More students were excited; they were just a few. The photos would then be given to Dr. Colson. Students felt satisfied with the result.


They did this for the first time ever, and hopefully will continue taking the drone photos going on.

We recently interviewed Brendan in third grade, a future author. Let's see what Brendan said.


WP: What inspired you to write Harry Potter books?
