didas, 41 years old, Male – KAKIKA PRISON

My name is Didas, when I was Born, I only spent the first 9 years of my life with my parents and then they abandoned me in the house alone because of Poverty, Alcohol, Drugs and domestic violence, they separated and abandoned me. I was then left to the streets to take care of myself when I was only 9, when I came on the streets, I learnt to do anything to earn a living, I became the most notorious young boy, Ready to kill or die to earn a living that is how I ended up in and out of the children's prison at only 14 years, this went on for long until I was permanently jailed at 22 years until now. I was a Heroin drug addict; I have always blamed this on my terrible childhood and resented my parents for abandoning me. When the Freedom Team came to the hall, our cell was invited, I came out thinking it was entertainment, but after watching the Film and they prayed for us I received Jesus, and the visitors gave me a bible, I am now at cell K-4563200 for prayers, I am encouraged by the testimonies of my fellow inmates daily and God has restored Joy in my heart.

Collins, 40 year old, Male – KAKIKA PRISON

My name is Collins or "AK 47" as I have been widely known on the streets all my life, I have been a drug dealer and user all my life, On Saturday during the Video show, I saw a man who lived the same life that I have lived testifying in the video, we all at first thought it was good life we were living until it was too late, but its never too late with God, the power of God delivered me and healed me from hate, bitterness, resentment, anger that has consumed me for many years, and I took a decision to accept Jesus, yet not I but God reached down to me. So I thank God for the friends here at church who have helped me learn to read my bible, thank you for my Bible and booklet, and I thank the warden for bringing visitors to make a church here and the sound system for praising God, I have not rejoiced in church in a very long time but God has brought the church to us in here, I am thankful.

Medard, 38 year old, Male – Kakiika Prison

Born in domestic violence and chaotic family, juvenile detention began at 13 years old. Drugs and alcohol marked my path from juvenile detention to prison. Committing 127 misdemeanors and three felonies has led to my spending 15 years here. And while in my jail here hopeless and facing a life sentence, I picked up my neighbor's Bible lying on the floor which I later learnt that he had gotten it as a gift from the Freedom Team visitors and I prayed for the first time in many years, "God, I don't know how to get to You, but I want to get to you, please help me." I requested him to go with me to these people, He helped me to ask the warden to change my cell and I was added to K-340071 which is near the hall that we have church from and I heard many testimonies from my fellow inmates of how they were Transformed by the Freedom team ministry, I decided to give my life to Christ, they prayed for me and I Got saved, I attend the Prison Cell Church twice daily and I am hoping to get my own Bible someday.

More Unedited Testimony from Prisoners in a East Africa Prison

Mosses, 34 year old, Male – Kakiika Prison

My name is mosses, I thank you for bringing Church To us, we Pray every day, in the evening before I rest and in the Early Morning, this has brought back my lost hope, after the morning prayers I feel empowered to face a new day with courage and my days here have become shorter and peaceful, as a former drug dealer and user, my life was a spiral downward. Spending time behind bars was not, in itself, enough to stop me from a bad lifestyle full of bad choices. Only the transforming grace and power of God through the freedom team Film of "Prisoners of Pain God's grace" could deliver me, and empower me to stand courageous and peaceful in my current state. Praise God that am now peaceful, Thank you for my Bible Gift.

Merab, 30 year old, Female – Kakiika Prison

From the time I was 15, I became a drug dealer and user, I have been in and out of Prison, but this has not been punishment enough to stop me from a bad lifestyle. My turning point was last Saturday 2nd April 2022. when I was invited to the hall to fellowship with the Freedom team and I watched the Prisoners of Pain Video and preaching From the Freedom Team Visitors, my life will never be the same again. Thank you for the gift of my Bible, I take almost 90 percent of my time reading the bible, It has taken away bad thoughts from my mind and kept me busy as well as getting me close to my saviour Jesus who loves me so much. I want to Serve the Lord with the same urgency that I previously served sin. Please pray for me to be released from here to reunite with my family.

Ronald, 37 year old, Male – Kakiika Prison

From my youth days, I lived life of drinking, drugs, and spent it on the streets, there was high rate of crime in my town and we were always the target of police I was later arrested and charged with armed robbery together with my group and ended up facing 14 years in prison. While sitting in my a jail cell recently, heard the warden call us for prayers at the hall, and I Just came out to have a feel of the sun outside and fresh air, my aim wasn't to pray at the hall, But God had a different plan for me, after watching the Video at the hall that had many testimonies of transformed lives from bad lifestyles, this was the kind of life I lived, I thought to my self that i can be transformed if I give it a try, I surrendered my life to Christ, and since then I have been coming here every morning and evening, this is my cell church, I feel peace now and I Thank you so much for the Gift of my Bible.

Robert, 45 year old, Male – Kakiika Prison

My name is Robert, From the days of my youth, I lived a life marked by drugs, alcohol, street crime and violence. I was Arrested many times and was imprisoned many times, I was in and out of Prison and the Life that I lived Eventually led to another Major arrest in 2010 where many charges were placed on me, All my life I was looking for Peace in what my life style was offering like money, drugs and women, But i never got the peace and comfort i longed for.....until the day my cell was invited to the Men's wing prison hall on 2nd April, at first I thought it was entertainment as usual, I had seen many preachers in the past years but watching the Prisoners of pain video was a whole different experience, I watched several testimonies of people in the video that have lived a life like mine and got a second chance of total transformation, I knew my day had come, and I surrendered my life to Christ, that day i received a gift of my bible that I love reading so much, I have since been in cell – K374800 for morning prayers and evening prayers in the same hall, the church has brought life to me again, I always feel the power when we pray. God has given me life, and a right to live again, he has delivered me and I feel peaceful.

Bamu, 43 year old, Male – Nyabuhikye Prison

Born in a polygamous family, characterized by domestic violence, alcohol and drugs, me and my siblings were addicted to meth at a very young age i remember I was 19 and my siblings were much younger but we were using Methamphetamine drug and cocaine by that age, it was expensive but somehow we got it, we had left home to face life on the streets of Kabale town and I was the first to be arrested on street crimes and selling drugs, because of my aggressiveness in this business and the many charges I was always on the run, they got me finally and I was given up to 27 years in prison, My inspiration was that i should get rich by all means or Die trying to get rich, when I got in prison, reality hit me, I felt shame, disappointment, fear and depression at the same time, tried to commit suicide many times, But I found something that satisfies, Right here upon this earth, Right here in Prison, Now I am always among the First in church on Sunday at my cell-hall. I am Glad I found Jesus since I met the Freedom Team visitors at the prison hall last month to watch the Film, I received Christ, and God has done more than delivering me from sin, He gave me peace. Thank you for the Bible and The Booklet. I read all the scriptures on the booklet with my bible.
