When we started in the prisons of Uganda we had no plans to start any churches or church movements. However even though we never considered the idea God had other plans for us. When the prisoners started coming out of the Prisons and the Cell Churches and couldn't find any church services where God was moving as much as in the Prison Cell Churches some prisoners indicated they would like to go back to prison so they could continue in the Prison Cell Churches. We knew then we needed to find a way to accommodate outside the prisons what God was doing inside the Prison Cell Churches. Thus began The WAY House Churches (nucleus of houses) and now The WAY Community Churches. The growth rate of these has been miraculously explosive. Most important we understand totally that we are not doing this and it is only God's movement of love andgrace doing this.

We are thankful to be a small part of organizing, structuring and guiding the growth of these churches and church leaders. Thank you Partners for

your continued prayers and financial support that God is using to impact a nation for His grace and glory.

We are giving most of our prison responsibilities to our new assistants, Alex and Doreen. We shall do supervision of what they do now. Alex and Doreen are capable to hold events, do baptisms and all the other things they have watched us do in the prisons. We shall give most of our time to The WAY Community Churches and The WAY House Churches in training leaders and setting things in order.

Regarding our WAY Church leaders let me share with you some of their developments. They had never been preachers and were afraid to lead a church outside of prison. They thought that the prison church was easier to lead because it was 100% inmates. I told them to do what they did in the

prison. They did and the people came.

Land has been donated for The WAY Community Church #1 to use by Shabban's Grandmother, a former witch doctor. She is now suggesting that she wants to give it permanently to The WAY Community Church. We are speaking with all the family to be sure that they are all in agreement with this decision. There are more people who have offered space for The WAY House Churches because of distance they have been traveling to attend gatherings. We then have a time of preaching and teaching from the Word of God. For those who don't have time to share in the church time we encourage them to write down their testimony and drop it in

our box. Those then are giving to Evangelists Bryan and Loice to be translated into English. We have also conducted 2032 baptisms this month. God continues to grant us favor with the prison staff and the inmates.

It is exciting and such an honor that God has counted us worthy to be a part of this work. My prayer is that I will remain humble and listen to the counsel and guidance of my leaders and the Holy Spirit. Bibles remain our greatest need as the inmates are hungry for His Word. We bless the Name of the Lord for His saving grace and provisions for this ministry.

Testimonies from WAY House Church #3 led by Ambassador Haula Miracle, after Miracle, after Miracle!!!

Miracle #1 - Testimony of - Brother Kagoro Cotham.

I was a cane farmer with a large cane farm here. Since 2018, I was sick and unable to care for the farm and my family, I suffered severely through this time of sickness. I was so weak that I could hardly get up and move around. So, I would just move slowly around the house, eat, sleep and visit doctors, priests, etc. I went to many priests and they prayed for me and gave me things to eat, I also received treatment from witch-doctors but I continued to grow worse. I tried everything including the services of a Muslim priest.

I went to different private doctors but my condition did not get any better. By this time, I had spent all my money and almost all my property. Finally in desperation, I gave up and I decided to stay home and wait for my death, my wife had deserted me, because I was not providing for her and my children had left the house, I was all alone. But when I heard about The WAY House Church #3 through Ambassador Haula and brother Shabban, I gave them my house to use it since I was there alone, that was the beginning of peace in my life, I accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior and Haula talked to me from the Bible and then prayed for me in the Name of Jesus Christ.

When they left that day, I felt a new strength in my body, from that day, I have been very strong and healthy. My wife and children are all back after two years of abandoning me in the house. I give praise and thanks to God for healing me and I want to give space freely to The WAY House Church.

Miracle #2 - Testimony of - Brother Bright Karungi

My name is Bright, I am married with children. Our family attends The Way House Church #3 in Biharwe, Rwenjeru North. Last year, I was unable to work as I was very weak in my body for about 5 months. I went to the hospital a few times for checkup and treatment but my condition remained the same. I also had some traditional herbal medicines from the witch doctors. During the day, I would lie down in the hot sun outside my house as I felt very cold inside me. They told me about the new Way House Church in our community, we were invited by a neighbors and after the service, all the members came over to my home and prayed for me.

Later, Bryan and Loice and some of the members of the church came to visit me. After he preached a message to my family, he told me to stand up and then he prayed. While he was praying for me, he rebuked some evil spirits and I almost blacked out. At the same time I grabbed the side of the wall to stop from falling over. Then they told me to sit down and they prayed for the house. After they left with his team, I felt very strong and put on my shoes and then went for shopping in trading center, this was the first time I had felt so different and strong for a long time.

Now I am completely healed and I give praise and thanks to Jesus for healing me. I asked Haula to bring The Way House Church to my house, we have a place outside in my compound, and all my neighbors are willing to gather there.

Miracle #3 - Testimony of - Sister Irene Mugema

This is translated from an audio interview from a newly converted couple Paul and Irene Mugema.

During my early teen when I was 13 years old, I started getting sick and ending up in hospital. This is all types of funny sickness such as anemia, stomach ache, blindness, severe migraine headaches and many more. I hardly attended school and many times unable to sit for exams. There were evil spirits troubling me as well. Neighbors suggest witch doctors to my parents. Because hospital couldn't cure me, my suffering increasing, we had to resort to witchcraft doctors, even they failed. I was 17 years old then, doctors told my mom, I am going to die, my body changed its color, and appendix needs to be operated immediately. My mom knew this is just another operation for no reason.

We were Muslim, since the time I started becoming sick, I had been praying and reciting all prayers and almost becoming another Muslim priest. We also then went for a witchdoctor who asked for chicken with black feet and alcohol. We were supposed to go back to him with this stuff when my mom's friend invited us to The Way House Church #3 and my mum said "we had tried everything, nothing helps. My daughter is dying today, cannot move, changed color, why not we give her to Jesus. If she gets healed she will serve Jesus all her life." We went to The WAY House Church and met Ambassador Haula, he gave us small white New Testament Bibles and shared the Word of God and prayed, As he was praying I could feel strength in my body, while he was still praying with his eyes closed, I could sit down and stand up, body completely healed by JESUS. Next was demonic spirits still knocking me, as I stood in the Word of God and confessed Jesus as my Lord and Savior, got baptized, they dare not come near my dwelling because now I belong to Jesus and covered by His Holy Blood. Most of my family and relatives turned to Jesus when they saw the miracle in my life and they received many blessings too.

I have a good family. I have a wonderful, loving husband and we are happy and have both decided to serve Jesus faithfully now at The WAY House Church #3. I thank Jesus for his sacrifice to save lost ones and sufferers. His Word is alive and very active in us. Thank you for The Way House Church #3 members that have helped me to know Jesus and discipled me to stand on God's Word and receive complete healing and live a life that God wants us to live, and gave me God's Word.

Unedited Testimony from Prisoners in a East Africa Prison

Kato, Female, 40 years old, Kakiika Prison

Hello dear Pastors from Freedom Team, thank you for my Bible and the book, my story is short, I thank God for victory, I lost both my parents through an accident when I was 17, out of that desperate situation, I resorted to drugs and alcohol, and street crime that would later lead me here, I have been here for 13 years, serving my last year now, and towards the end of my jail term is when I experienced the transforming grace and power of God through the ministration of the Prisoners of Pain Video and teaching from the Freedom Team visitors. I want to serve the Lord when I am totally healed.

William, Male 64 years old, Kakiika Prison

My name is William, I thank you for bringing church to us, we pray every day, in the evening and in the early morning, this has brought back my hope, after the morning prayers I feel empowered to face a new day with courage and my days here in jail have become shorter and peaceful, am a former drug dealer and user but spending time behind bars was not, in itself, enough to stop me from a bad lifestyle, Only the transforming Grace and power of God that I experienced through the Freedom Team film of Prisoners of Pain God's Grace could deliver me, and save me, Thank you for my Bible Gift and the book.

Ronald, Male, 39 years old, Kakiika Prison

My story is brief, I write to thank you for coming to us and to thank God for bringing you to us, I lived life of drinking before, I also used drugs, and I lived on the streets, there was high rate of crime in my town and we were always the target of police, I was later charged with armed robbery facing 14 years in prison. While sitting in my a jail cell recently, the warden called us for prayers at the hall, after watching the video at the hall that had many testimonies of transformed lives from bad lifestyles, I surrendered my life to Christ, and since then I have been coming here every morning and evening for church, this is my cell church. I thank you so much for the gift of my Bible and the book.

Erick, Male, 41 years old, Nyabuhikye Prison

Born in a polygamous family, domestic violence, alcohol and drugs, me and my siblings using meth drug at a very young age, we had left home because of extreme poverty to face life on the streets, because of my aggressiveness in the business of selling drugs, and the many charges placed on me, I was always on the run, they got me finally and I was jailed, but what I have found in prison makes the process worth it all, I found something that satisfies, when I was invited at the hall, I watched the Prisoners of Pain Gods Grace documentary, I received Christ, I have now been changed and new born, Thank you for the gift of the Bible and booklet. I read all the scriptures on the booklet with my bible.

Puli, Male 38 years old, Kakiika Prison

Praise God Pastors of the Freedom Team, I was encouraged to write my story by a friend and cell mate, and I want to thank you for the Bible, and my book that you gave me. When I lost my wife in 2013, I started to use alcohol and drugs to deal with the loneliness, little did I know that the path I was walking in was a path of sorrow and death, I became an addict and was in and out of jail, falling deeper and deeper into my addiction and feeling more sorrow and pain without any relief, I realized my life was out of my control. Drugs, crime and alcohol brought me here. I was recently invited to attend the Saturday Prisoners of Pain Christian event in the hall, accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior, I am trying not to do drugs again and I know Jesus will help me.

Henry, Male 37 years old, Kakiika Prison

Hello Freedom Team, thank you for my Bible Gift and the booklet, But I have a prayer request, I need you to pray for my health, because I am HIV positive. My Name is Henry, am now 37-years-old, I came here in 2011, my charge was involuntary manslaughter, I first heard about you last year but when I was planning to come for the event, they shifted me to Karyera Government Prison, where I had spent almost 6 months. Until recently when I came back and immediately I was invited at the Prisoners of Pain video show, in the hall, I repeated the words after the man in the video and I received Christ Jesus, Thank you for coming and keep coming to us.

Emmanuel, Male, 34 years old, Kakiika Prison

Praise God that I am still alive, my story is long but I have attempted suicide several times. I joined the famous Kiffesi-gang as a young boy, pickpocketing, alcohol and drugs was my life style, I had no home, no job, no family and no friends. When I was arrested in a gang round up on the street, and ended up here in prison 5 years ago, my life begun falling apart in this jail cell, I tried to take my life several times, I felt useless and hopeless, until yesterday when I was invited to the hall, I have attended now as my second time, I would like to do a reading loudly during our cell church, I know how to read my Runyanko-re Bible that you gave me.

Henry M., Male 31 years old, Nyabuhikye Prison

My name is Henry, I have been a heroine drug addict; I have always blamed this on my terrible childhood and resented my parents for abandoning me. When the Freedom Team came to the hall, our cell was invited, I came out thinking it was entertainment, but after watching the film and they prayed for us I received Jesus, and the visitors gave me a Bible, I am now at cell K-4563200 prison church for prayers, I am encouraged by the testimonies of my fellow inmates daily, we meet twice daily, and God has restored joy in my heart.
