

Car Break-Ins

At approximately 12:15 a.m. on January 20th a vehicle entered our community though the front gate that was still open after a resident had entered. While here six different vehicles were broken into through the driver side window. There were also two cars with attempted break-ins. All of the vehicles were parked on the street. From those I have spoken to I have determined that center consoles were rummaged through. It appears as though the thieves only made off with small amounts of change and cash. They exited the community at approximately 12:27 a.m.

I was able to review camera footage and identify the license plate as it was captured by our cameras. I met with an ACPD officer yesterday and provided them with the footage they wanted and the license plate number. From what I am told there were a string of break-ins in Vallejo and American Canyon that night. As unfortunate as this is, it appears to be a completely random act. If I receive any further information from ACPD that is important to share I will keep the community updated.

At this time everything that can be done, has been done. I encourage residents to remain vigilant and report suspicious activity to the ACPD. Remember to call 911 for emergencies and **(707) 648-0171 for non emergency dispatch**. Please feel free to contact me with any concerns.
