## Annual Celebrate & Protect the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Amendment 2021



Rules & Regulations (Must be read BEFORE applying for a booth)

Thank you for your interest in this year's Celebrate & Protect the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment and thank you for taking the time to read the below items that will help ensure a clean, orderly and safe environment.

- 1. No FIRES, No DRUGS, NO ALCOHOL allowed. Violators will be removed.
- 2. Vendor is solely responsible for providing whatever tables, chairs, and coverings (tents/canopies) required for their assigned space. Booths must be staffed during vendor hours between 9:30-2:00pm. All vehicles must be removed from Washington St. AS SOON as they have been unloaded. Vendor vehicles are to park in the parking lot east of the event after unloading.
- 3. Use of stakes and or tying to trees, buildings, monuments, etc. is prohibited.
- 4. TRASH: Vendors must provide for their own trash disposal and are prohibited from using trash receptacles provided for event patrons.
- 5. All items sold or distributed as promotional items at RidersUSA's "Celebrate & Protect the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment" Celebration must be appropriate for a family friendly event.
- 6. Under no circumstances will the Vendor sell any projectiles, explosives, or laser pointers on Capitol premises. No silly string, poppers, glitter, or any other products that require special cleanup may be sold or given away for free.
- 7. No food or beverages may be sold except by food vendors.
- 8. THE DECISION OF RidersUSA, Inc. IN ALL MATTERS, IS FINAL.
- 9. HOLD ARMLESS; All booth operators, owners, employees, workers shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless RidersUSA, Inc. and any co-sponsors, their officers, employees, agents, volunteers from any and all loss, damage, or injury, to any person or property taking part in the "Celebrate & Protect The 2nd Amendment" event.
- 10. Booth setup: Vendors may set up booths on the day of the event from 7:00 9:00am.
- 11. Booth Teardown: Must be complete by 3:00pm.
- 12. Cleanup: Vendor agrees to maintain a clean and presentable booth. Vendor is responsible for the removal of ALL materials, litter, garbage including boxes, signs, and any other disposable garbage. Vendors may not dispose of any hazardous material or burn any objects on Capitol property.
- 13. Security is not provided for individuals or the event. RidersUSA, Inc. is not responsible for loss of any kind. Vendor agrees to obtain all additional insurance deemed necessary to cover potential losses. Vendors are responsible for their own setup and tear down. Vendor agrees to see that their booth is staffed, open, and ready to operate during vendor hours as stated above. Vendor specifically agrees to abide by all applicable ordinances and statutes pertaining to vender during the event. This includes but not limited to, any and all laws, statues, and ordinances of the City of Phoenix, County of Maricopa, and State of Arizona, or any other governmental agency pertinent to the Vendor's products and participation in the event including but not limited to those affecting health, fire safety, and sales tax regulations.
