






I have asked myself that question often. We can see it taking place now.

Many of the prisoners have come to Jesus Christ as a result of the Prisoners of Pain.....God's Grace video documentary. Then many become part of the 991 Prison Cell Churches that meet twice a day, seven days a week. When released from prison many feel God leading them to start WAY House Churches. We ask them as they start new WAY churches to simply duplicate what God is doing in the Cell Churches inside the prisons. Most of these WAY churches meet 5 to 7 times a week. This is similar to the model of the House Churches in the book of Acts. **So, it is God doing it** and we are only a small part in His powerful work. **It is by His Spirit**, that God is accomplishing this great work.

We have had an excellent year 2025, as we end the month of December we have received all the information connecting us to already established works that have been a result of our influence which we had never known before. The **five new geographical centers** of OMURUTI, NYAMUKANA, RWAMPARA, NYEIHANGA, NDEIJA, with about 30 churches in operation already. The new Kanyary-eru center, the new WAY House churches in Ntungamo district that we have not yet physically visited and the Nakivale Refugee Camp churches which are multiplying at a very high speed.

. The WAY of Jesus school has been handed over officially to the government and we already received a Confirmation Certificate from Government Community Schools

Thank you for helping our 30 Elders to repair their bicycles, especially during this rainy season when they needed them most to visit the several WAY House churches and fellowship with them and collect the information of the progress, activity, encourage, give direction, and also praying for the sick, thank you so much. We ended the year with **13 geographical centers**, **13 Center Superintendents**, and **504 clusters of WAY House Churches**.

We thank God for the guidance of our spiritual parents' pastor Tom and Carla Flaskerud for the support and advice in all areas of the ministry.

I don't know any ministry that has had such a huge harvest using very simple tools, indeed obedience is better than sacrifice**. Thank you for your guidance Pastor Tom and Carla Flaskerud, through your support, guidance and prayers, **God has changed our land and even the government recognizes this**.

All planned schedules, events, and routes for December 2025 were completed as intended, the security on all roads, and road blocks by government soldiers has intensified as we get even closer to the elections, this is always a very tough time in our country where everyone needs to be careful as well as pray.

Security has generally improvement, on the roads, and we thank God for safe travels of our teams, safe accommodation, and very successful events. Special thanks to all teams for their faithful service and dedication to this calling and mandate throughout the year. We are now in 17 prisons, with 991 cell churches, and **our trained inmate Evangelistic Video teams doing a minimum of 3 events per week in each or these prison facility**.

We thank God for the gift of Bibles to inmates and this is the greatest gift an inmate can ever have during his time in prison, you have touched many souls by giving this gift to the inmates. We pray that God will continue to provide the Bibles for the many respondents coming to Christ each month, that at least every inmate will have access to the Word of God daily.

And finally we are here first of all to thank God for the year 2025, **we can surely say that God has used us mightily and His power has been manifest in our midst powerfully, it is surprising that God has gone ahead of us to use inmates coming from prison released after their sentence stirring their hearts to go out there to exactly what we are doing without our knowledge or supervisor**. We have learned towards the end of the year that we can't even count the exact numbers or the size of the work of God through TFEA in Uganda, we can only count what we are able to see at the time. **But our influence has gone beyond what we can count or imagine**, we have just discovered five well established centers with about 30 new Way House churches growing at a very high speed, we are so happy and excited about what the LORD has done through us and all our WAY of Jesus staff and ministers this year. We are ending the year with 13 centers and we have been informed that the Ntungamo area has a number of WAY House churches that have been in operation for the last three months. We are very excited to visit the area soon and the village where the **outbreak-of-churches started** from 3 months ago after the release of the inmates who had been in the prison cell churches. **So we know what we are reporting is a small part of what the LORD is doing, that we are currently aware of and that there are many other operations that have come out from the TFEA influence that we have not yet discovered.**

We are planning to extend our system of the 12 Elders leadership on each of the 13 centers, their superintendents and their assistants. Alex and Doreen's supervisory team, me and my wife Harriet, will continue to visit and do supervisory work, collecting data, supervising its accuracy, following up timetables of baptism events, doing the baptisms, special pastoral visits, supervision of the new areas. Our bicycles are in better shape now, and we are ready to walk with God as He advances His work of the gospel to hundreds of clusters of homes, house churches, having daily services and in fellowship with one another.

Evangelist Bryan Writes: Widow MWIRINGIYE MARTHA (pictured on left), is one of the blessed widows who has been among the first to benefit in the TFEA program of helping widows get a descent place to live. We got to know her through her youngest son, Simon, who was in prison at the time because of selling dangerous drugs, he was released early last year and became part of a WAY House church. Her two daughters also are part of our first graduates in the tailoring class, they got the opportunity because the Mega Church Center was their home during that time, ever since she got saved and baptized and became part of the WAY House church community, she and her two daughters who graduated tailoring class last year and her only son released from prison, and got saved in a Prison cell church and stopped taking drugs. She is now getting a house for her 5 children and they have a place to call home. This widow, mother of five children, 4 girls and one boy Simon, the youngest, is HIV+, after the passing of her husband several years back, MWIRINGIYE did not know she was living with HIV which had claimed the life of her late husband, however on discovering the truth later, she joined a government health program of people living with HIV, and started getting treatment of ARV's, her two daughters are also living with HIV AIDS, fortunately her other 3 children are healthy. But the greatest miracle is that she has found hope in Christ Jesus together with her children.

Miracles: - God saved her son from drugs in a prison cell church service.

God released her son from jail shortly after.

God gave them a house through TFEA widows program.

God gave opportunity to her two daughters to learn and graduate in tailoring skills.

God has become the father of her 5 children.

With all that God has done, we expect He will do more for Mwiringiye's family.

Miraculous, powerful, life-changing testimonies translated into English!

Kalanzi Enoch, male, 48 years old, recently released prisoner

Last year, while in my 8th year in prison, I met the Freedom Team and gave my life to Christ, and I received a Bible that would get me out of prison. I was added to the prison cell church and I started attending morning and evening prayers, **I earned trust from the Warden and I was given the task of putting back over 600 inmates into a holding cell after the prayers, I got a chance to speak a word of encouragement to each of them as they entered their cell in a line.** As we met daily and talked about the things of God in our cell church gatherings, one of the inmates, came over and shared his heart, confessing his need that he couldn't break addiction on his own and that he needs help. I had been reading my Bible which I had received from the Freedom Team, **so I shared the good news of Jesus deliverance from sin by grace through faith in Jesus Christ with him and with tears streaming down his face and trembling in the presence of God he surrendered his life to Christ!** Every addiction broke off of him. Since then I began praying to God to release me to go out and preach the gospel, and the Warden after hearing the testimony of this man, my sentence was reduced and I was released two months ago. **I joined with ministers Doreen and Alex at their home, now I go with them everywhere as a volunteer of the gospel,** my commitment to the Bible and the Word of God released me from the physical and spiritual prison.

Louis Mwenekahima, male, 42 years old

My name is Louis Mwene, and I grew up in the town of Kabingo near Rwenjeru in Ankore. I was very young when my mum left and never returned. My Father, stepped up to raise me and my two older brothers on his own, we lived in the same room with my grandparents, uncles, and cousins, sometimes we would sleep out in the verender when the room was full, a lot happened in that small one room house that hurt me, it turned into deep anger, confusion, and pain that followed me for years, with time I didn't understand life, death, or why everything felt so dark. I found comfort in the wrong places hanging out with older men on the farm, getting into drugs, alcohol, and crime. I have tried to end my life uncountable times. I tied a bedsheets around my neck and tried to hang myself last year, but God intervened, somehow, I was filled with energy and managed to break free. Now I know it was Him who saved me that night. I have found a family in Christ Jesus, I was living alone last year, thinking about ending my life, when a just released prisoner knocked at my door and invited me to the big church, he gave me an old Bible with the four gospels written in WAY of Jesus Bible, I was fully lost in drugs at that time, but something in me said, I have tried all ways, let me try the WAY of Jesus. That night, I found myself high, walking through the Rwenjeru and Kabingo to the big church center, and I stopped in front of the big church. Since then I have never left this place, its now 3 months I live here, my life is renewed, I plan to have a family, live for Jesus and tell others about the Savior Jesus who saved my life, I was baptized last month and I have found a new family in Jesus.

M.... M...., male, 39 years old, currently in prison

I was sentenced to 6 years and 9 months in prison, while there I started attending the morning and evening services at the prison cell church. I wasn't fully engaged in worship yet, but now I know seeds were being planted. After my first year in prison, I was moved to a new jail because of my behavior. I didn't know it then, but this move was part of God's plan. The prison was about four hours away from my previous one, it placed me exactly where I needed to be. The inmates were hard on me, I was beaten and treated like an animal. But it was there, **in that prison, just three weeks after my transfer, that Jesus Christ revealed Himself to me in my cell,** during a session of the Freedom Team, while watching the Prisoners of Pain testimonies, at that moment, my life began to change, the cell church leader at that prison became like a father to me, he didn't just preach the gospel to me, **he also gave me the WAY of Jesus Bible and taught me how to read it, he followed up with me, he prayed with me, taught me, and baptized me.** I truly believe God moved me to that prison so I could meet the Freedom Team and the support team of inmates, the cell church guidance, and love played a massive part in leading me into a real relationship with Jesus. I am now happily serving my sentence with big dreams of when I am released to go and serve God, meanwhile am going to commit to helping others know Jesus while here in prison.

Robert Mukuntanya Membo, male, 37 years old, former prisoner

The first time I saw the Prisoners of Pain event, I buried my face between my knees, I was seated on the floor, and I wept. I saw all my past life replayed, the drugs, the robberies, the gang life style, in that moment, amid the tears, I knew I needed to change, I received Jesus. They told us that Jesus offered freedom from the sins of the past that bound me spiritually, and gave me a copy of the Bible. The Freedom Team regularly visited us, with life changing documentary and as I sat through a few of these meetings, I was assigned to the prison cell church fellowship every morning and evening, and this is where I received my deliverance from witch craft that my family practiced, Bacwezi ,a form of witchcraft, I fell down one day during morning prayers and something strange came out of my body violently and I was delivered. I started reading the Bible that I had received, and committed to the cell church programs, and last month, to my surprise, I was released on probation in August. Jesus has rescued me from a life of drugs, street crime, and sexual immorality. My girlfriend and I will soon become parents, Jesus saved me from a path of self-destruction, I am now serving at Kanyaryeru Way Church.

Musasizi Benard Aruho, male, 51 years old, former prisoner

I have finally finished my 14 year sentence and reunited with my wife Lydia, and my children. Together, we go to Rwamuranda WAY House Church. In my church I keep sharing my testimony and ministering through music. Its exactly two years since I first met with the Freedom Team. Then I was hopeless and thinking of taking my life, I was seated in the common area when we were invited for the Freedom Team event in the prison hall that changed my life, we always sat in the hall to be alone and think about life, this is where the Freedom Team found me in an event that would change my life forever, **after the event and giving my life to Christ, two days later I was assigned the work of organizing the morning and evening prayers at my cell and I served the prison cell church for two years until my miraculous release.** I had the first Christmas with my family in 14 years. Our home in Rwamuranda has turned into a church, and my wife feels that our calling is to make disciples the WAY of Jesus, because we are convinced the Church is the only hope for the world, just like through the cell church I was delivered, healed and released from prison, there are many others in and out of prison that need this grace, and **for this reason we opened our WAY House Church here in Rwamuranda.**
