#### President's Message, July 2023



To all Club Members,

This month we celebrate the 247th anniversary of Independence Day, the day that 56 Englishmen who represented the 13 British colonies in America declared

their independence as 13 sovereign nations from the tyranny of King George III and the State of Great Britain.

The Signers of the Declaration dissolved the political bands with their country based on the principle that the Laws of Nature and that of Nature's God entitled them to do so. They then went on to boldly declare that, "We hold these Truths to be self-evident, that all men are created Equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness."

#### THE FACTS About Electric Vehicles

(part two of the series)

How far can one go on a charge? The key to these questions depends on your circumstances and how you drive. Do you just take short trips to the store, gym and church, or will you need to travel long distances to see family, friends, or to go on vacations? Do you accelerate quickly? Do you coast to a stop or brake rapidly?

The first thing you need to determine is, how important is the range of your electric vehicle to you? Most gasoline cars have a range of approximately 400 miles. Very few electric vehicles can achieve this range. Therefore, you must determine what an acceptable range is for you. The range is measured by the EPA in a climate-controlled garage with a temperature of 68-70°F.

The temperature is important because the outside temperature greatly affects the maximum range. For example, if the temperature is 5°F the range of the vehicle will be reduced by 50%.

The garage test also does not take into account wind resistance, hills, air-conditioning, heater, or additional weight from passengers, luggage, groceries, etc. In some vehicles the range is cut in half with four passengers. Therefore, the range provided by the manufacturer is an estimate and based on near optimum conditions to achieve the highest possible range.

You need to understand you will most likely not obtain the milage range the manufacturer claims. Remember for safety, you should only count on 80% of the estimated range. You just can't pull over to the gas station and fill up. So be very careful.

Furthermore, batteries in electric vehicles are very expensive. They are the most expensive part of the vehicle, and their cost can be up to 50% of the vehicle cost. The cost of replacement batteries can exceed \$20,000 dollars. Therefore, it is imperative the batteries are maintained and charged properly to protect your investment.

The general rules of charging batteries are fairly simple. The faster they charge the shorter the battery life. Keeping the batteries fully charged will also reduce battery life. To obtain the longest battery life the battery should be kept charged in the range of  $20\rightarrow80\%$ . Charging a typical electric vehicle using a standard 110-volt outlet provides approximately 2-3 miles per hour. Therefore, charging your EV for 12 hours will allow you to travel 24-36 miles, or **4** days for a complete charge.

The average cost for a home charger is approximately \$500 dollars and must be installed by an electrician. A 220-volt charger can supply up to 44 miles per hour of charging. Level-one chargers (110 amp) require approximately 40-50-amp service. A level-two charger requires 80–100-amp service. Many homes do not have this amount of available amps. Therefore, many homes cannot charge an electric vehicle and run the air conditioner at the same time.

For example, Anheuser-Bush stock has decreased 8.14% in the last three months and Bud Lite is no longer the number one selling beer. What is Anheuser Bushes' comment? Target stock has dropped from \$170.46 to \$131.10, a drop of 23.1% with significantly lower profits due to lower store traffic; however, Maybelline, which is owned by L'Oréal cosmetics just hired Dylan Mulvaney (The Budweiser Man masquerading as a woman) as their spokes man.
