<i>Seamless and silky, showing an almost effortless sense of complexity, with notes of lemon and pear paired with toasty brioche, fresh ginger and hazelnut details.</i>				
#62	90	Joel Gott (California) Sauvignon Blanc	2017	\$15
<i>Juicy pear, peach and citrus flavors are bright and smooth, with a touch of dried chamomile and lemon verbena lingering on the finish. Impressive for the focus and aromatic detail. Drink now.</i>				
#32	92	Nautilus (Marlborough, New Zealand) Sauvignon Blanc	2017	\$17
<i>Rich and complex, with honeysuckle and freshly grated ginger notes up front, giving way to juicy and crisp Meyer lemon, yellow apple and Asian pear flavors. Hints of lime zest and dried mango linger.</i>				
#57	93	Hamilton Russell (South Africa)	2017	\$40
<i>Melon, yellow apple, white peach and quince flavors give this an opulent feel, harnessed by honeysuckle and quinine accents through the finish, showing refinement and length in the end. Drink now through 2021.</i>				
#78	91	Landmark (California) Chardonnay	2016	\$25
<i>Well-built and rich, with a solid core of apple pastry, fig and guava flavors that offer a creamy texture. Nutmeg and clove notes show on the spicy finish. Drink now through 2022.</i>				
#59	93	Lopez de Heredia (Spain) White Blend	2008	\$36
<i>Rich and firm, this white shows complex flavors of dried apple, creamed pear, heather, white tea, coconut and vanilla. Juicy acidity and light tannins keep this focused, providing structure for the long haul. A lovely example of the traditional style. Drink now through 2026.</i>				
#50	93	Four Graces (Oregon) Pinot Noir	2015	\$32
<i>An expressive and supple version, with a complex core of lively tannins and acidity, plus accents of black cherry, cinnamon and spice that linger toward the minerally finish. Drink now through 2024.</i>				
#11	95	Carpineto (Italy) Montepulciano Reserva	2013	\$30
<i>The stunning bouquet of ripe black cherry, black currant, leather and woody spice notes is enticing, while the sweet fruit is a match for the dense structure. The lengthy finish lingers, with tobacco, eucalyptus and iron accents. Drink now through 2030.</i>				
#17	95	Caparzo (Italy) Brunello	2013	\$45
<i>This cuts more of a broad swath than its peers, yet remains graceful, evoking strawberry, cherry, tobacco and stony mineral flavors. Long and dense in structure, with a tobacco- and underbrush-tinged finish. Best from 2021 through 2033.</i>				
#53	93	Sequoia Grove (Napa) Cabernet Sauvignon	2015	\$42
<i>Rich, smoky oak and plump dark berry, mocha, cedar and sage flavors form an enticing mouthful, supported by a supple, caressing texture, ending long and full. Drink now through 2030.</i>				
#58	92	Vasse Felix (Australia) Cabernet Sauvignon	2015	\$27
<i>Opens with a fresh green accent reminiscent of tomato leaf and sage, giving a savory, peppery note to the plush, velvety cassis and plum core. Finds balance between grace and power, with spice and herb elements lingering on the finish. Drink now through 2028 (Cab and Malbec)</i>
