 - o Dr. Colletti previously proposed Hope School program Hope School garden much larger

- Plant the strawberries in pots and have a "strawberry sale."
- John Perlin and Ryan Moore nominated to build a "farm stand" that could be used for multiple purposes including a "Summerland Market"
