It has been a great year of learning and improvement for me, as well as for all in our school. I came to appreciate more fully the detail of work that is needed for the school and the work that has been done by our wonderful staff.

Our team of instructors is like a neo-impressionist painting. Each small dot of paint comes together to form a beautiful art piece. Each teacher, unique in experience and skill, joins together and makes our school distinctive and colorful.

Looking at our amazing teachers and dancers, I sometimes feel my own abilities fall short of what this school deserves. But, I know that with so many supporting the vision of this school, we cannot go wrong. I thank all our staff and parents for continuing to help me in so many ways to shape our future dancers.

We are excited about the upcoming schedule. Dates for Summer 2019 and Fall 2019-Spring 2020:

Summer Session 1Jul 8-Aug 3, 2019
Summer Session 2Aug 5-Aug 31, 2019
Fall-Spring Sep 3, 2019-Jun 6, 2020

To focus on the needed work going forth, we have decided not to do a Summer Dance for 2019. However, parents will be invited to attend and observe the last day of class for each summer session.

Since ballet is a performing art, we provide multiple opportunities to perform. These include Annual Nutcracker (two performances), Annual Showcase, Annual RAD exam, and PPDC (Pre-Professional Dance Company; PPDC groups attend at least 3 competitions).

Nutcracker: David Eck and I will be working closely with all teachers for the upcoming Nutcracker casting. We have recently decided to wait until September to cast lead roles because many vocational students are away for the summer. The selection process will include consideration of RAD exam scores as well as an audition. More information regarding the try-out process will take place in the first week of September.

RAD Exams: As I am writing this, the RAD exam results have not been received but I was pleased with all the teachers who were able to help and support the students. On exam day, students were greeted by their teachers who led them in warm-up exercises, reminded them to focus on particular skills, and encouraged them before they were escorted into the exam room. It helped so much with the continuity of class to exam to see how much they have achieved this year. I am 100% sure that the exam results will reflect what has been taught and emphasized in class.

New Classes:

Pre-Pointe class, which we offered for the first time this year for the Grade 5/Grade 5 SPA students, added a great benefit by educating students about foot technique and the maturity needed to take on the challenge of going on pointe. Those who have taken this course have seen the benefit of understanding what they individually need to work on to strengthen their feet to prevent injuries. Pre-Pointe will now be included as part of the Grade 5 curriculum this summer and continuing into fall.

Acro and Jazz classes have been requested and tested by a small group of students this year. We are going to offer Acro classes to the whole school for the benefit of more conditioning starting this summer and into fall. Danielle de Ojeda has graciously agreed to continue on as the Acro instructor. See more about Jazz classes below in Combination Classes.

Combination Classes:

We are excited to announce new Combination Classes beginning this summer and continuing into fall. Hip Hop/Tap, Jazz/Lyrical, and Modern/Hip Hop classes will give our students more confidence in other dance forms. Ariel Webb will be our new teacher for the Hip Hop/Tap and Jazz/Lyrical Combination Classes. Danielle Sullivant will be our new teacher for Modern dance as part of the Modern/Hip Hop Combination Class. She will also be teaching ballet to our younger students. Frankie Mendoza will be the Hip Hop teacher for the Modern/Hip Hop Combination Class and continue as our Hip Hop coach for PPDC.

Other Teacher News:

Liliana Vinueza-Prada: We welcome Liliana Vinueza-Prada from Cuba to the Rachel's Ballet family. You can read her extensive resume and profile on our website.

Connie Zaug: We are happy that Connie is able to return back to teaching.

Barbara Campbell: We are so pleased that Barbara will continue to substitute teach for us.

Pre-Professional Dance Company (PPDC): I can see this year that teachers who attended the competitions with their PPDC groups gave students increased unity and a spirit of teamwork. The 2019 competition experience has been wonderful for our school from RAD Dance Challenge (RDC), California Dance Classics (CDC), Spotlight, and Youth America Grand Prix (YAGP). Our students continue to improve as they attend more competitions.

I want to congratulate Maria LaMance's PPDC group dance "Alliance." They advanced into the YAGP Finals, and the four students will be attending and representing the school. Thank you to all the wonderful coaches for your sweetness and hard work training these students since they were young. I am so proud of them.

PPDC Registration will continue to be done by Isabelle Sjahsam. I will continue to work closely with her on the administrative side of things.

Graduating Seniors – Jade Zhang and Amanda Lin: Lastly, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all the best to our two graduating senior students who are on their way to college in the fall. We are always saddened to see our students leave. They are both kind, thoughtful and loving young women who serve as good role models for the younger students. LE CORSAIRE

Le Corsaire is a ballet usually performed
in three acts. Choreographed originally by
Joseph Mazilier to the music of Adolphe
Adam, it premiered at the Paris Opera on
January 23, 1856. It was later revived by
Marius Petipa and performed in St. Petersburg
in the late 19th Century.

Medora, a Greek girl, is sold to a slave trader
named Pasha. The pirate, Conrad, takes
Medora and declares his love for her. His

right hand man is jealous of Conrad and sells
her back to the slave trader. When Conrad
and his men come to rescue Medora, he
is recognized even in his disguise and
sentenced to death. Medora, who has fallen
in love with Conrad, agrees to marry the
slave trader to save Conrad's life. However,
she plots with a slave girl named Gulnare
to trade places with her, so that Gulnare
marries Pasha instead. After the ceremony,
Medora dances for Pasha. Thinking he has
married Medora, he lays down his weapons.
Gulnare reveals that she has actually married
Pasha. Conrad and Medora escape on a ship
that sinks during a violent storm. But Conrad
and Medora escape to a rocky island.
