

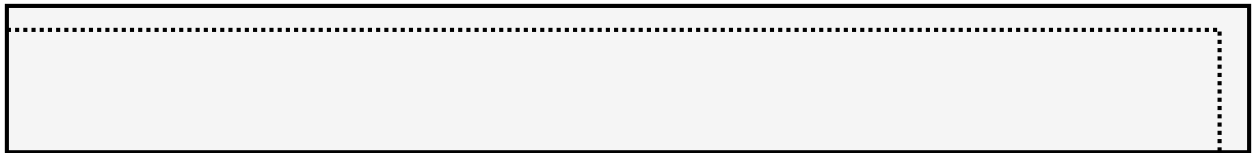
Cooling Scarves:

Cut 4 1/2 fabric strips WOF (selvage to selvage).

Fold with right sides together in half lengthwise and iron.

Sew down one short end and up the long edge.

Trim corners on sewn seams and turn right side out.
