And to everyone else, a good job too! You did it!

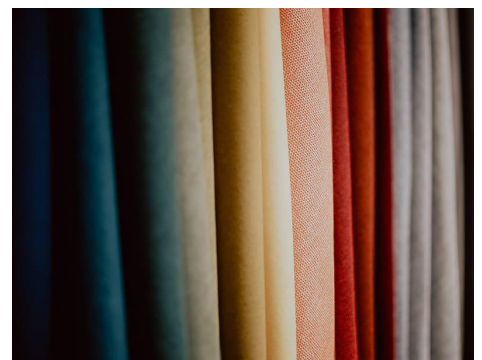
Everyone really loved the Makerspace Carnival and are looking forward to the one next year.

Spencer Clark, Student Of The Month

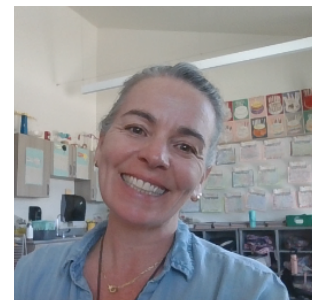

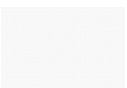

Gray, white, dark blue, purple purse, clear lipgloss, clear or metallic barrette

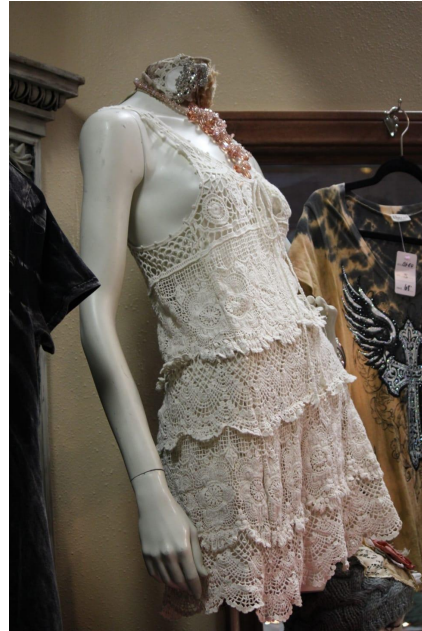
Purple, dark purple, light purple, white purse, purple lipgloss, metallic, purple checkered, or white barrette
