La Bayadere

La Bayadere was created especially for the benefit performance of Ekaterina Vazem, Prime ballerina of the St. Petersburg Imperial theatres.

La Bayadere (meaning the Temple Dancer or the Temple Maiden) tells the story of the bayadere Nikiya and the warrior Solor, who have sworn eternal fidelity to one another. The High Brahmin, however, is also in love with Nikiya and learns of her relationship with Solor. Moreover, the Rajah Dugmanta of Golconda has selected Solor to be the fiancé of his daughter Gamzatti (or Hamsatti, as she is known in the original production), and Nikiya, unaware of the arrangement, agrees to dance at the couple's betrothal celebrations.

In a dream-like euphoria, Solor has a vision of Nikiya's shade (or spirit) in a nirvana among the star-lit mountain peaks of the Himalayas called the Kingdom of the Shades. Here, the lovers reconcile among the supreme opulence and order of the shades of other bayaderes (in the original production of 1877 this scene took place in an illuminated enchanted palace in the sky). When Solor awakes, preparations are underway for his wedding to Gamzatti.


