	 Ms. O'Shea shared a PowerPoint presentation about 6th grade and 7th grade class options. A few notes: GATE students are clustered in the same classes, there is a higher-level math class and social studies and ELA classes are the same teacher. Daily advisory classes are under 20 students each and utilize "Responsive Advisory" curriculum. Ms. O'Shea and Ms. Rigby answered many posed questions. Ms. Rigby shared out of 498 students, 492 follow expectations regularly while 6 students do not. Ms. O'Shea and Ms. Rigby stated while they are working on addressing these students' needs, they are "challenged" by these students. Concerns also shared about math scores – with a pattern of students' scores dropping from fifth grade to sixth grade and increasing by eighth grade. Numerous hypotheses and suggestions were shared. Ms. Rigby and Ms. O'Shea indicated the CMS team are working on increasing math scores at CMS. Ms. Rigby addressed a question about Measure U construction at Summerland School. Indicated plans are now for construction to happen in the 21-22 school year and be done in 2022. \$6 million continues to be dedicated toward modernization of Summerland School. 	Diana Rigby
